ANC Services Trend, Distribution and progress



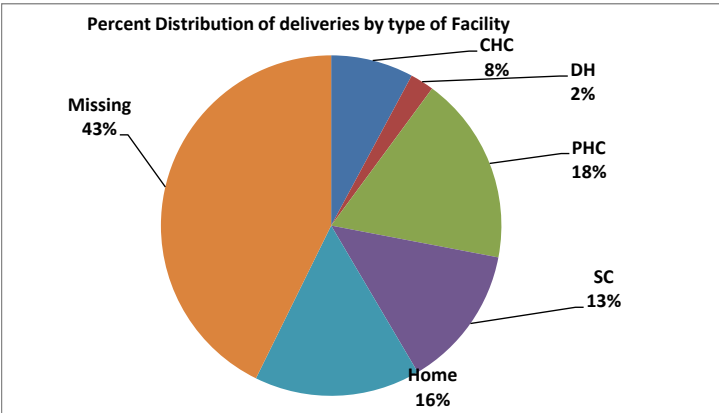
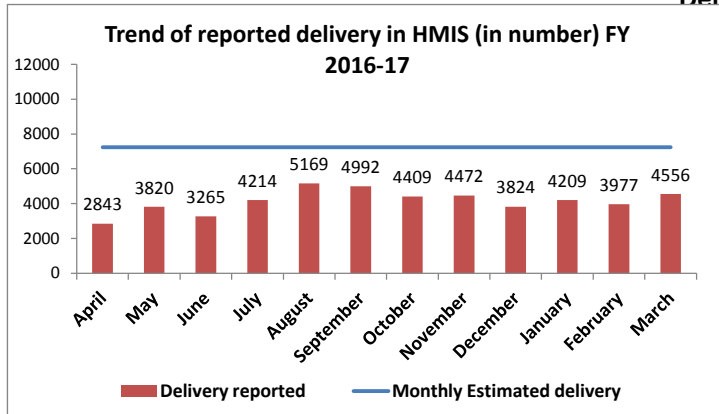

- 2- ANC Registration in 1st trim. is 40% against 56% registration which is reported less as compared to AHS 12-13. almost all blocks are below 50%. Strategies should be planned to improve it.
- 3- % of ANC received 3 ANC checkup is 60% which is higher than AHS 12-13(42.6%).

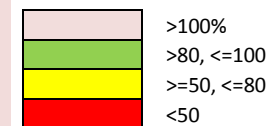

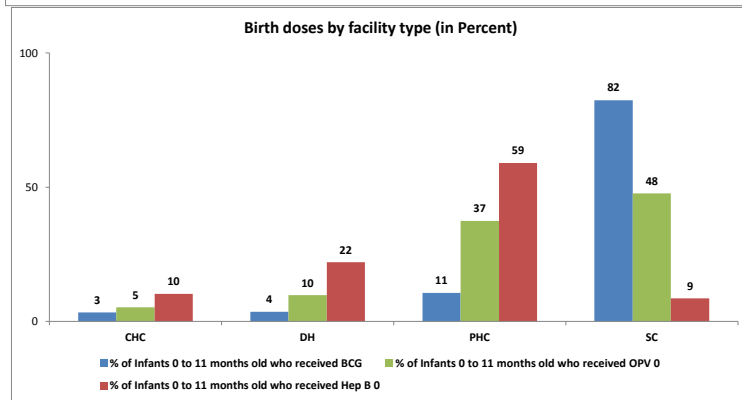
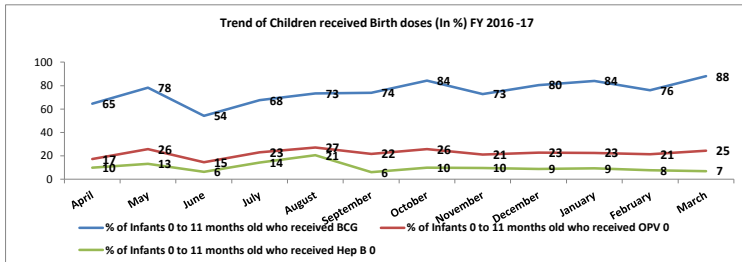
Gaps in Child care :

- 97% births are reported as breast fed within 1 hours of births, it is need to check as AHS 2012-13 showing data for Hardoi is 29.5% only.
- In Ballia 97% children weight at birth and 5.7% LBW among them while AHS 12-13 estimated this as 26% & 22% respectively.

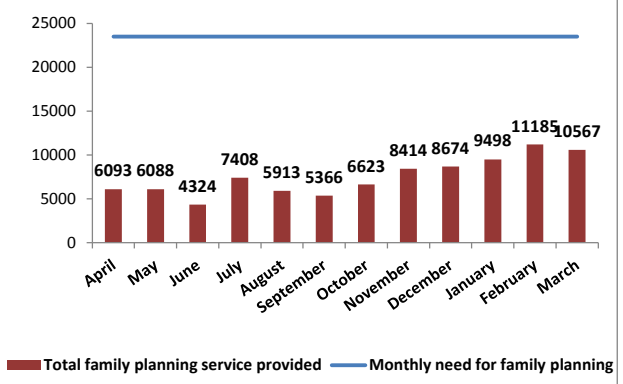

It is noticeable that 65% of children between 9 to 11 months are fully immunized while other vaccines except measles are very low.

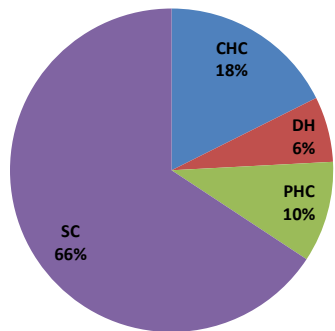


District Ballia - Family Planning Services Reported in HMIS upto (April-March) FY 2016-17

Number of Family planning users against need by month



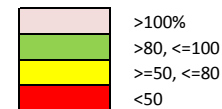
Percent Distributions of new IUD insertions by facility type

- 66% of total IUCD perform at subcenter till month so quality and quantity should be a concern to all Family planning managers.
- Achievement of limiting method is 2.36% , and it needs to develop some strategies to improve the services in the district.
