2- ANC Registration in 1st trim. is 46% which is reported more than to AHS 12-13 i.e. 100%. accept Block Duleliya rest blocks reported poor performance PW registration in 1st trimester

3- % of ANC received 3 ANC checkup is 76% which is more than double of AHS 12-13(32%). only 60% ANC conducted @ SC so record of 3 ANC need to check.

- 1-85% deliveries reported against the total estimated deliveries, needs to report rest missing deliveries.(1351 SC s are reported zero from April to Decemerr,16)
- 2-85% deliveries are reported as institutional out of total deliveries(it is 48% against the total estimated deliveries)
- 3-9% deliveries conducted at Home and 38% deliveries are not reported against the estimated deliveries.
- 4- More than 87% mothers discharge under 48 hrs of delivery in from 10 blocks district and AHS 12-13 measure it 79.8% in the same district. need to check data
- 5-5 blocks reported more then 50% missing deliveries and Vikramjot and Vikram jot reported highse tmising deliveries more than 60%

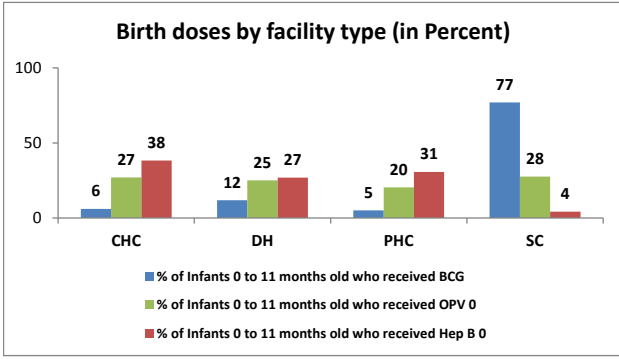
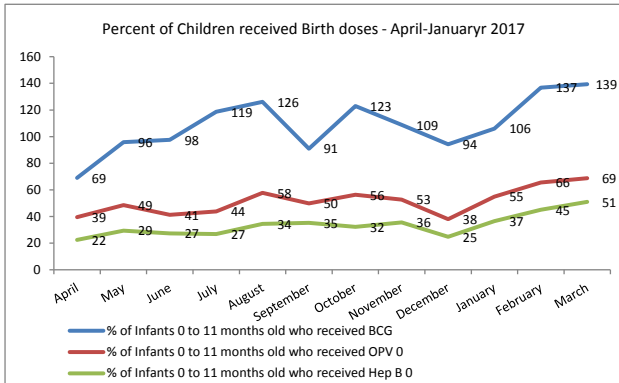
### Gaps in Child care :

- In Basti 91% children weight at birth and of which 19% LBW while AHS 12-13 estimated this as 12%&27.% respectively.

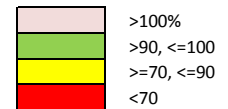

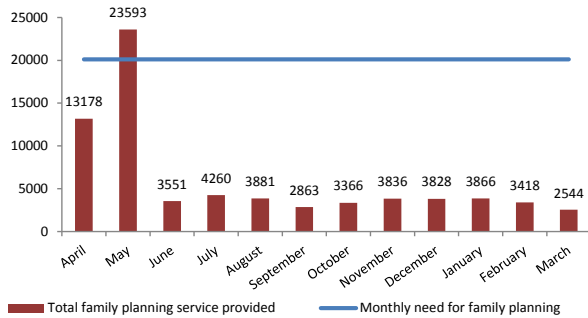
Gaps in Immunization :

- No of Live births and BCG given not corresponding in most of the blocks as per the table and reporting aprox. double or > double I or live births (Home deliveries not reported need to be checked accurately).
- Only Shaughat 5.7, Bhadurpur, 11% and Vikram Jot 0.4% it very low Hep-B-0 dose to the total live births and rest blocks were not able to do so.
- Usually BCG, OPV0 and Hepatitis B0 doses are given at birth time but reporting shows all three are not given at the time of birth even at DH and CHCs, it is showing service gap at facility and need focus monitoring.

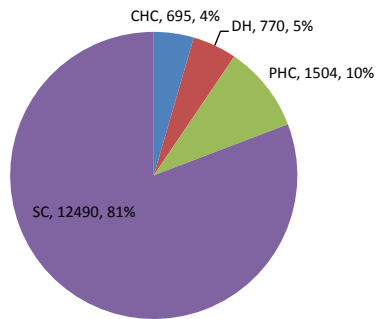


## Basti April to March,2017 Family planning trends Distribution and progress

**Number of Family planning users against need by month**

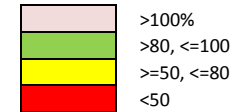


**Percent Distributions of new IUD insertions by facility type**
