Summary Sheet



Maternal health :

- 80% of estimated pregnant woman were registered in the program.
- Of which only 51% pregnant woman were registered in the 1st trimester.
- 86% of pregnant woman were registered under JSY.
- 62% of registered pregnant woman were received 3 ANC checkups.
- 63% of pregnant woman received TT2/BD, where as 88% of ANC's were received 100 IFA tablets.
- 54% of registered pregnant woman were having Hb level<11.

Child Health:

- 1.6% still births are reported from the dist .
- 98% births are reported as breast fed within 1 hours of births, it is need to check as AHS 2012-13 showing data for district is 64 % only.

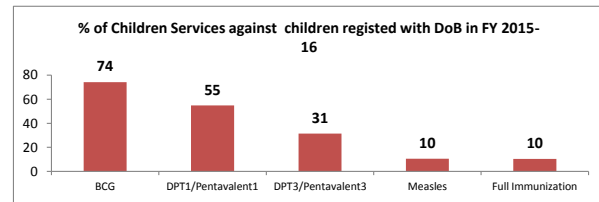
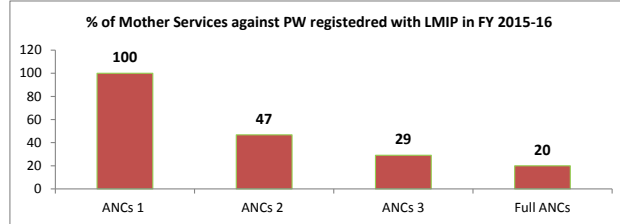
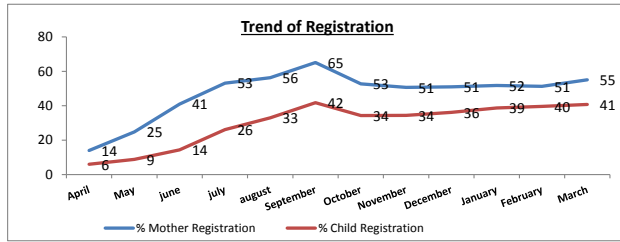
- 85% of children in district are fully immunized

- in district 21% of total family services are provided

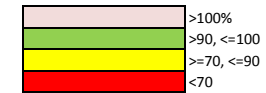

 Mother and child service updations are poor need to focus on that.

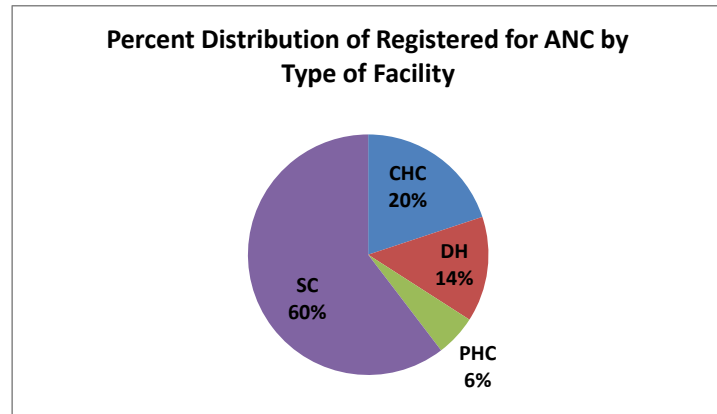
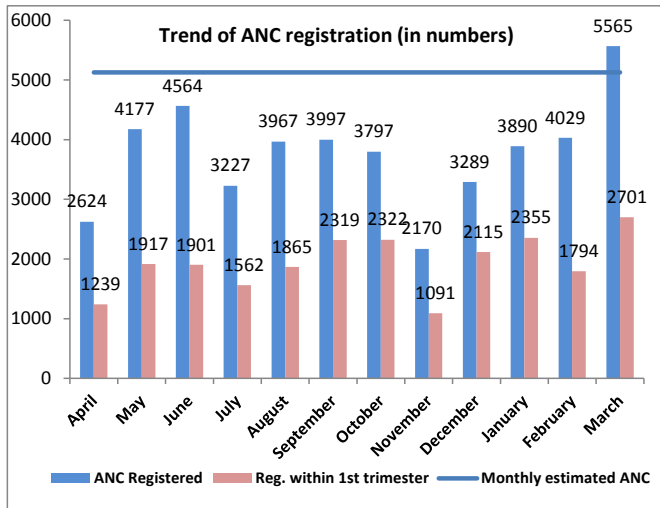

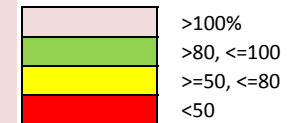

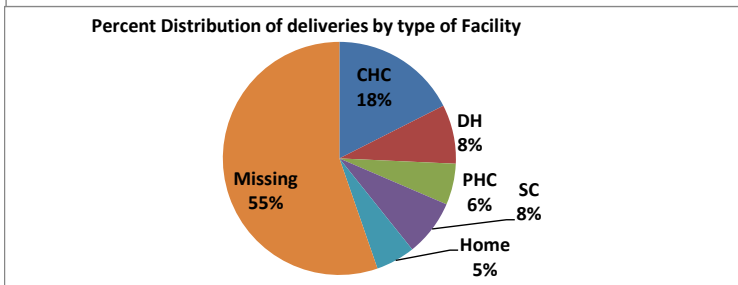
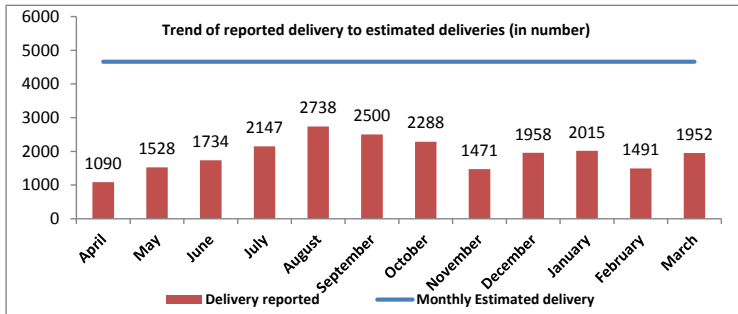
Gaps in ANC Registration :

1. ANC registration of dist. is 80% and it is equal to AHS 2012-13 finding.
- 2- ANC Registration in 1st trim. is 51% which is reported less than AHS 12-13 i.e. 59.3%.
- 3- % of ANC received 3 ANC checkup is 55% which is higher than AHS 12-13 (40.5) .

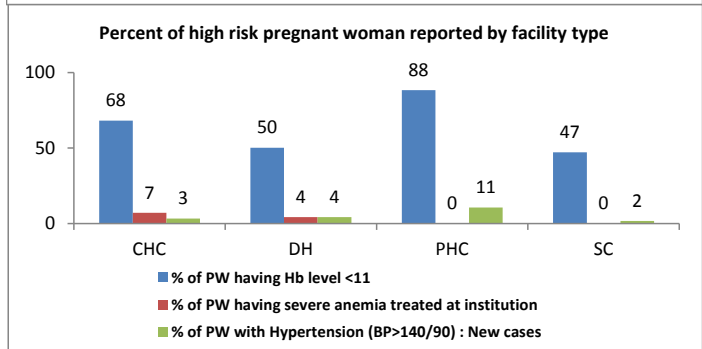
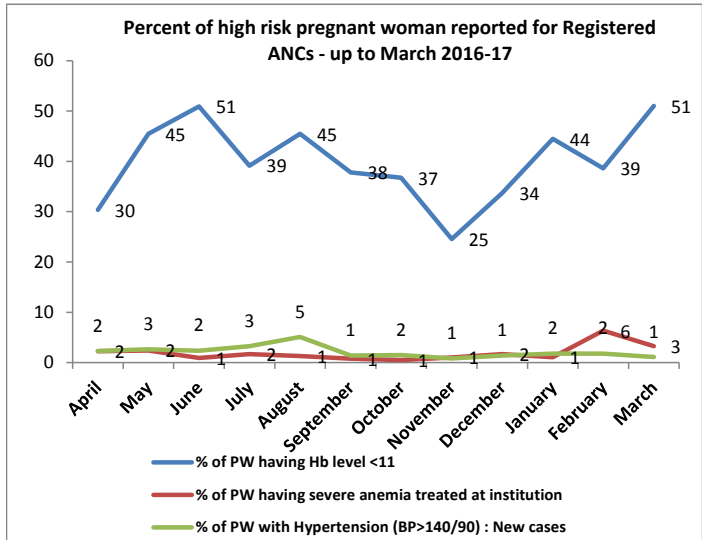
1-45% deliveries reported against the total estimated deliveries.

2-87% deliveries are reported as institutional out of total deliveries(it is 35% against the total estimated deliveries) althou gh AHS 2012-13 reported for jalaun is 62%.

3-13% deliveries conducted at Home and 55% deliveries are not reported against the estimated deliveries.

4-81% mothers discharge under 48 hrs of delivery in district and AHS 12-13 measure it 62.7% in the same district.

- District reported 2.2% hypertensive women but blocks Kadaura does not detect any hypertensive women.

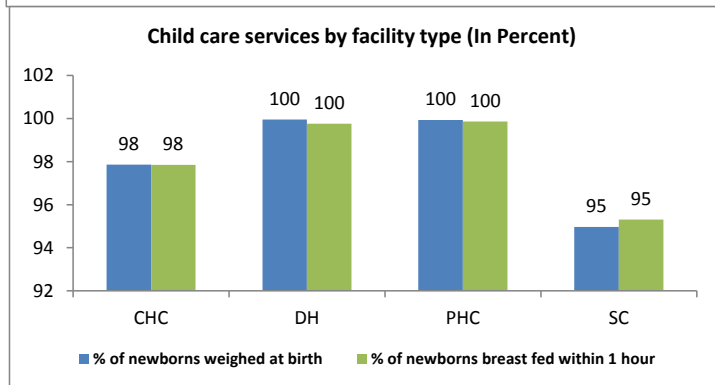
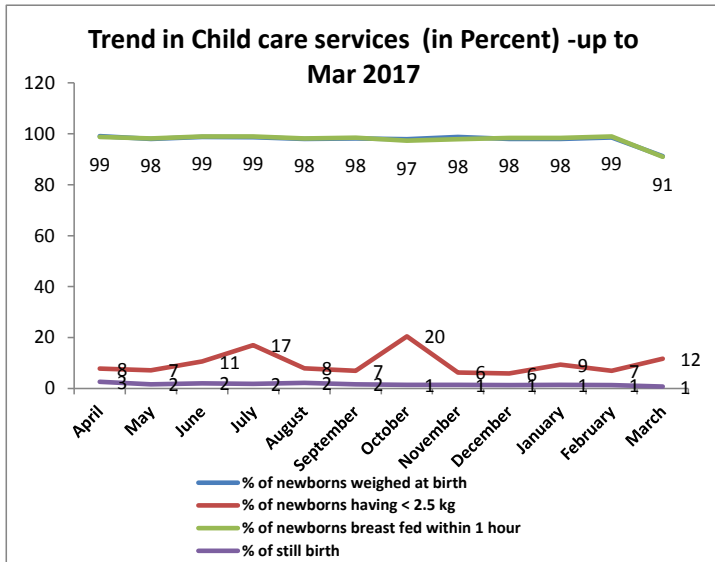

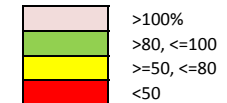

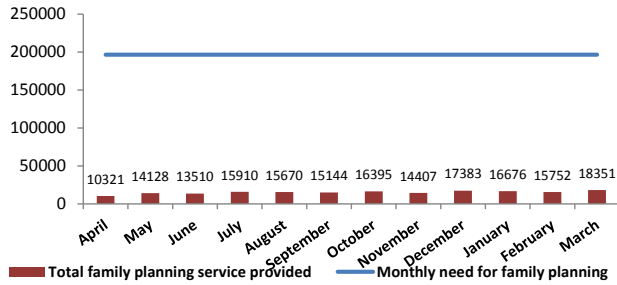

-85% of children in district are fully immunized.

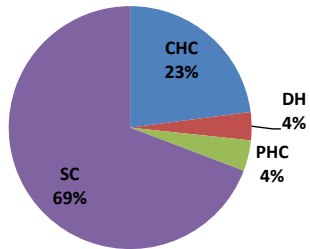
