#### Gaps in Deliveries :-


Total delivery reported by Dist is 39% in over the period i.e. more than half of the Deliveries are missing in reporting.

Institutional Del against estimated dilevery is 27% whereas AHS shows 54%, Home diliveries are not reported adequately in HMIS reported only 12% to estimated

DWH Deliveries are included in Bulandshahar. Reporting of PVT is 0%, there is an opportunity gap in pvt & Home del reporting.due to that Missing deliveries are showing high.

Discharge with in 48Hrs is 58% means that 42% of delivered women's are staying at facility after delivery whereas AHS shows 91% of women are receiving PNC within 48 at facility so data is not same need to check.



#### Gaps in HRP :

PW having HB level<11 against estimated PW is 34%, but Khurja has reported more than 100 % cases of Hb< 11, needs to verify. Most of the cases are checked and treated at DH and CHC level facility so these are showing very high.

PW having HB level<7 is less than 1% of Dist., 4 Blocks of dist. are reported 0% over the period. Bulandshahar not reported adequately as it's consist DH.

Hypertension cases are 6%. some Block are reporting very low which are need to monitor services or check availability and use of BP instrupents.



however, some of Blocks are reported treatment of complications like IV oxytocics and IV antihypertensive not corresponding with complication.

% C-Section reported 1% other CHCs of Block are not performing C-Section. need to check data wherever C-Section has Conducted.

Child care services trend (In Percent)







% of BCG is Reported to estimated is 78%, most of the BCG are reported by SC level facilities it's as per protocol. HB0 dose are reported only 24% against estimated facility wise distribution of HB0 shows that most of HB dose are reported from CHC & PHC level facilities which is as per protocol becacuse HB0 dose should be given by facility before 24 hrs of del. Inst. delivery of dist is 27% but HB 0 23% it's seems service not given to all NB. although 4% of Newborns are left out.

4% HB0 reported by SC level facility which is good if service is available. Measles doses are reported 77% to estimated by Dist. AHS is 71 so needs to check for reporting gap and data. Full immunization is 71% AHS shows 58%.
