Summary Sheet**



Maternal health :

- 82% of estimated pregnant woman were registered in the program.
- Of which only 46.3% pregnant woman were registered in the 1st trimester.
- 63% pregnant women are registered in the MCTS which shows a gap of 27% in registration
- 50.7% of registered pregnant woman were received 3 ANC checkups.

Complication and HRP

- 28.1% of registered pregnant woman were having Hb level<11.
- 8% complications are identified in the district

Delivery Care

- 46 % deliveries are reported in HMIS out of which 3% is home delivery and rest are institutional deliveries .
- 54% deliveries are missing which has to be addressed keenly.
- Out of 3% home deliveries, 53% are done by SBA trained personnel and 77% are visited within 24hrs.
- Out of total reported institutional deliveries 81.2% JSY payment is done (data need to be verified) and 3% Home deliveries were paid JSY payment
- 36% women are discharged within 48 hrs of delivery..

Child Health and Immunization:

- 47% live births are reported in HMIS where as 49% are reported in MCTS.
- 98.7% are weighed at birth and out of which 18.8% are low birth weight.
- 98.3% infants had breast feeding at birth.
- 13 still births are reported from the dist.on 1000 live births
- 74.9% infants were given BCG, 44.5% OPV0 and 20.8% HepB0 against estimated live birth.
- 73.2% infants were given Measles and 74.2% full immunization against estimated births.

Family Planning

- 46% of total IUCD perform at Subcenter till month so quality and quantity should be a concern to all Family planing mangers.
- Only 24% total family planning services were made available in the district.

- Mother registration in MCTS is only 63% while in registered in HMIS. This shows poor and delayed MCTS entry.
- Poorest blocks in Mother Registration is Moth.
- Child registration in MCTS is 49% which is less than children registered in HMIS.
- Poorest blocks in Mother Registration are DHQ, Chirgaon, Moth, Mauranipur, Bamur
- Updation of Mother services against registered in (Apr-mar 16-17) in district are ANC3 55.3% and Delivery are 50%.
- Child Service Updation against registered in district is Full immunization 33%.
- HRP detection in district is satisfactory but there is it varies from block to block , needs more improvement



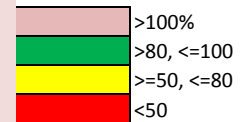
Jhansi - ANC Services Reported in HMIS during FY 2016-17 - March ANC Services, Trends, Distribution and Performance



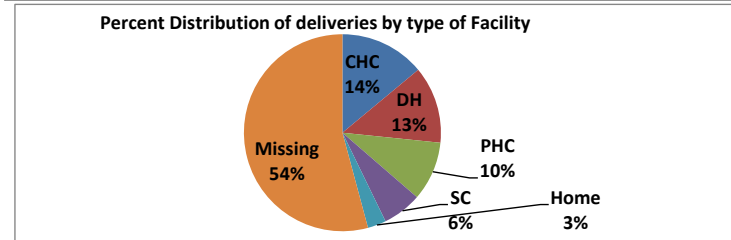
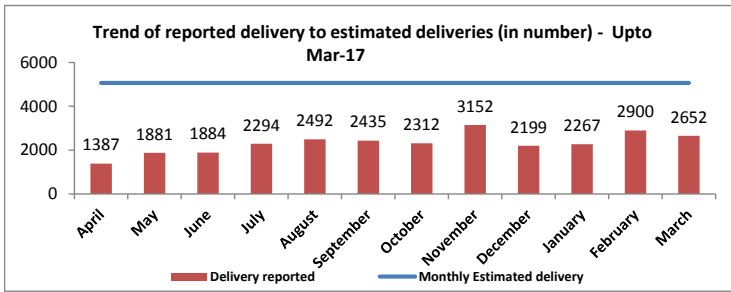

Gaps in ANC Registration :

1. ANC registration of dist. is 82.5% although AHS 2012-13 showing ANC registration 78.5% and DHQ & Bada Gaon is reporting more than 100% which is an outlier.
2. ANC Registration in 1st trim. is 46.3% which is reported less than AHS 12-13 i.e. 76.5%. Moth, DHQ, Chirgaon, Bangra, Gursaria have poor detection of pregnant women in 1st trimester .
- 3- 3 ANC checkup is 50.7% .



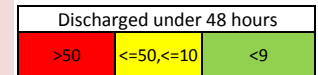
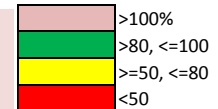

Gaps in Deliveries :-

- 54 % deliveries reported against the total estimated deliveries, needs to report rest missing deliveries.
- 93.4 % deliveries are reported as institutional out of total deliveries(it is 38% against the total estimated deliveries) although AHS 2012-13 reported for Jhansi is 76.8%
- 3% deliveries conducted at Home and 65% deliveries are not reported against the estimated deliveries. at district
- 36% mothers discharge under 48 hrs of delivery in Jhansi district and AHS 12-13
- Bamaur ,Bada Gaon, Moth has reported more than 100% JSY Payment. Babina,has reported lowest JSY payment need to check.



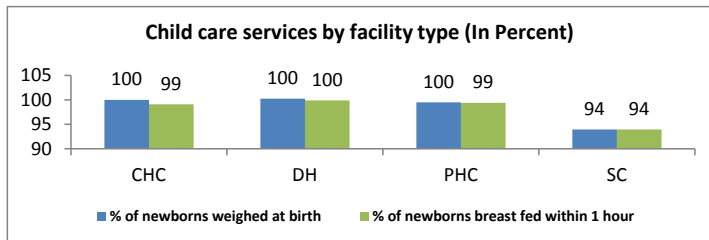
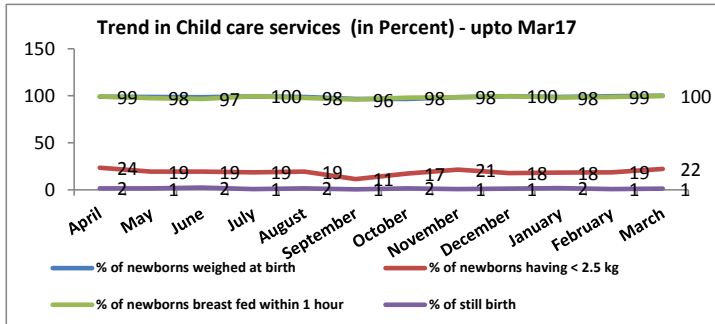

- There is confusion regarding reporting of complication at DHQ (Total of all complication should be equal to or less than complication reported)

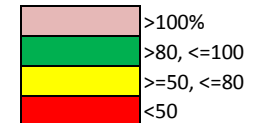

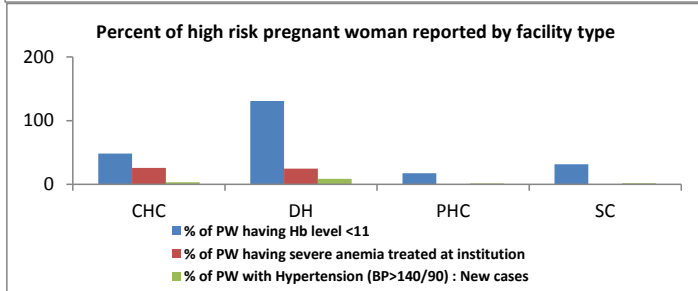
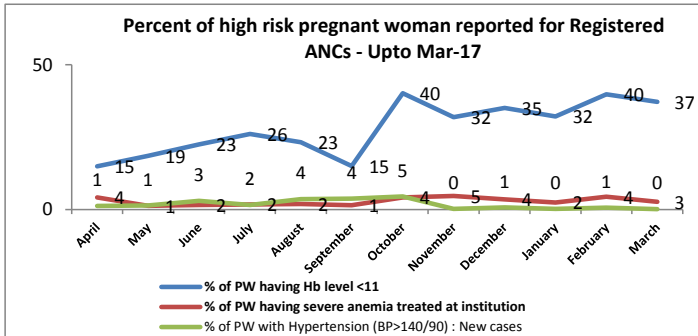

Gaps in Child care :

- 13 still births are reported from the dist.on 1000 live births while Badagaon has poor reporting of still birth
- 98.3% births are reported as breast fed within 1 hours of births, it is need to check as AHS 2012-13 showing data for Jhansi is 75.3% only.
- In Jhansi, 98.7% children weight at birth and of which 18.8% LBW while AHS 12-13 estimated this as 62.4% & 9.8% respectively.



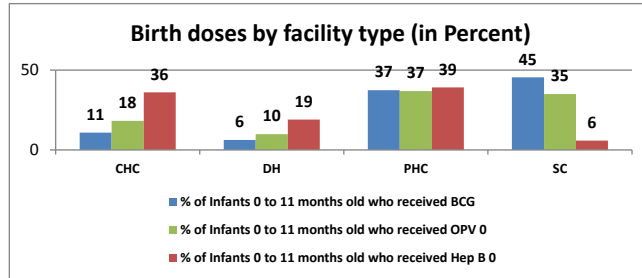
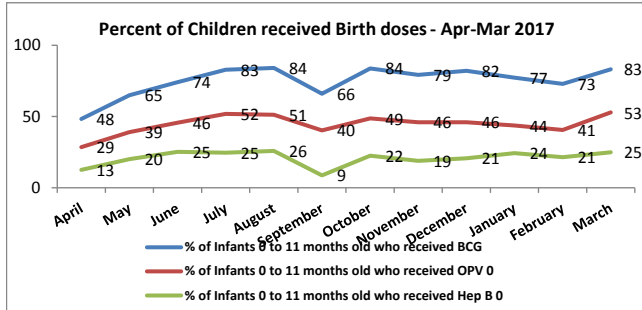

- It is a mandate to treat severe anaemic pregnant women at block facility level but Badagaon, Chirgaon, Mauranipur and Gursaria blocks have not reported (need to see whether services are not given or there is poor reporting).
- Hypertensive cases identification is lowest at Bamaur

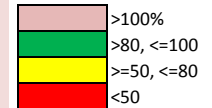
Jhansi - Immunisation Services Reported in HMIS during FY 2016-17 - March
Child Immunization trends, Distribution and progress



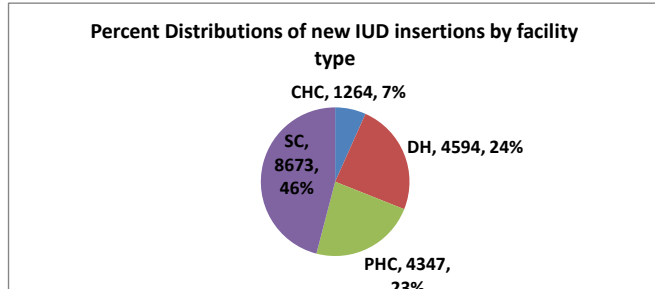
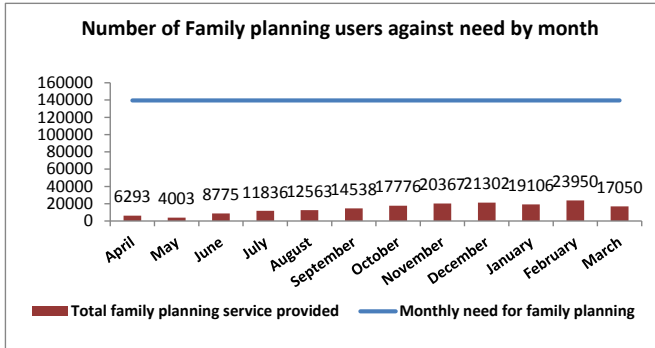

Gaps in Immunization :

- Against estimated BCG is only 74.9%.
- Moth, Bangra, Badagaon, Bamur has reported very less coverage of HepB0 .
- Usually BCG, OPVO and Hepatitis B0 doses are given at birth time but reporting shows all three are not given at the time of birth even at DH and CHCs, it is showing service gap at facility and need focus monitoring.



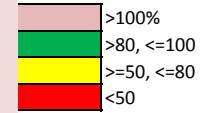
