Mother and child registrations on MCTS portal are poor against the registraion of the same in HMIS. 74% of pregnant women got registration in HMIS & 59% mothers registered in MCTS. 57% child got registered on MCTS portal against 54% registerd child on HMIS & district require to take proper steps for registration of child on MCTS portal and in HMIS too. Updation of full ANCs is only 38% in MCTS and the same of full immunization is 91% in HMIS.

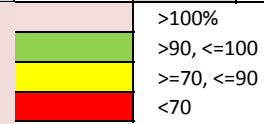

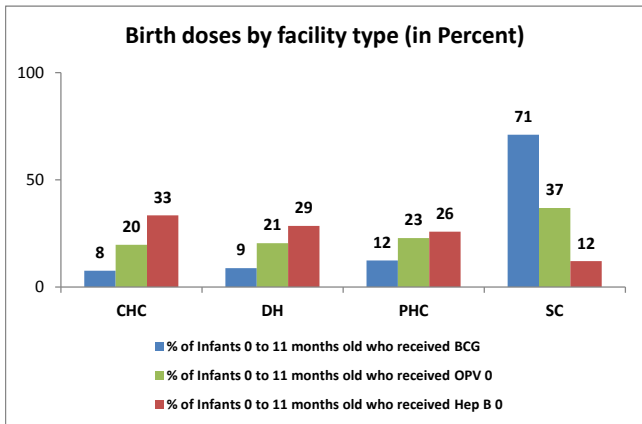
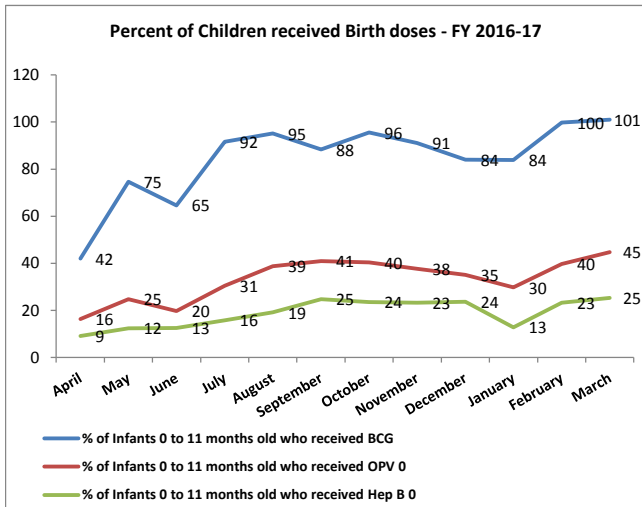
**Gaps in Child care**

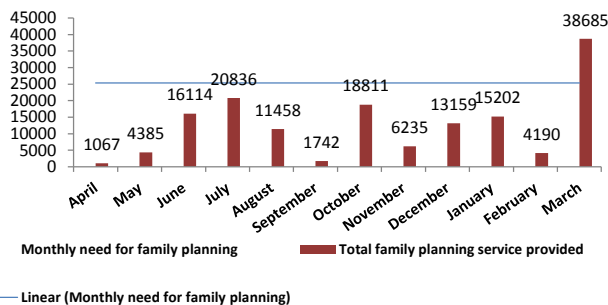
- BCG coverage is 75% in the district and deoria sader coverage is more than 100%.

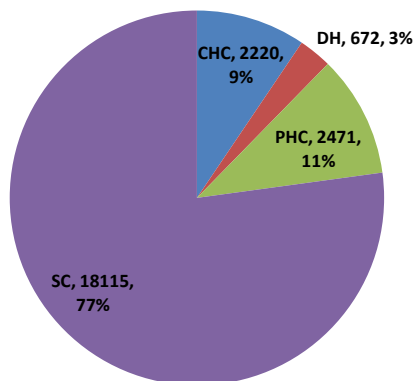

**Percent Distributions of new IUD insertions by facility type**



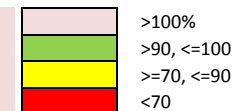

Achievement of spacing method is only 61%.

-Majority of IUD insertions are taking place at SC. There are two blocks where there is no IUD insertion at all.
