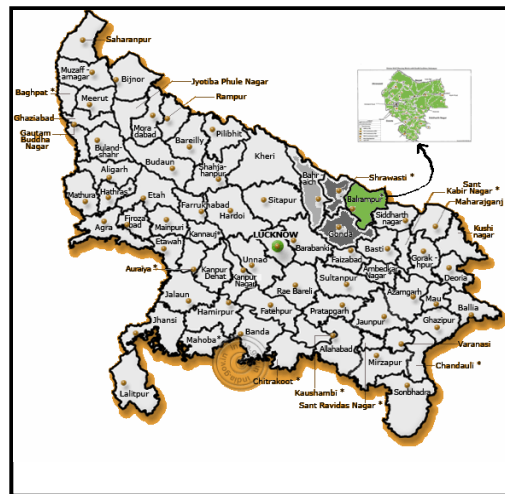

## District Profile:

Balrampur is one of the newly constituted district in 1997 by GD No. 1428/1-5-97/172/85-R-5 Luckon dated May 25,1997, after diving district BALRAMPUR that is now a division s\ituated on bank of River Rapti. District is consists of three Tahsils Viz-Balrampur, Tulsipur and Utraula. There are Nine Blocks and thirteen Police Stations in the district. Blocks Balrampur, Harraiya Satgharwa & Balrampur Urban area lies under sub-district (Tehsil) Balrampur, Block Tulsipur, Gainsri and Pachperwa under Tulsipur Sub-district and Block Utraula, Sriduttganj, Regara Bazar and Gaindasbujurg are situated under Utraula tehsil. There are two Nagar Palika Parisad and Two Nagar Panchayat. The total Revenue Villages are 1017 in district (five forest villages included in year 2010). District has been identified high focused Area under NRHM.



According to 2011 census, the total population of the district is 21.48 million of which 11.17 million are males and 10.31 million are females. The district accounts for 1 percent of the total population of the state. The decadal growth rate during 2001-2011 recorded in the district was 27.74 percent that is higher than the state average of 20.09 per cent. The population density in 2011 is 642 persons per sq. km. The sex ratio is 922 females per 1000 males that is higher than the state level (828 in 2011). The child sex ratio in age group 0-6 in the district is lower (968 females per 1000 males) higher than the state average (914).

In the district, there are three sugar mills situated in BSMC Balrampur, Hindustan Sugar Milaa Itai Maida and BSMC Tulsipur. There is also a Distillery too established in Balrampur Sugar Mill, Balrampur.

The area of the district is 336917 Hec., in which the agriculture irrigated area is 221432 Hec. Districts Siddharth Nagar, Shrawasti, BALRAMPUR District, are situated in the east-west and south sides respectively and northern boundary is made by Nepal. In north part of the district Shivalics ranges of the Himalyas is situated which is called Tarai Region. There are valuable trees like Sagavan, Shakhu and Khair are found in the forest of district.

In the district, there are three sugar mills situated in Balrampur city, Itai Maida and Tulsipur. There is a Distillery also established in Balrampur city.

According to Government of India, the district Balrampur is *one of the Minority Concentrated District in India* on the basis of the 2001 census data on population, socio-economic indicators and basic amenities indicators.

Geographically Balrampur is located at 27.43°N 82.18°E.[2] It has an average elevation of 106 meters (347 feet) on the border side of Indo-Nepal. District Balrampur is one of the

most difficult area identified by state and GOI based on it's geography and availability of basic amenities.
