- Maternal Health

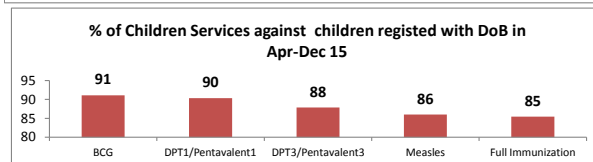
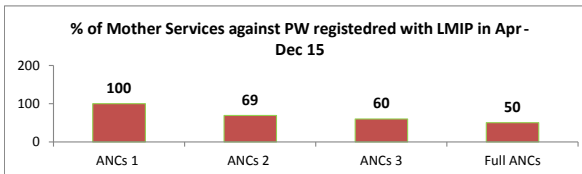
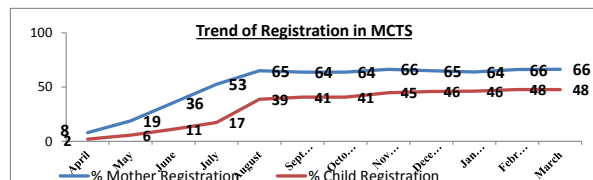
- ANC registration against estimation is 73 for district which is near by AHS (76.6%) while Mother Registration in MCTS is only 66%. Need to focus on MCTS also.
- 1st Trimester registration for district is 38% and as per AHS it is 45.6%.
- 3 ANC checkup of pregnant woman is 49% for district and it is near by AHS-35.4%.
- 50% delivery not captured by district against estimation.
- Institution delivery against reported delivery is 82% while JSY incentive paid to mother is 86%. Block Chaniya , Dhanpur and Naugar paid more than 100% incentive of JSY, Data need to check and verify. Mohter discharge under 48 hours is 71%.

- Child Health

- 50% delivery reported against estimation for district and 10% Home delivery.
- Identification of less than 2.5 kg new born is less (8.1% for district) compare to AHS (23.3%)
- New born breastfed within one hours is 99% for district while as per AHS it is 27.4%.

Registration and Update



- Mother Registration is slightly improved from April (8%) to Dec (66%).
- Updation of HRP is only 1% while HMIS is showing 46%.

ANC Services Trend, Distribution and progress



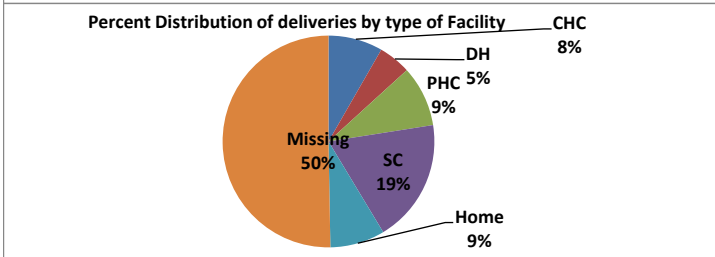
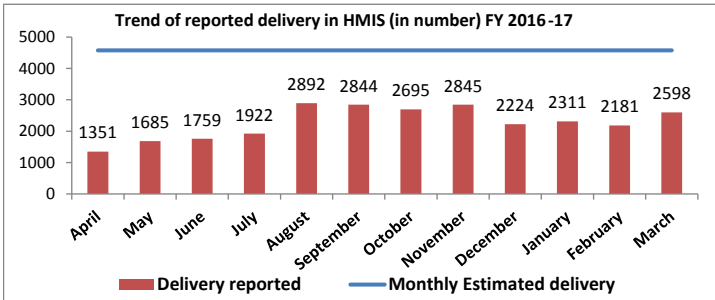

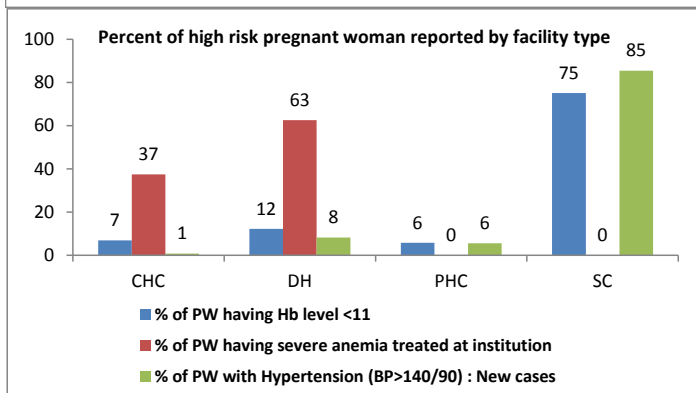
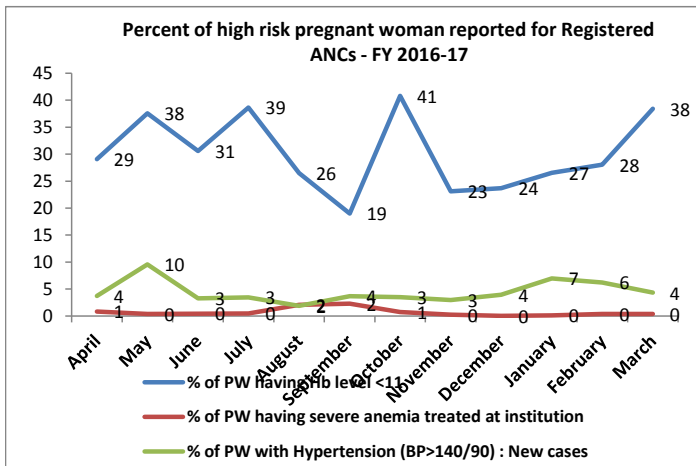
Gaps in Deliveries :-

- 1-50 % deliveries reported against the total estimated deliveries, needs to report rest missing deliveries.
- 2-83 % deliveries are reported as institutional out of total deliveries(it is 41% against the total estimated deliveries) although AHS 2012-13 reported for district is 61%
- 3-9% deliveries conducted at Home and 50% deliveries are not reported against the estimated deliveries.
- 4-72 % mothers discharge under 48 hrs of delivery in Chandauli district.

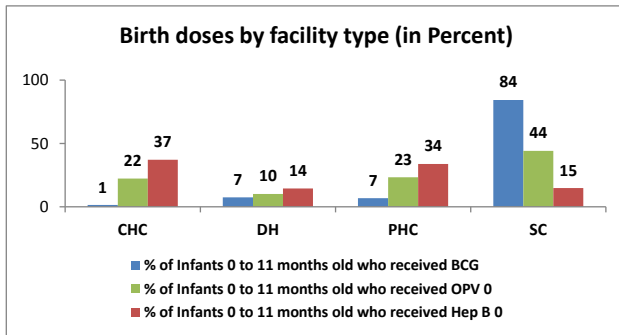
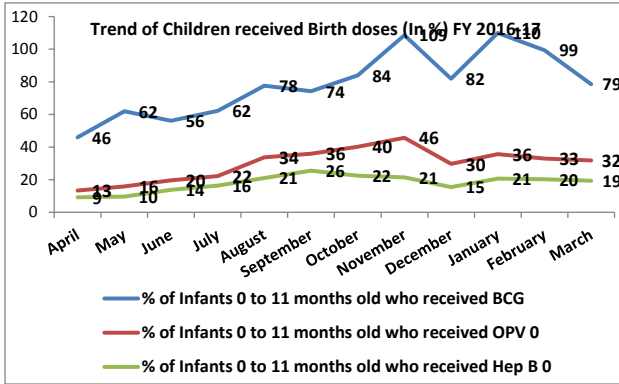
Gaps in Child care :

- 99% births are reported as breast fed within 1 hours of births, it is need to check as AHS 2012-13 showing data for Varanasi is 27.4% only.
- In Chandauli 99% new borns are weight at birth and 8% LBW among them while AHS 12-13 estimated this as 33% & 23.3% respectively.

Gaps in Immunization :

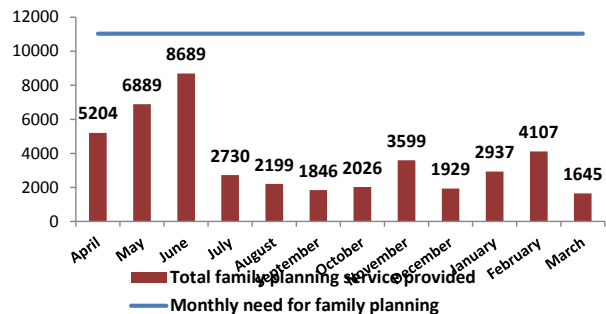

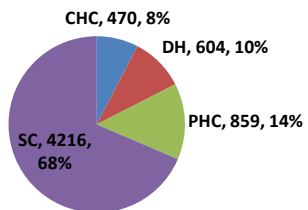

Number of Family planning users against need by month



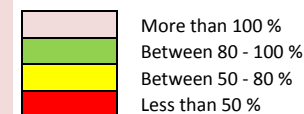
Percent Distributions of new IUD insertions by facility type

- Achievement of Spacing method is more than 100 % in Naugarh while limiting method services is just 9%.
