Summary Sheet



Maternal health :

- Percentage of 3 ANC checkups reported in HMIS (62%) as compared to AHS data (33.39) is high which raises an issue of over reporting. Data needs to be verified. MCTS service updation of 3 ANC is also moderate (53%), need to be kept on priority.
- TT2/Booster coverage is also high in DHQ block which is need to be verified.
- According to AHS Home delivery in district is 26.7%, whereas only 16% home deliveries are being reported, this shows reporting gap.
- HRPs are not tracking or reporting in MCTS.

Child Health:

- Percentage Newborn weight at birth reported by district is 96% where as in AHS it is 33% , difference is more than double which is suggestive of over reporting.
- Among estimated live births 56% live births are reported in HMIS and only 57% in MCTS. All blocks having difference in HMIS and MCTS ,need to address this issue to the particular blocks

Immunization

- Immunization of birth dose is detreating i.e. BCG 69% since it can be administered till one year, OPV0 is 40% and HepB0 is 33%. Thus it reflects that birth doses are not given at higher facility level like CHC and DH where antigens are available 24X7. Need to address the issue to the MOIC.

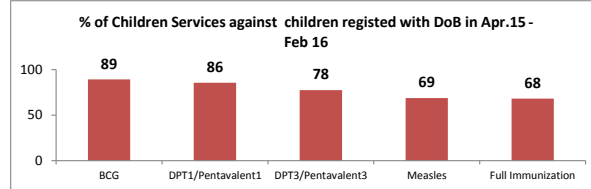
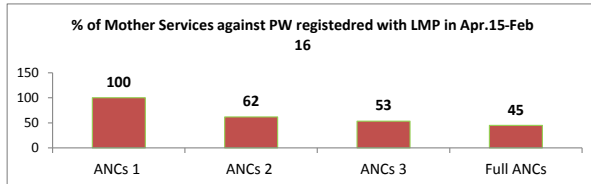
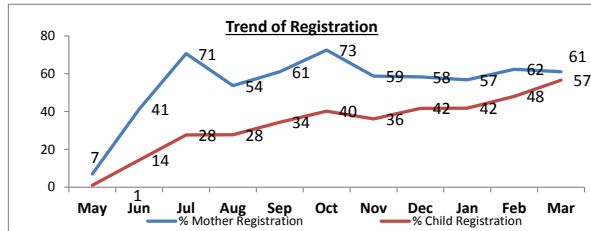
Family Planning

- Number of IUD insertion is very low but need to focus to increase the service & utilization at Sub center & CHC because mostly couple accept IUD for family planning from SC & CHC.
- IUD Insertions coverage is low in Bithaura and Haswa blocks.

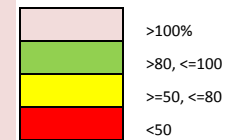
Fatehpur - ANC Services Reported in HMIS during FY 2016-17 (Upto Mar)
ANC Services, Trends, Distribution and Performance



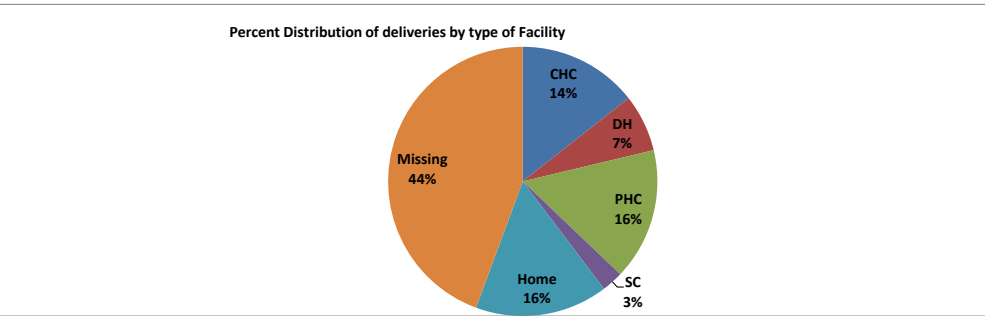
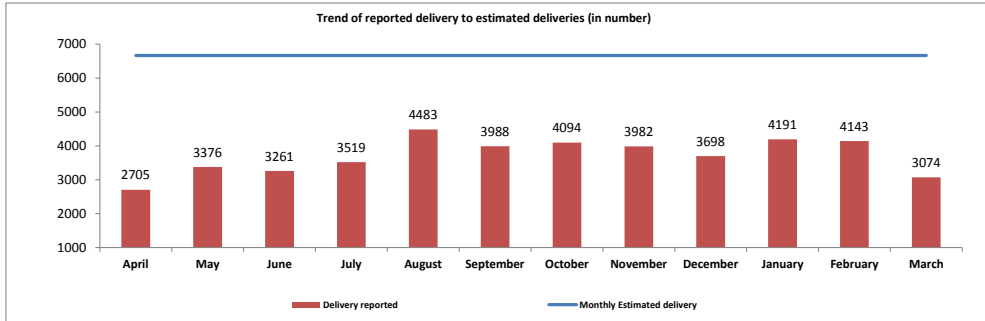

- ANC Registration in 1st trim. is 59% which is reported more than to AHS 12-13 (49%)
- % of ANC received 3 ANC check up is 62% which is more reported from AHS 12-13(33.9%).

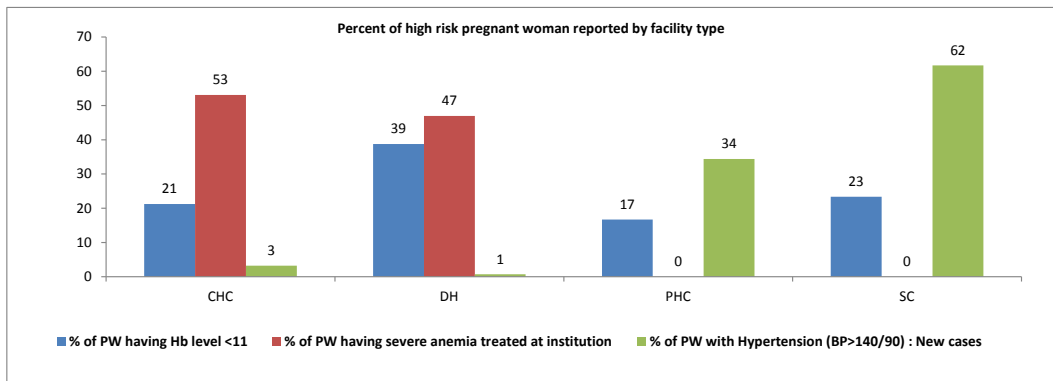
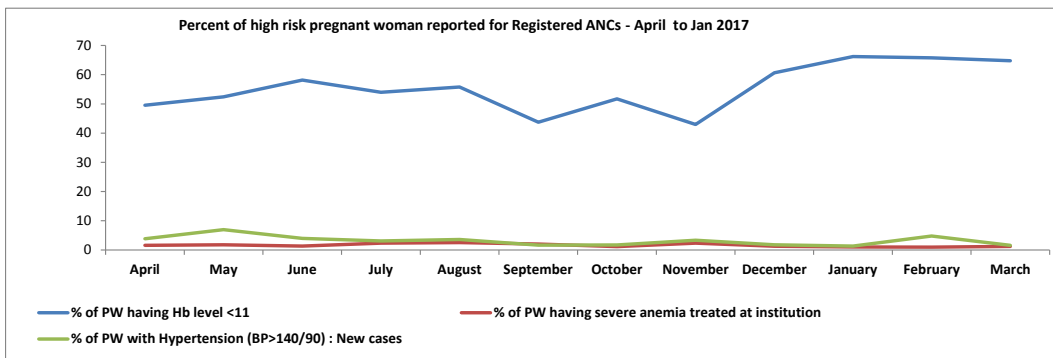

Gaps in Deliveries :-

- 1- Percentage of institutional delivery is 71% while AHS data shows 58%, which needs to check.
- 2- Percentage of delivered women discharged within 48 hours is 90 percent while according to AHS data it is 59 percent. Data needs to check and verify.
- 3- Distribution of delivery across facility is almost similar figure i.e.CHC 14%,PHC 16%,SC 3% respectively, which is against the guidelines. This data needs to verify from base records .
- 4- % of JSY incentive paid to mothers in hathgam block shows only 29% which need to verify .

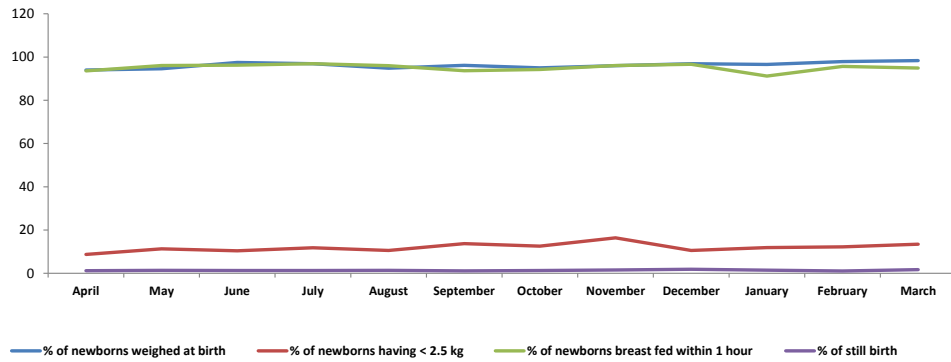

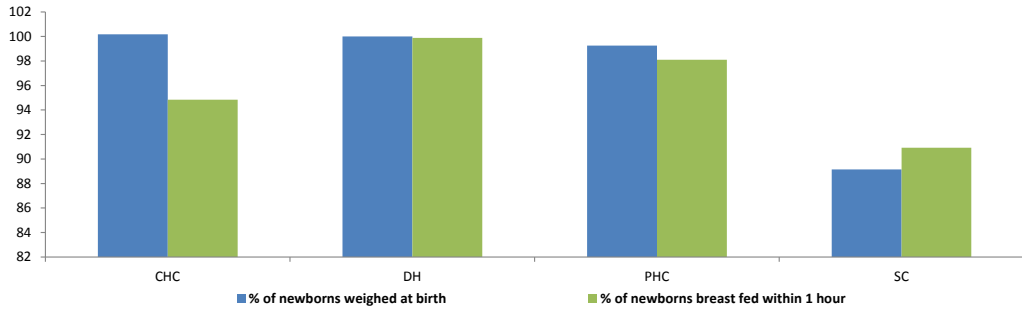

Trend in Child care services (in Percent)



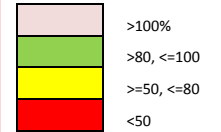
Child care services by facility type (In Percent)



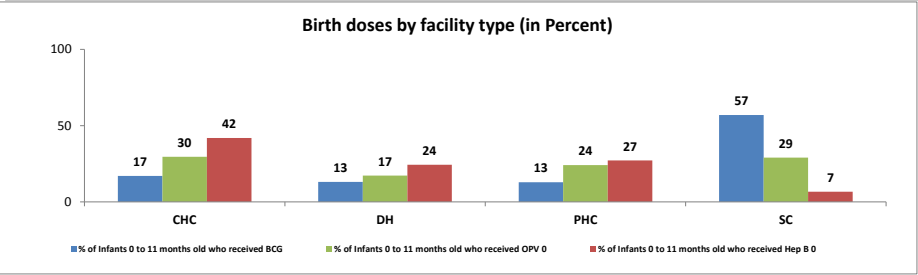
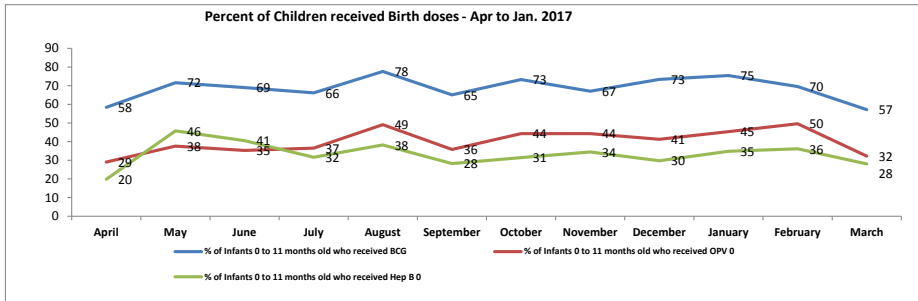

Gaps in Child care :

- Only 1.4% of still births are reported from the district.
- 95% births are reported as breast fed within 1 hours of births, while AHS shows 51.4 %,attracting much attention for policy makers.
- Only 12% of newborn having <2.5 k.g are reported, while AHS shows 22.8 % which is need to check and verify.
- 96% of newborns weighed at birth are reported but AHS shows only 33.8 % attracting much attention for policy makers. DHQ blocks are reported more than 100%.



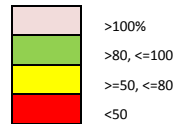

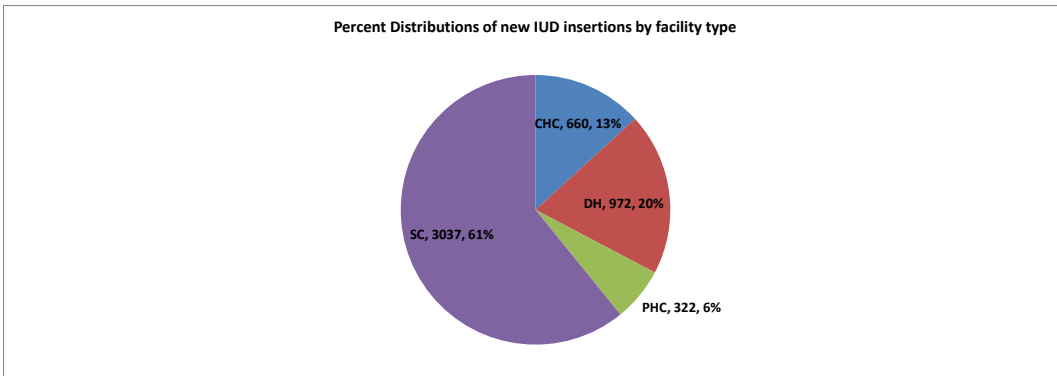
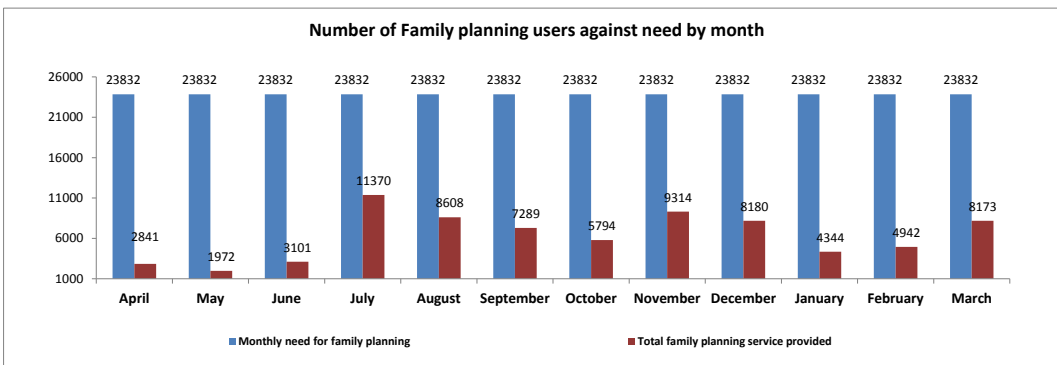
Gaps in Immunization :

- 1- No of Live births and BCG given not corresponding in most of the blocks. Data needs to verify from records available at facility.
- 2- Usually BCG, OPV0 and Hepatitis B0 doses are given at birth time but data shows that all three are not given at the time of birth even at DH and CHCs, it is showing service gap at facility and need focus monitoring.
- 3- % of Infants 0 to 11 months old who received Hep B 0 and Measles is more reported in DHQ block which is need to be checked and verified.

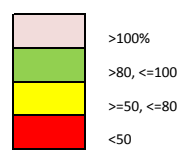

- IUD insertion is only 13% at CHC, while 20% in DH. Major contribution is from DH and SC.
- Hathgam, Gopalganj, Haswa and Khjuha blocks should improve data in spacing method.
- 43% blocks are not conducting Female Sterilization.
