- 4. Maintenance of office equipment at State, District level & IRL equipment should be completed as planned. Ensure that all BMs are in working condition (their AMC is taken care of by the Union) .
- 5. All trainings, ie, Induction training, update and re-training of all cadres of staff should be well planned and completed as planned. The expenditure should be as per GoI approval. Photographs/Video coverage of the trainings will be required for second release.
- 6. All 4 wheelers in the Districts should be well maintained and in running condition.
- 7. Planning for supervisory visits by DTOs and MO-TCs and accordingly vehicle hiring should have approval of DHS.
- 8. More NGOs should be involved in schemes of RNTCP as per approved plan & their physical and financial progress should be regularly checked.
- 9. All activities under "Miscellaneous" head should be completed as per approved paln in PIP and proper records maintained.
- 10. All vacant positions of contractual staff should be filled as per norms and paid regularly.
- 11. All material should be printed at State and district level through hired agency selected as per norms.
- 12. All activities proposed in PIP for Medical Colleges should be completed timely and monitored regularly.
- 13. 2-wheelers and equipment (36 computers, modem, scanner, printer, UPS **etc**) should be purchased as per norms and as per requirement.
- 14. There will be release of first installment of 36% budget to 44 districts funded under World Bank and 40% to remaining 27 districts funded under GFATM.
- 15. Budget to State TB cell will also be released in the same proportions.
- 16. Funds for IEC/Publicity will be retained at NRHM till further decision.
- 17. Second and final installment will be released on submission of a) head wise SOE b) approval of civil work from DHS & work completed c) list of community DOT providers with self certification from 5 of them for payment received d) report of trainings with visual proof e) CMO approved consolidated report of at least 5 supervisor visits by DTO/MO-TC f) physical progress of NGOs involved g) list of contractual staff appointed in the districts h)receipt of printing from printer and copy of printed material i) consolidated report from Medical Colleges for physical & financial progress J) report of process adopted in purchase of 2 wheelers and computers.
 - 18. Final consolidated report after completion of all the activities has to be submitted for verification of indicators set as above and will be reviewed by MD-NRHM.
