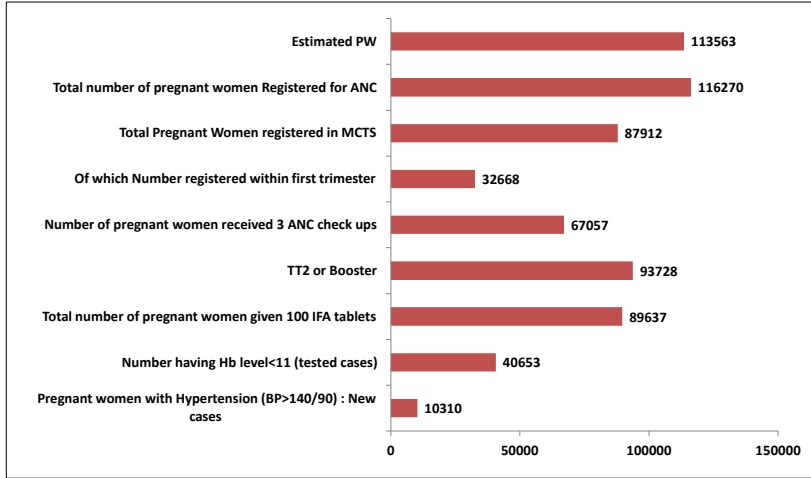

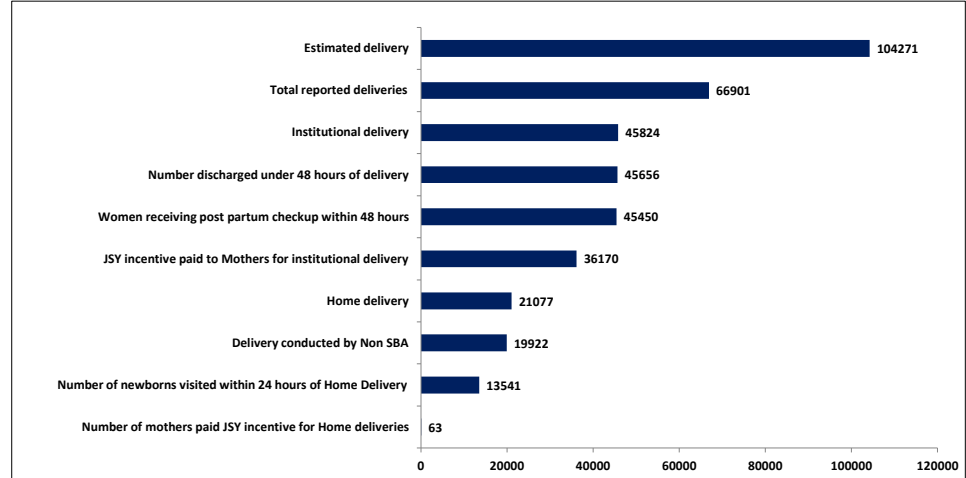
District at a Glance 2016-17 ( April -March 2017)



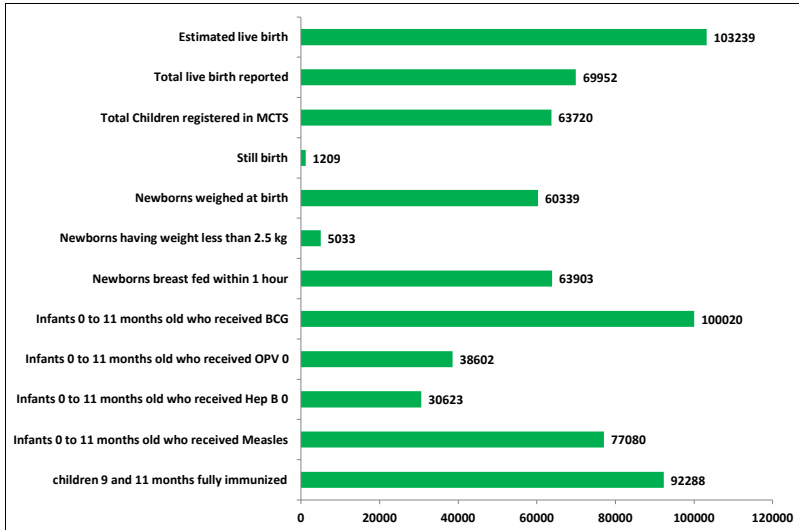

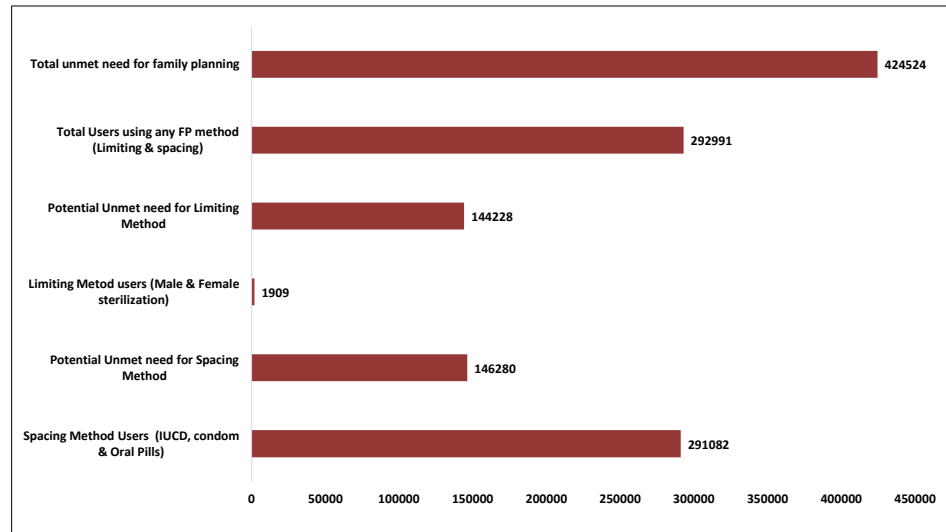

**ANC Care**

1. ANC registration of dist. is 102% although AHS 2012-13 showing ANC registration 51%, need to recheck data.
- 2- ANC Registration in 1st trim. is 28% which is reported approx equal to AHS 12-13 i.e. 48%.
- 3 % of PW received 3 ANC checkup is 59% which is double of AHS 12-13(32.6%). 67% ANC conducted @ SC so record of 3 ANC need to check.

**Delivery Care**

- 1- 65 % deliveries reported against the total estimated deliveries, needs to report rest missing deliveries.
- 2- 68.5 % deliveries are reported as institutional out of total reported deliveries(it is 44% against the total estimated deliveries) although AHS 2012-13 reported for Gonda is 51%
- 3- 20 % deliveries conducted at Home and 36% deliveries are not reported against the estimated deliveries.
- 4- 100 % mothers discharge under 48 hrs of delivery in Gonda district and AHS 12-13 measure it 61% in the same district.

**HRP and Complication Detection**

1. 35% pw were identified HB <11.
2. Maskanwa reported only 5% of PW with HB <11
3. DWH reported that 68% PWs are having hb<11 which is more than Pregnant women's need check.

**Child care :**

1. 2% still births are reported from the District.
2. 91% births are reported as breast fed within 1 hours of births, it is need to check as AHS 2012-13 showing data for Gonda is 45% only.
3. In Gonda 86% children weight at birth and of which 8% LBW while AHS 12-13
4. estimated this as 21.5% & 15.7 % respectively.

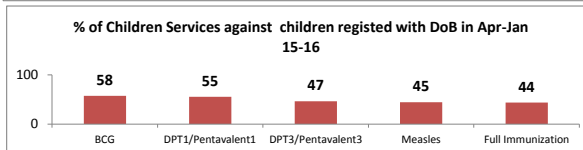
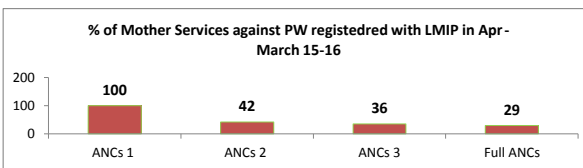
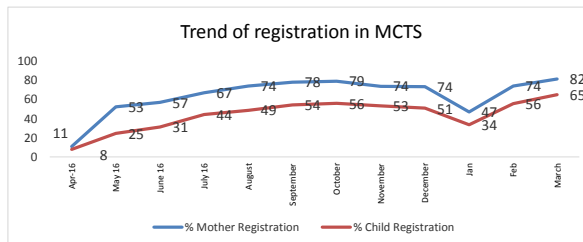
1. 97% BCG given against total live birth. No. of Live births and BCG given not corresponding in most of the blocks as per the table and reporting approx. double or > double live births need to be check accurately.
2. DHQ data need to cross check, it is showing 437% fully immunised while only 56.7% children received measles .
3. only 35% infant receive OPV 0 and 29% received HepB 0. and Fully immunised children 87%

**Family Planning:**

1. 75% of total IUCD perform at Subcenter till month so quality and quantity should be a concern to all Family planning managers.
2. Mujhana, Mankapur block providing less services of Condom in this month for family planning.
3. Only 1.3% are achieved as limiting method.
4. Achievement of spacing method in 23%.

- Antihypertensive used by only DhQ and Rupaideeh, its showing that PW with hypertention detection is very poor in almost all blocks.

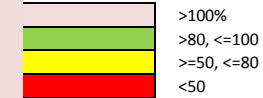

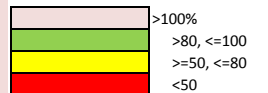

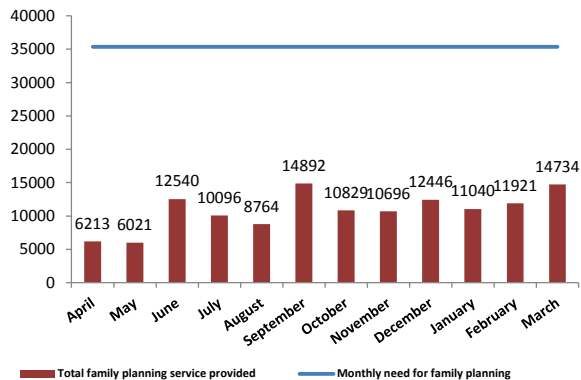

- only 37% infant receive OPV 0 and 30% received HepB 0. and Fully immunied children 89.4%



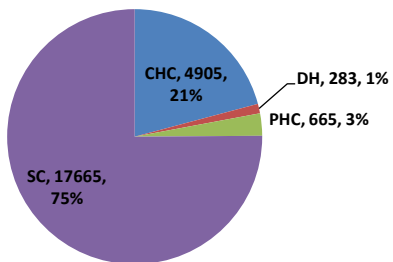

**Number of Family planning users against need by months 2016-17**



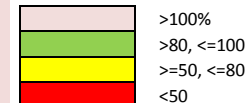
