HMIS Bulletin - Summary Sheet District Aligarh Month - April- March FY 2016-17



➤ **Maternal health :**

- Akrabad block facility reported more than 100 percent for ANC registered against estimated. As per AHS 50.2 percent PW registered for ANC, while in district it show 72.6 %.
- Most of the block are reporting that pregnant women get TT2/Booster more than district average (61.7 %). Except Lodha and DHQ.
- 65 percent of the ANC are registered at sub-center but DH , CHC and PHC % is Show out reach Activity not implimented in proper way.
- First trimester registration reporting in Five Block is less than 50 %. Need to be focus.
- 39 % of deliveries are not reported in HMIS against estimate.
- only 13 % Home delivery reported at sub center level that need to check and it is needed to verify according to other data source and records and also from AHS home delivery is 40.4 .
- 79 percent of women discharged within 48 Hours. its means 21 % women are staying till 48 hours at facility after delivery that are need to more focus or can be a cause of maternal & child mortality. DHQ report almost 100 % in Up to March 2017.
- 4 block Namly Chandaus, Gagiri, Iglas and Aligarh block JSY incentive paid to Mother is very low as compare to other block and as per the AHS it is 55.9 percent while reporting in HMIS is 44.5 percent up to March 2017.
- Lodha block JSY incentive paid to Mother is more than Delivery. Data need to recheck.
- Three block namly Lodha, Gonda and Bijoli Home Delivery reported more than institutional Delivery. Need to be focus on institutional Delivery those block.
- Two block severely anamic pregnant women is treated reported is Zero that need focus at facility level.
- Five block not reported of hypertensive cases those block focus to Identification of Hypertancive PW. Need to be focus.
- 267 percent high risk pregnant women identified at CHC level while it is very low at SC, PHC, and DH that need to be focus.
- Iglas block PW % of having Hb level <11 more than 100%. Data need to be recheck.
- Most of the block reported in HMIS portal High risk PW but in MCTS portal High risk PW Block Not Reported . High risk PW information Must be capture in MCTS portal.
- Three block Namly Chandaus, Gonda and Bijoli Number having Hb level<11 (tested cases) is very low reported as compare to other Block.
- Gonda block need to more focus on HRP Identification and treatment during HRP day organized every month of 9th .
- 10 block out of 14 not reporting PW with Obstetric Complications attended at facility.
- C- Section Conducted not reporting by any Block. Data need to recheck or focus on this indicator.
- Only 2 % of Instituional Delivery PW with Obstetric Complications attended at facility
- Aligarh and Tappal Block PW with Obstetric Complications treated case more then reported aganist attended at facility. Data Need to be Recheck.

➤ **Child Health:**

- 0.6 percent still births are reported from the district. Reproting of still birth is very poor in many bloks of district up to March 2017. DHQ and Gonda block zero or 1 still birth reported in HMIS portal up to March 2017. Data need to recheck.
- Gonda and DHQ block % of newborns having < 2.5 kg are very less as compare to other block.
- Almost block newborns breast fed within 1 hour is reported is almost 100 % but Acoording to AHS only 30% of Newborn breast fed within 1 hour. Data need to be recheck
- Total Deliveries is =< Live birth + Still Birth" but Four block namly Dhnipur, Lodha, Akrabad & Atrauli Not follow this validation rule. Need to be focus in Block Validation committee at Block level.

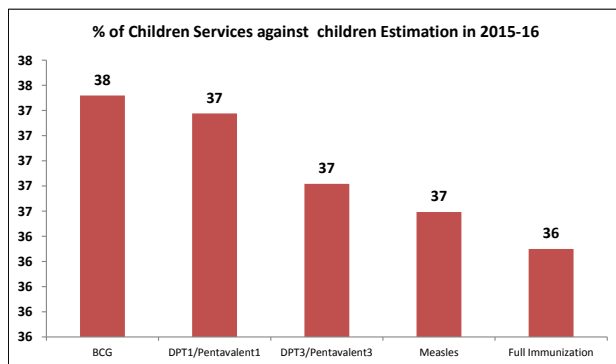
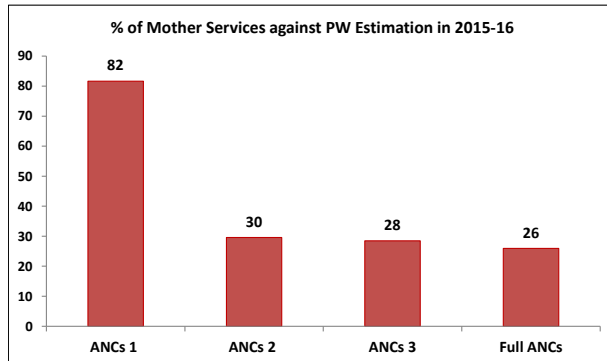
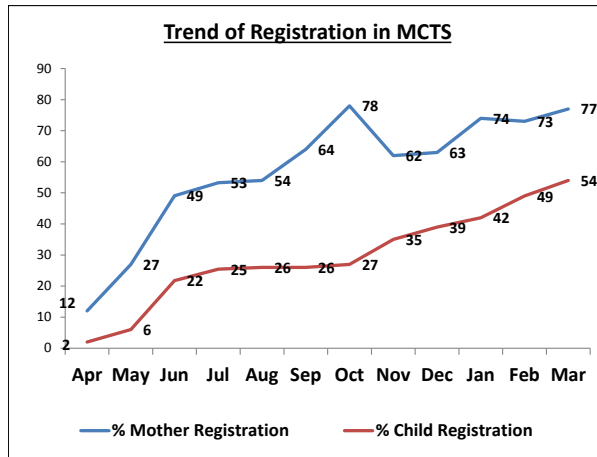
- No. of Live births and BCG given not corresponding in most of the blocks as per the table. Need to be check.
- Usually BCG, OPV0 and Hepatitis B0 doses are given at birth time but reporting shows all three are not given at the time of birth even at facility level showing service gap at facility and need focus monitoring.
- 70.9 % of Infants 0 to 11 months old who received Measles at district reported and 70.7 percent of children 9 and 11 months fully immunized that are reported the equal percentage at district and block, which need to focus to check.
- Three block Fully Immunized child More than Measles Received child. Data need to be recheck in Block validation Committee Meeting.
- Akarabad block Measles and Fully Immunized child reported is more than estimated Live birth. Data Need to be recheck.

➤ **Family Planning:**

- 4 percent couple are using limiting method at District . Need to be Focus .
- 43.5 percent family using spacing method at district while Akrabad block showing more than 80 percent couple using specing method.
- Total 10 percent family planning services provided in district which need to focus on quality of service their recording & reporting.
- Three Block OCP user reported is very low as compare to other block. Need to be focus on Specing Method on those block.

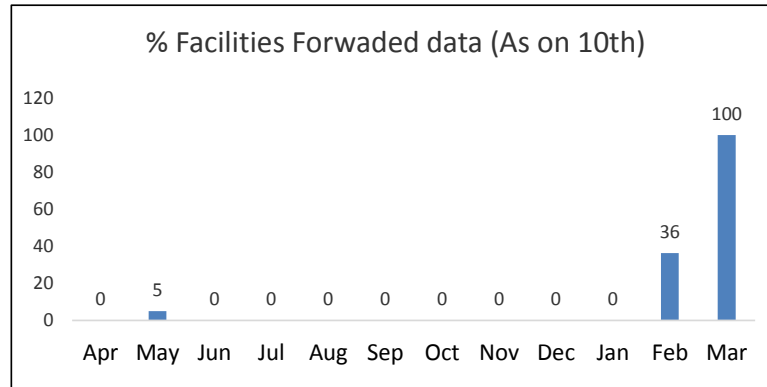
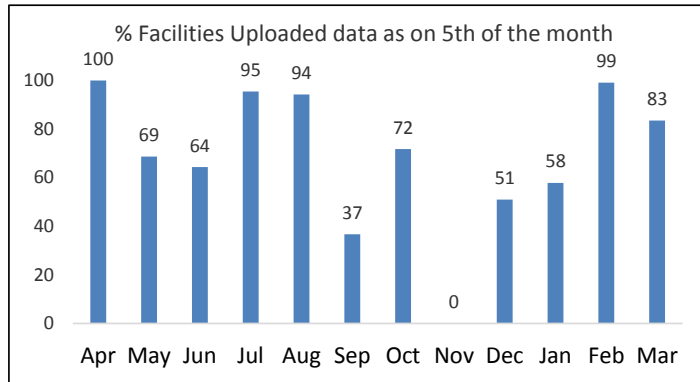

- Aligarh Block Child Registration started. Need to focus on child entry at facility level on MCTS portal
- 2 block namely Gonda and Aligarh Mother Registration in MCTS portal low as compare to other block. Need to focus on daily bases monitoring.
- Mostly block updation on High Risk PW on MCTS Portal is Very Low.
- PW delivered against PW registered with LMP in FY 2015-16 is very low on MCTS portal.
- 3 ANC Services updation in three block Dhanipur, Aligarh and Gagiri is low as compare to other block and one block Aligarh 3 ANC Service Not Updated. Need to be focus on ANC Services updation
- Tappal, Bijauli and Gagiri Block Mother and Child registration in MCTS as ideal Condition but More than 100 % . Data should be recheck
- Mother and Child registration improve April to Feb Month. (Mother 12 to 73 % & Child 2 to 49 %.)
- Mother registration in MCTS is more than HMIS this is a very good indicator but some block registration is very Poor in MCTS Namly Gonda, Dhani pur , Lodha

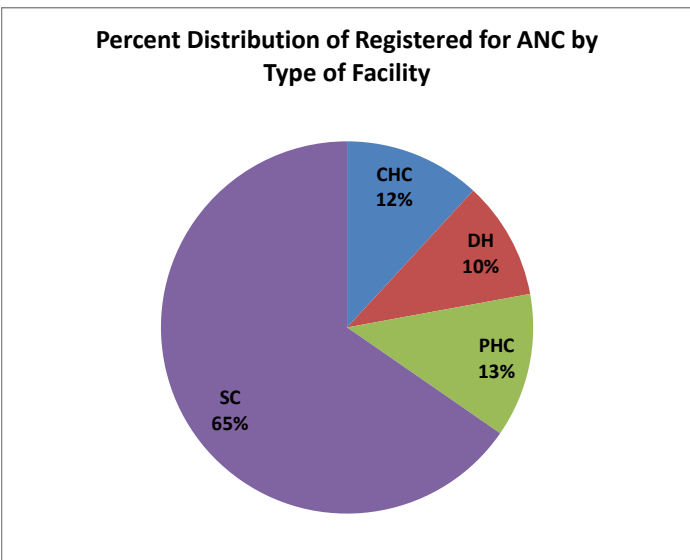
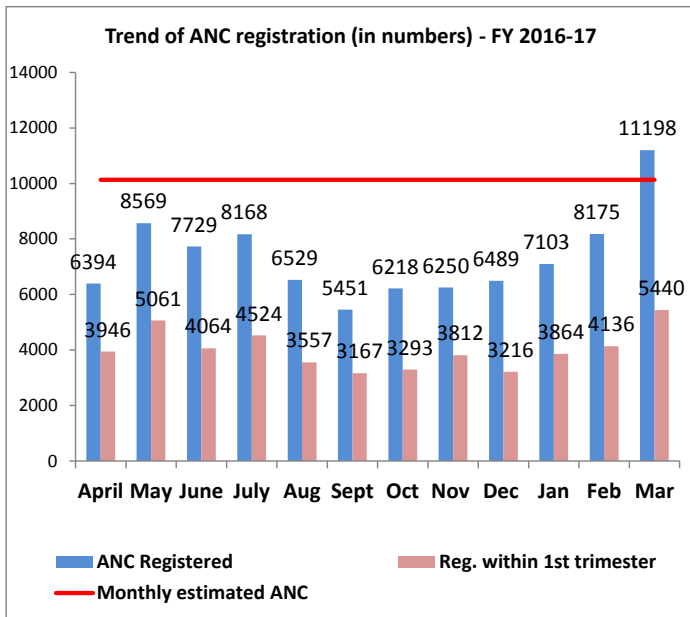

ANC Services Trend, Distribution and progress



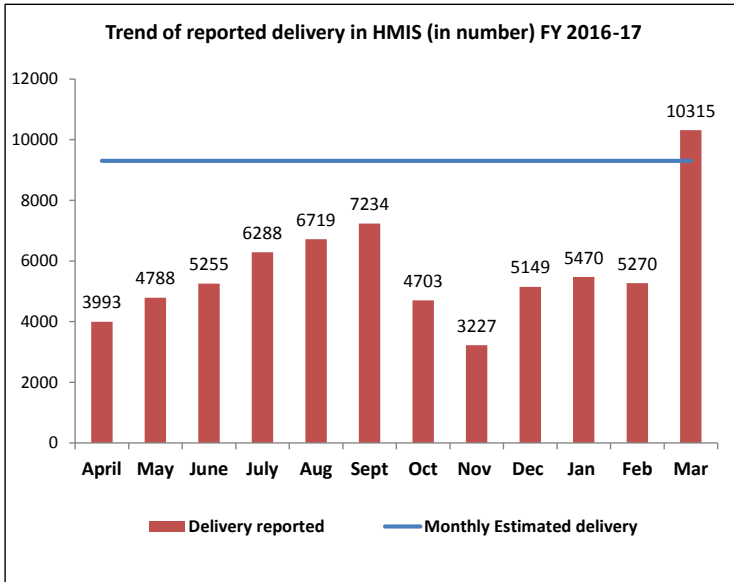

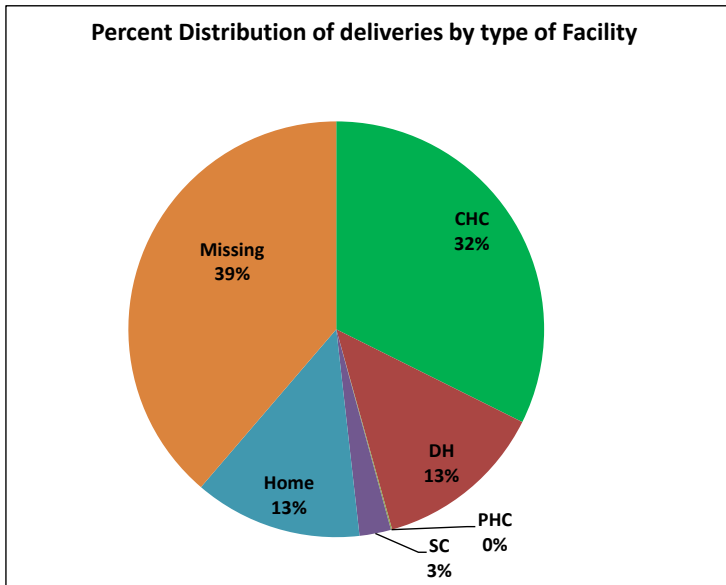

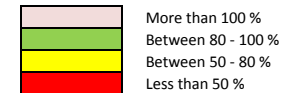

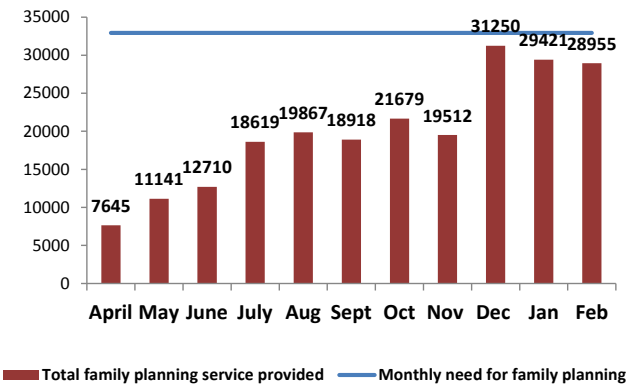

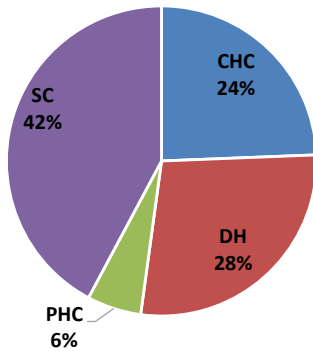


District Aligarh - Family Planning Services Reported in HMIS upto April- March FY 2016-17

Number of Family planning users against need by month



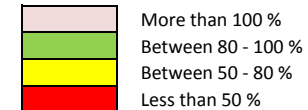
Percent Distributions of new IUD insertions by facility type

- 43.5 percent family using spacing method at district while Akrabad block showing more than 80 percent couple using spacing method.
- Total 10 percent family planning services provided in district which need to focus on quality of service their recording & reporting.
- Three Block OCP user reported is very low as compare to other block. Need to be focus on Spacing Method on those block.
