➤ **Maternal health :**

- ANC registration is more reported as compare to AHS 2012-13.
- Jalesar, Marhara, Skit and Jaithra Block ANC registration More than Estimated. data need to recheck
- PW registered within first trimester is less reporting as compare to AHS 2012-13
- DHQ and Skit Block % of 3 ANC is less reproting as compare to other block. Need to be focus.
- 78 % of registered PW for ANC at SC that shows out reach Services is implemented properly.
- 24 % deliveries conducted at Home and 39 percent of deliveries are not reported in HMIS.
- Only 37 % of deliveries are reported in DH, CHC, PHC, and SC in Up to March 2017 but District Institutional Dilivery is 56.1 % as per AHS 2012-13.
- Nidholi Kala block only 41 % and Awagarh only 52 % of delivery are reporting. Need to founs
- Number discharged under 48 hours of delivery is very high in Nidholikala, Jaithra, Skit and Sitalpur Block reporting as compare to other block.
- Three block JSY Incentive paid to mothers is very low Namly Sitalpur, N. Kalan and DHQ total district only 62.1 % of Mothers paid to incentive of JSY in Up to March 2017.
- Aliganj and Skit block Home Delivery are more rpted as compare to Delivery at facility. Need to be focus on instituional Delivery.
- Aliganj, Awagarh, and Sakit block % of institutional deliveries is very low.
- 6 Block not reporting any Severe anaemia PW treated at Institution
- DHQ block Pregnant women with Hypertension (BP>140/90) : New cases Only 43 repored on HMIS portal up to March 2017.
- DHQ Block PW Hb level<11 (tested cases) is more than PW registered . data need to be Check
- Marhara and Sitalpur Block PW with Hypertension (BP>140/90) New Case is very low reported as compare to other block.
- Two block not reported PW with Complication in public facility
- DHQ Block 206 reported Complication treaded PW Attended at Facility and 230 with IV anitibotics and 231 with IV Oxytocics treated. Data Need to be Check.
- 71 C-Section reported on HMIS Portal up to March 2017 and Nidholikala block 2 C-Section Reported in PHC Level in August Month . Data need to recheck.
- Only 4 % complication reported in HMIS portal Up to March 2017.

➤ **Child Health:**

- No. of still birth reported in respect to live birth is 1.5 percent in the district. Marhara block only 17 reported a number of still birth up to March 2017.
- Nidholikala and Jaithra Block still Birth persent is very high. Need to be check.
- Aliganj, Sitalpur & Awagarh block still birth % is low as compare to district %.
- Weight at birth and breastfed with in one Hour is very high as compare to AHS 2012-13
- "Total Deliveries is =< Live birth + Still Birth" but Two Block(Sitalpur and Jaithra) not follow this validation rule. Need to be focus in Block Validation committee at Block level.
- Shitalpur block Newborns having weight less than 2 and half kg only 27 Child reported in HMIS portal up to March 2017. Data need to be recheck

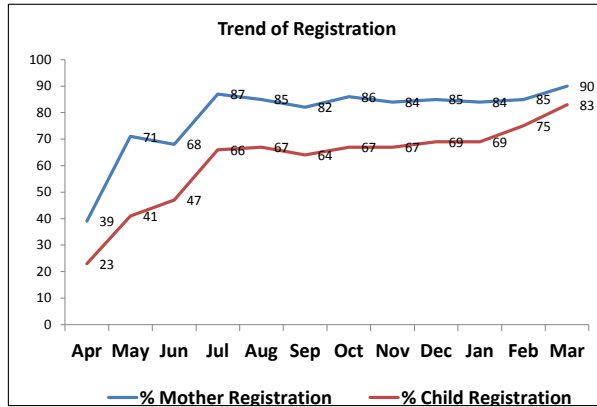
➤ **Immunization**

- DHQ, Marhara, Jaithra and Sakit Block BCG reported more than estimated live birth. Data need to be focus.
- Usually BCG, OPV0 and Hepatitis B0 doses are given at birth time but reporting shows all three are not given at the time of birth even at facility level showing service gap at Facility and need focus on monitoring.
- Jaithra, Awagarh and Marhara block report more than 100 percent of Infants 0 to 11 months old who received Measles . Data need to be rechack
- Most of the Block reporting more than 90% children 9 to 11 months fully immunized , Data need to be rechack.
- DHQ Block Fully Immunization Child More then Reported to child received Measals. Data need to be recheck.

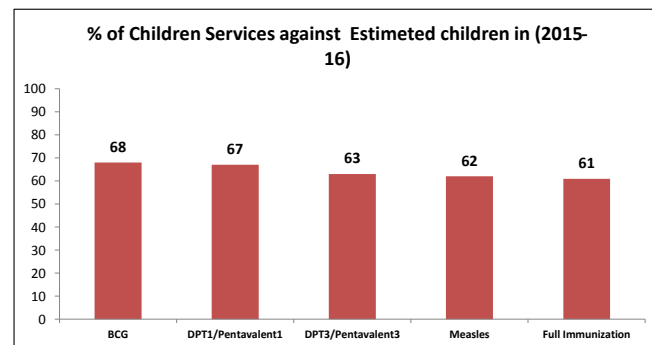
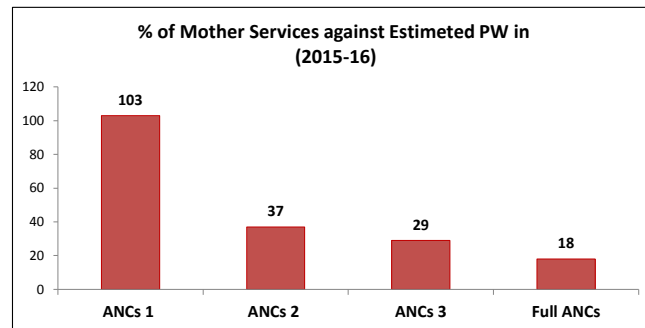
➤ **Family Planning**

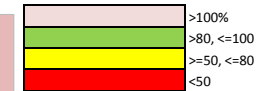

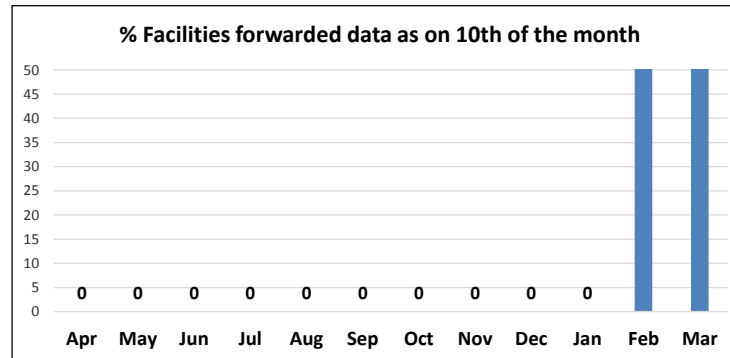
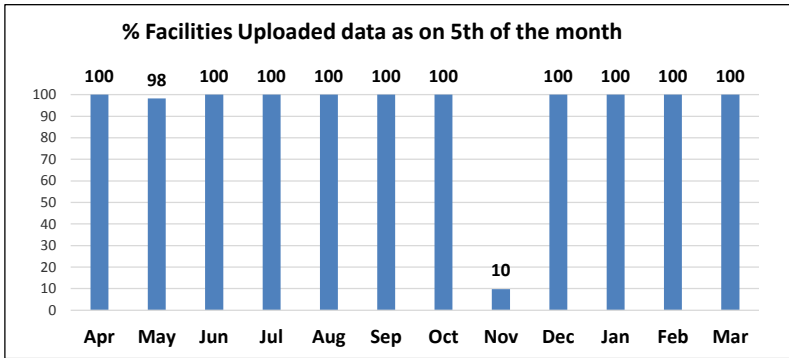
- Up to March Mother registration is 90 % but HMIS portal Shows Mother registered 100 %

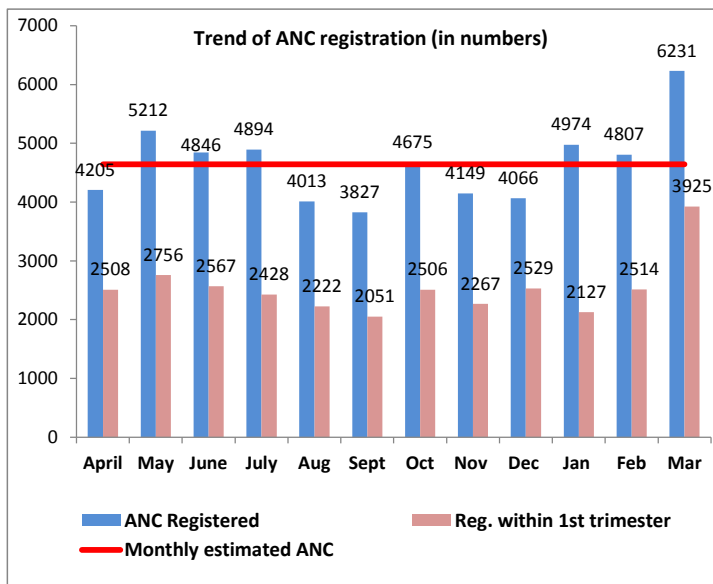

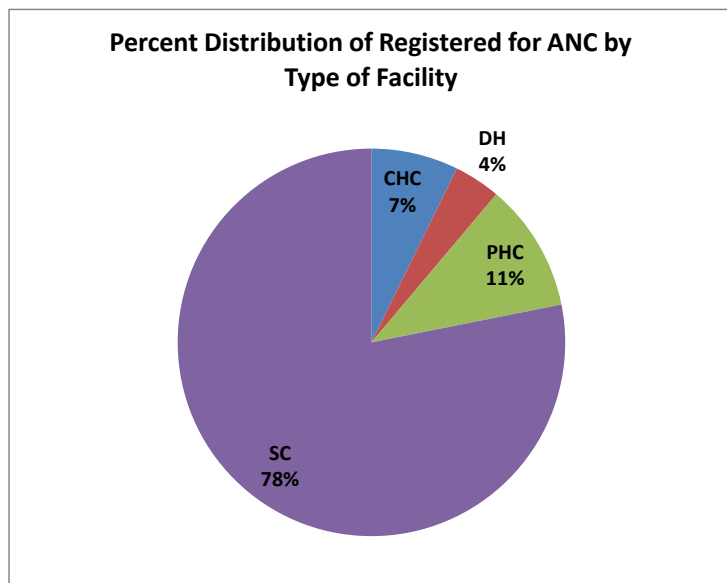

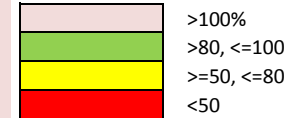

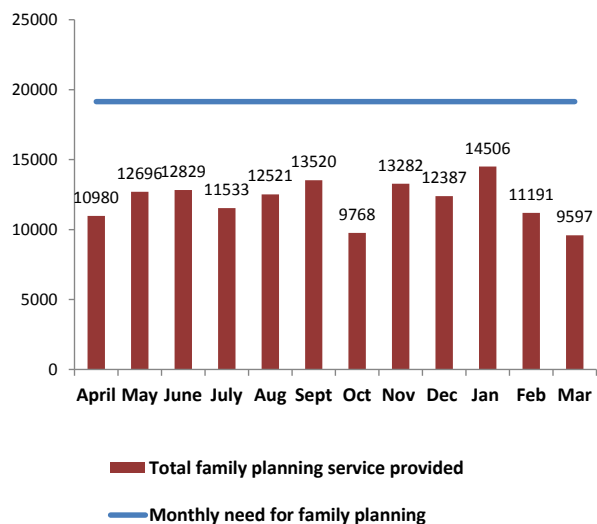

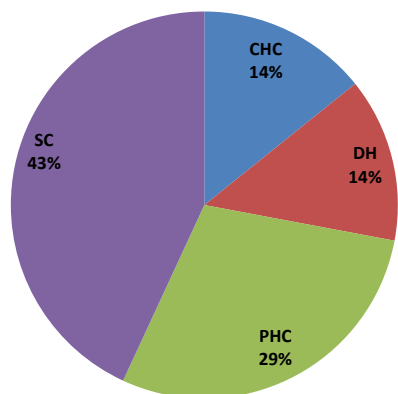

Number of Family planning users against need by month



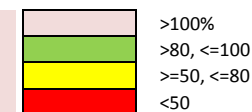
