**Chitrakoot - FY 2016-17 (March-17)  
Summary Sheet**

**Maternal health :**

- 73% of estimated pregnant woman were registered in the program.
- Out of which only 35% pregnant woman were registered in the 1st trimester.
- 58% of Women getting 3ANC chekups.
- 68% of pregnant woman received TT2/BD.
- Only 12% of Contribution on ANC regsitration by CHC, PH & DH.
- 34% of Delivery were missed in reporting.
- 60% of registered pregnant woman wee having Hb level<11 were only 1.7% pregnant women having < 7 Hb level detected.

**Child Health:**

- 98% of Child weighted at birth
- 18% of babies were reported less than 2.5 Kg.
- 100% babies were breast feeded with in 1 hour.

**Immunization**

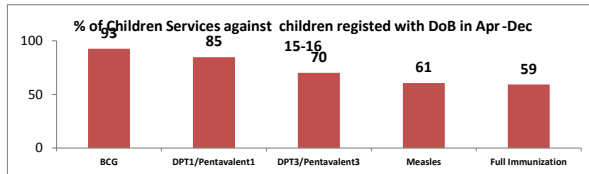
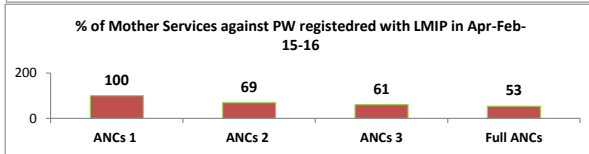
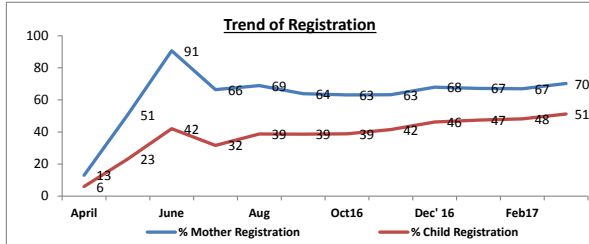
- 86% of BCG reported corosponded to Estimated live births.
- % of full immunization is 89%.
- Birth doses at CHC & PHC were less contributed.
- % of Hep-B Zero and OPV-Zero were increased in reporting in Oct-16.

**Family Planning:**

- Major contribution for IUCD insertion is from SC-59%.
- % of achivement in specing method is only 45% achiveed by April & Oct16.
- But in case of service provided in family planning is 10%.
- % of Achivement for limiting method is .65% whcih not seems good for district performance for FP Indicators

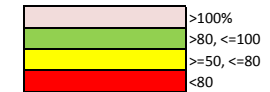

 - % of HRP recording is not satisfactory so data should be review in Validation committee meetings

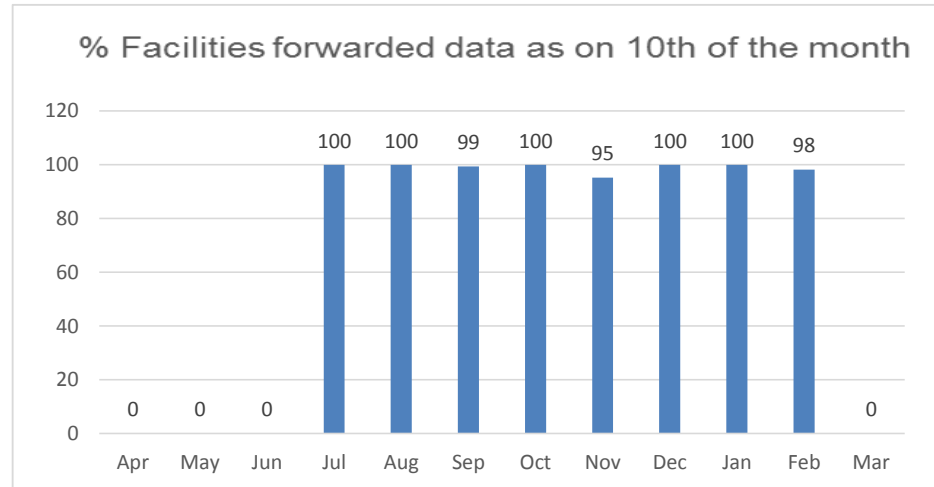
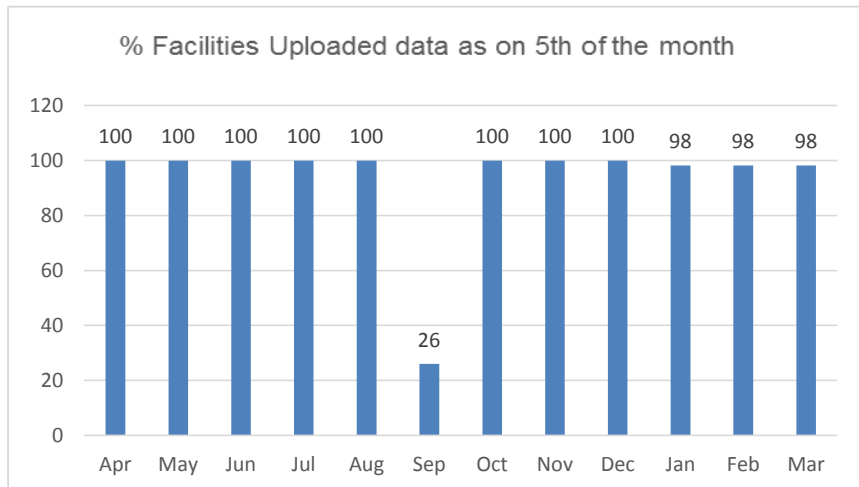

**Gaps in ANC Registration :**

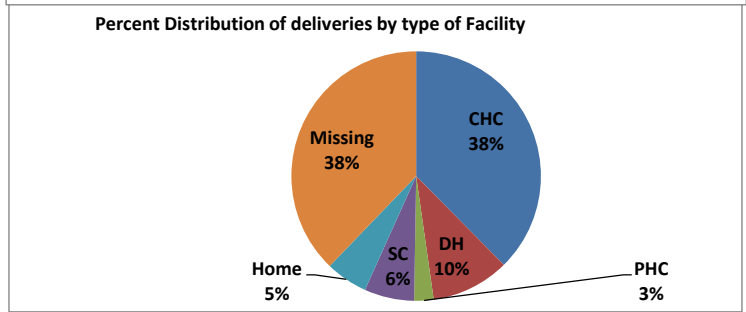
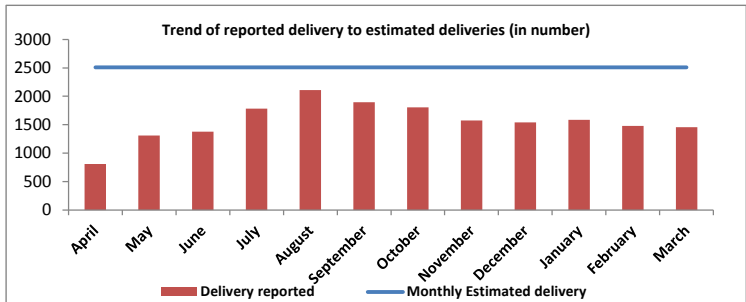
1. % of ANC Registration is 74% that seems good in all blocks except ramnagar it seems better in performance rather than other blocks.
2. Register with in 1st trimester is not satisfactory by all Blocks and need to be check by program managers.
3. Majority of ANC distribution is 88% that seems better but at CHC, PHC and DH service part is lacking more inspite of high facility services.





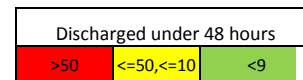

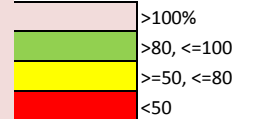

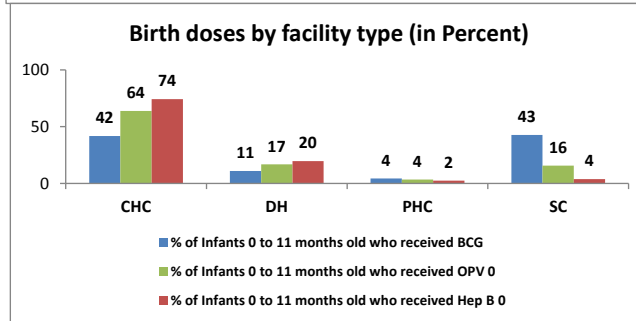
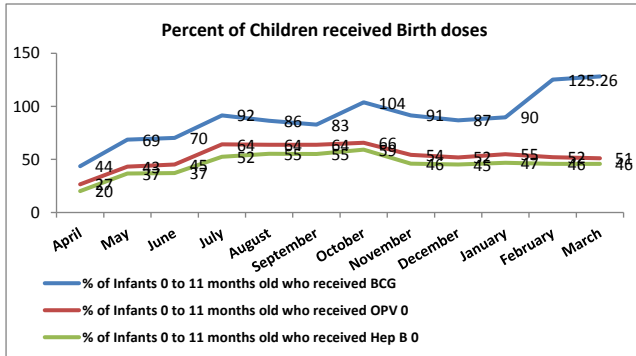
#### Gaps in Child care :

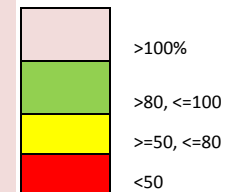

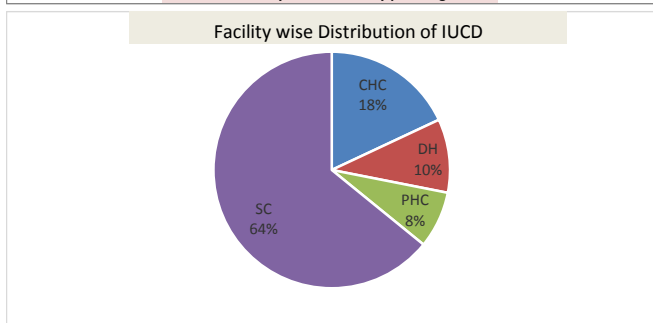
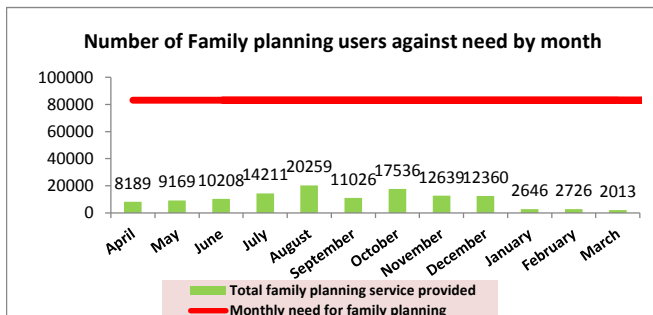
#### Gaps in Immunization :

- % of Overall Hep-B Zero reporting is not satisfactory by district so data and program must be review.
- % of Fully immunized is 94% so data and program need to be checked.

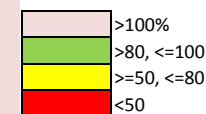
