C S M Nagar - Immunisation Services Reported in HMIS during FY 2016-17 - March Child Immunization trends, Distribution and progress



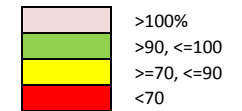

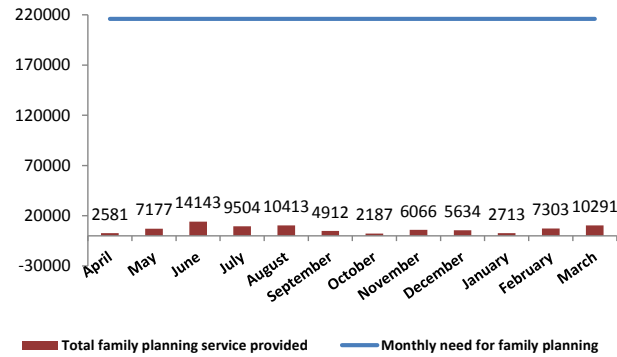

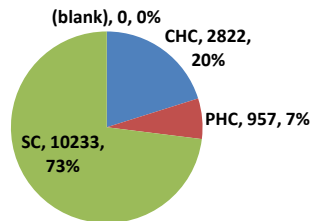

Number of Family planning users against need by month



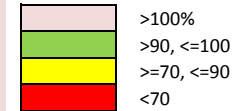
