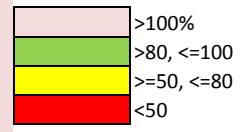

Kushinagar - Delivery Services Reported in HMIS during FY 2016-17 (April-March)

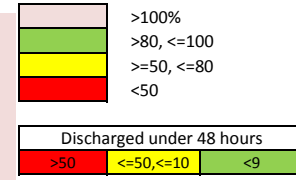

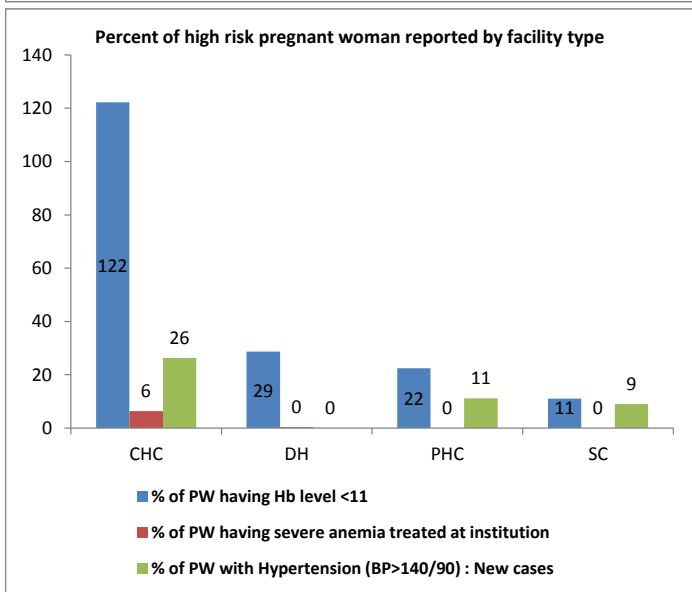
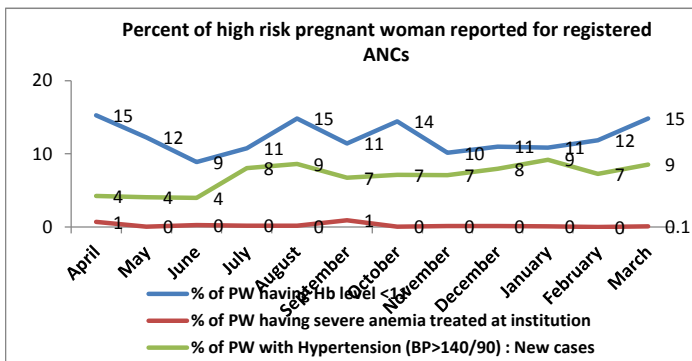

Gaps in Deliveries :-

- 1-58.5% deliveries reported against the total estimated deliveries where missing delivery is 41%.
- 2-68% deliveries are reported as institutional out of total deliveries although as per AHS 2012-13 is 55%.
- 3-56% mothers discharge under 48 hrs of delivery in district and as per AHS 12-13 is 91%.
- 4- JSY payment coverage is 82%, where five blocks coverage is more than 100% & three Blocks reported 0% JSY payment.

- Severe Anaemia having treated is only 0.2 where most of blocks (10) reported zero from Apr'16 to Jan'17.

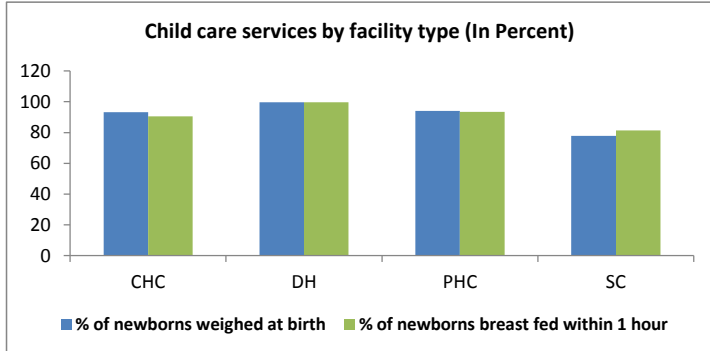
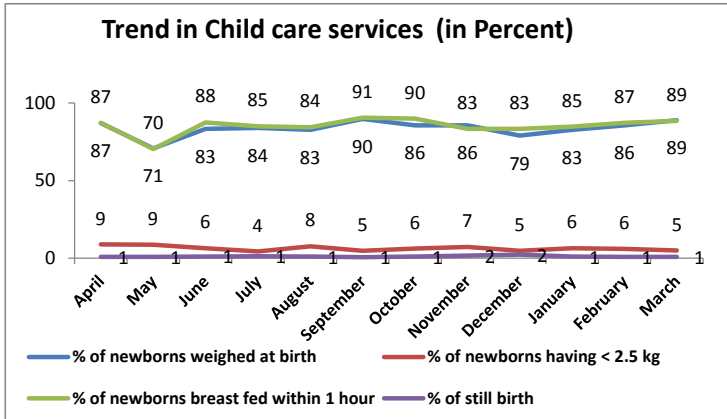

- More than two thirds of the children (73%) are fully immunized.
- Usually BCG, OPV0 and Hepatitis B0 doses are given at birth time but reporting shows all three are not given at the time of birth.

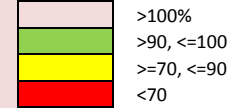
