Summary Sheet



Maternal health :

- ANC Registration Reported in HMIS is 80% which considerably better value from AHS (63%). Contribution of SC in ANC registration is 66% which explicitly reveals good outreach coverage whereas ANC registration in DH is considerably very low (3%). DHQ which consists of DWH and Urban PHC which caters good amount of population but still it is lowest performing.
- As compared to HMIS, MCTS is reporting ANC registration of 66% against estimated upto Mar month which is less than HMIS .This is suggestive of poor MCTS entries by blocks. ANC registration in MCTS in Urban has been initiated only 27% reported. This shows a scope for great improvement.
- Percentage of 3 ANC checkups reported in HMIS (54%) as compared to AHS data (30.5%) which considerably better value. MCTS service updation of 3 ANC is similar from HMIS data (74%).
- Percentage of delivered women discharged within 48 hours is 92 percent while according to AHS data it is 95 percent.
- Percentage of JSY incentive paid to mothers is considerably better in entire district. Baharia and Karchhana blocks are poor performing blocks therefore percentage is low.
- According to AHS 12-13 Home delivery in district is 41%, whereas only 7% home deliveries are being reported, this shows reporting gap. If this gap is covered around 33% missing deliveries can be covered.
- 84% of Missing Delivery in DHQ block because of private facilities are not reporting in DHQ. Need to flag the issue and make a reporting system to cover the missing deliveries in the records.

Child Health:

- Only 0.8% still births are reported from the district. Only 65% blocks are reporting rest of blocks need to be verified .
- Among estimated live births 45% live births are reported in HMIS and 60% in MCTS. Need to address this issue to the particular blocks.
- Breast fed within 1 hours of births are reported 96%, while AHS shows 34.7 %,attracting much attention for policy makers and data need to verify , as per observation of record it has shown that record maintain with only "Yes"

Immunization

- No of Live births and BCG given not corresponding in most of the blocks. Data needs to verify from records available at facility.
- Usually BCG, OPV0 and Hepatitis B0 doses are given at birth time but data shows that all three are not given at the time of birth even at DH and CHCs, it is showing service gap at facility and need focus monitoring.
- Full Immunization in MCTS is near by the HMIS .

Family Planning

- IUD insertion is only 22% at CHC,while 8% in DH.Major contribution is from SC.
- Koraon, Dhanupur, Saidabad and Uruwa blocks should improve data in spacing method.

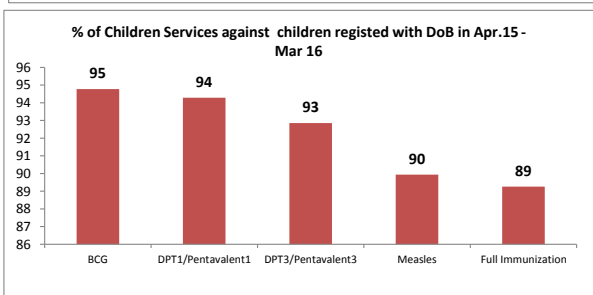
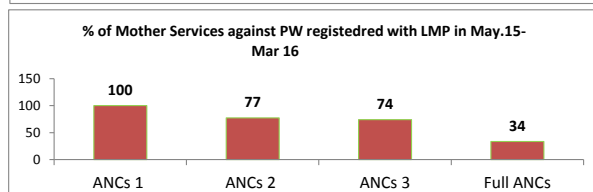
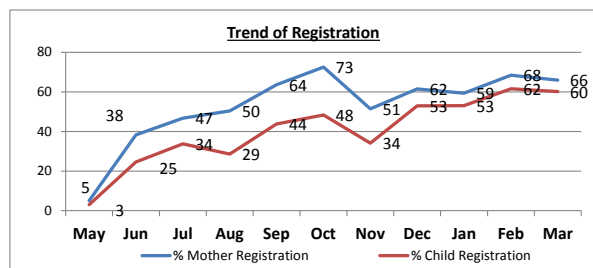

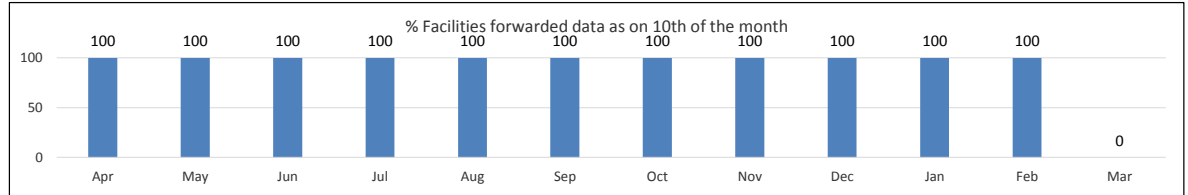
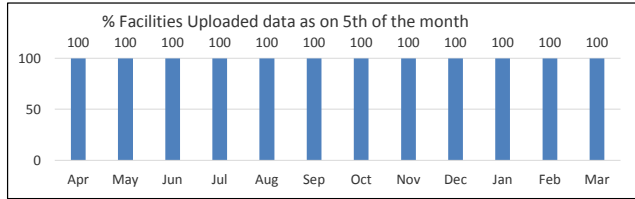


- % of mother registration is very low and compare with HMIS it's only 66% which is need to be improve.

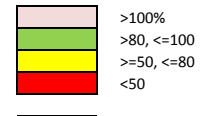
1. ANC registration of dist. is 80% although AHS 2012-13 showing ANC registration 62.9%.
2. ANC Registration in 1st trim. is 59% which is reported approx equal to AHS 12-13 (58) while 50% of blocks is reported below 50% in 1st trimester registration.
3. % of ANC received 3 ANC check up is 54% which is more reported from AHS 12-13 (30.5%). Pratappur is poor performing block it's shown only 30%.

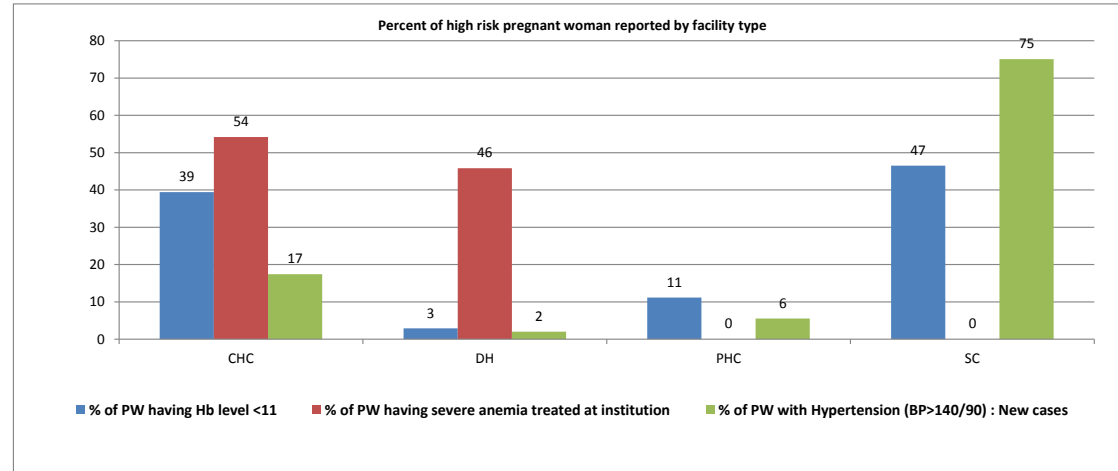
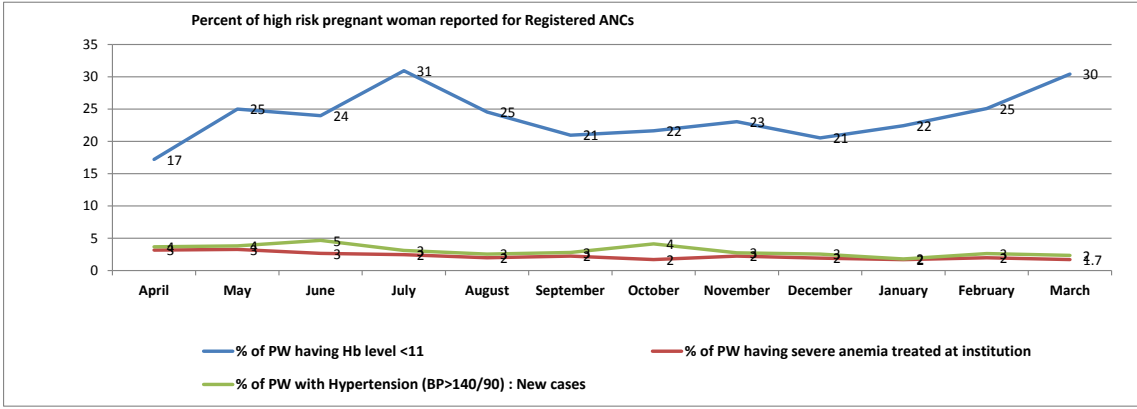

- 2- Percentage of delivered women discharged within 48 hours is 92 percent while according to AHS data it is 95 percent. Data needs to check and verify.
- 3- Distribution of delivery across facility is almost similar figure i.e. CHC 18%, PHC 3%, SC 13% respectively, which is against the guidelines. This data needs to verify from base records.
- 4- % of JSY incentive paid to mothers is very less in Baharia and Karchhana in this month.

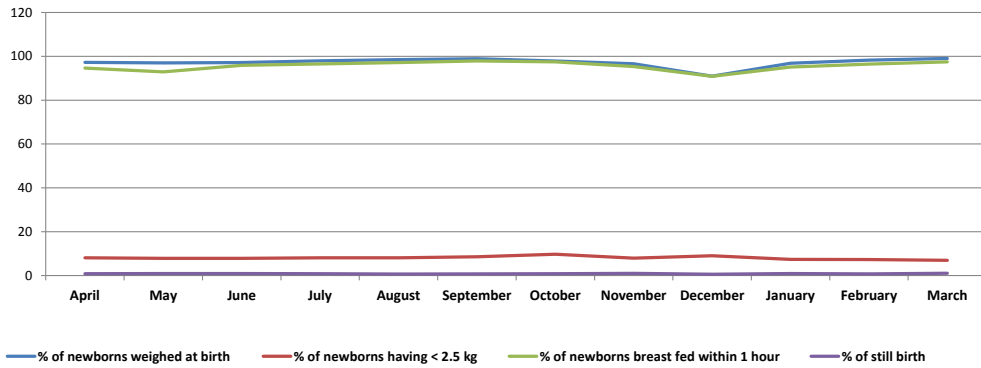

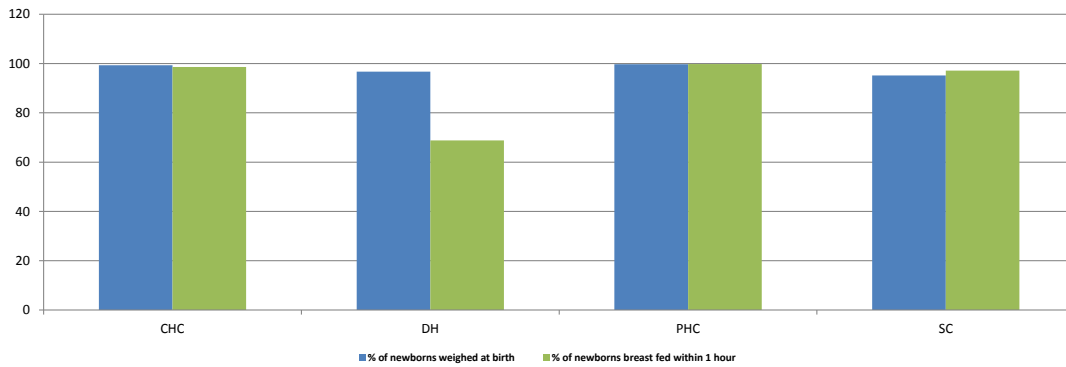

Trend in Child care services (in Percent)



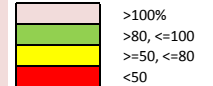
Child care services by facility type (In Percent)



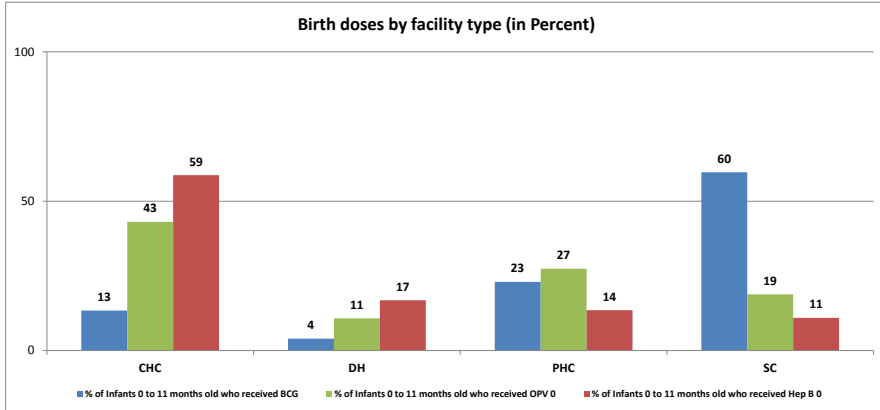
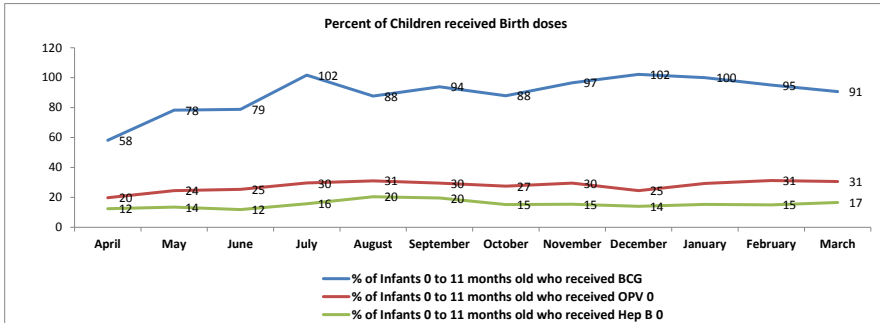

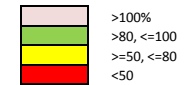
Allahabad - Immunisation Services Reported in HMIS during FY 2016-17 (Up to Mar)

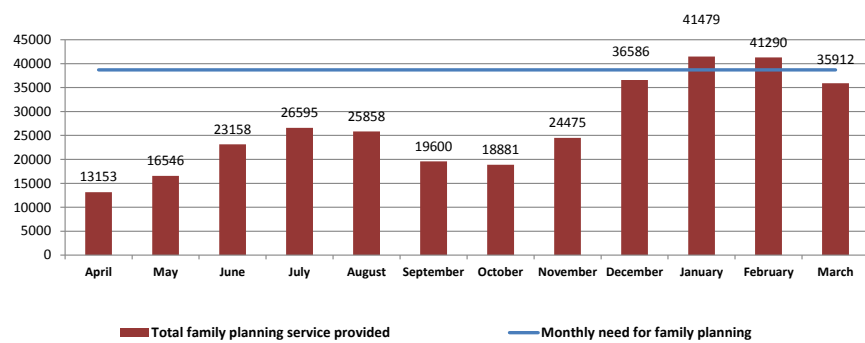
- 1- No of Live births and BCG given not corresponding in most of the blocks. Data needs to verify from records available at facility.

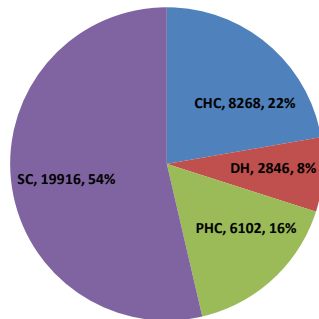

Number of Family planning users against need by month



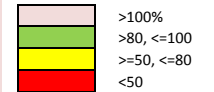
Percent Distributions of new IUD insertions by facility type
