Reporting Status Gaps

- 86% facilities reported in HMIS (few private facilities and Pasgwa blocks data is not completely filled).

Maternal health :

- 79% of estimated pregnant woman were registered in the program.
- Of which only 39% pregnant woman were registered in the 1st trimester.
- 50% of registered pregnant woman were received 3 ANC checkups.
- 68% of pregnant woman received TT2/BD, where as 88% of ANC's were received 100 IFA tablets.

Complication and HRP

- 36% of registered pregnant woman were having Hb level<11.
- 5% complications are identified in the district

Delivery Status

- 64 % deliveries are reported in HMIS out of which 13% is home delivery and rest are institutional deliveries.
- 36% deliveries are missing which has to be addressed keenly.
- Out of 19 % home deliveries, 83% are done by Non SBA trained personnel and 79% are visited within 24hrs.
- Out of total reported institutional deliveries 73% JSY payment is done (data need to be verified) .
- 55% women are discharged within 48 hrs of delivery..

Child Health and Immunization:

- 65% live births are reported in HMIS where as only 55% are reported in MCTS.
- 93% are weighed at birth and out of which 12% are low birth weight.
- 94% infants had breast feeding at birth.
- 21 still births are reported from the dist.on 1000 live births
- 73% infants were given BCG, 35% OPV0 and 24% HepB0 against estimated live birth.
- 67% infants were given Measles and full immunization against estimated births.

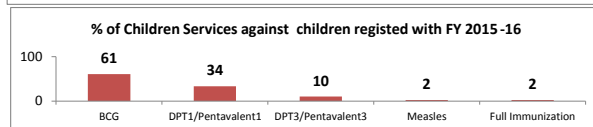
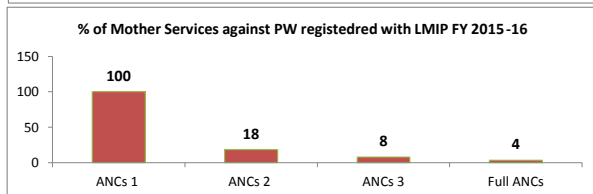
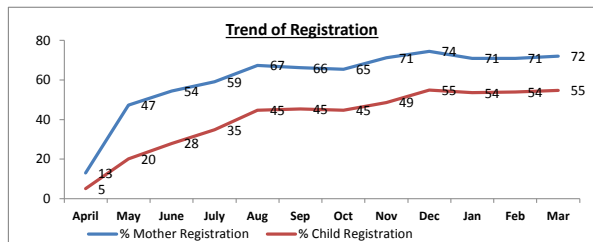

- Mother registration in MCTS is only 72% which is almost near by HMIS.
- Child registration in MCTS is only 55% which is 10% less registered in HMIS.
- Poorest blocks in Child Registration are Nighasan, Phardhan, Pasgawa,
- Updation of Mother services against registered in (Apr-Jan15-16) in district are ANC3 27% and Delivery are 23% which is very poor
- Child Service Updation against registered in (FY 2015-16) in district is not satisfactory.

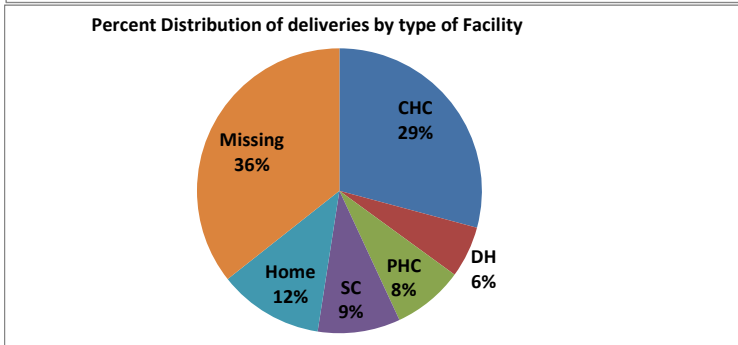
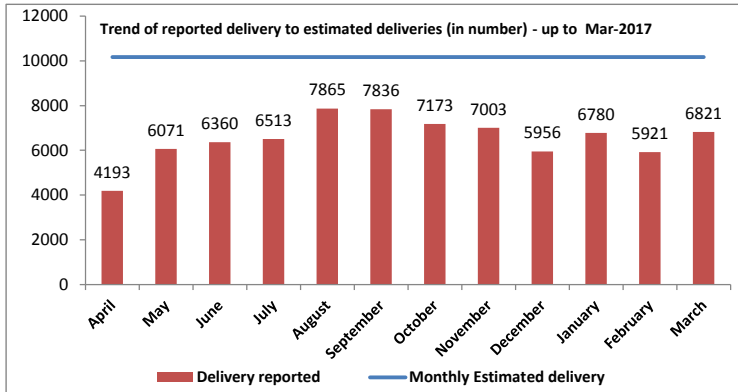
1. ANC registration of dist. is 79% although AHS 2012-13 showing ANC registration 59.5% .

Gaps in Deliveries :-

- 64 % deliveries reported against the total estimated deliveries, needs to report rest missing deliveries.
- 81 % deliveries are reported as institutional out of total deliveries(it is 52% against the total estimated deliveries) altho ugh AHS 2012-13 reported for Kheri is 54.3
- 19% deliveries conducted at Home and 36% deliveries are not reported against the estimated deliveries.
- 55% mothers discharge under 48 hrs of delivery in Kheri district and AHS 12 -13
- Pasgawa has reported more than 100% JSY Payment.

Gaps in HRP :

- Mitoli, Pallia, Phoolbhar & Rmia Behar has poor reporting of Anaemic pregnant women.
- It is a mandate to treat severe anaemic pregnant women at block facility level but many blocks have not reported(need to see whether services are not given or there is poor reporting) .
- There is a sudden increase in hypertensive case identification in month of October need to check the data.
- DWH reported that 108% PWs are having hb<11 which is more than Pregnant womens need check.

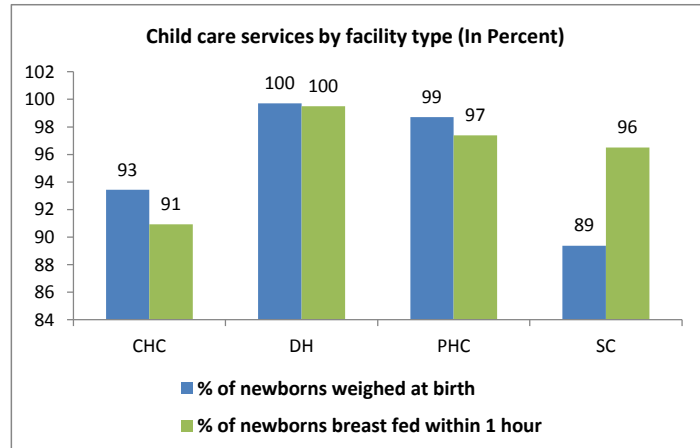
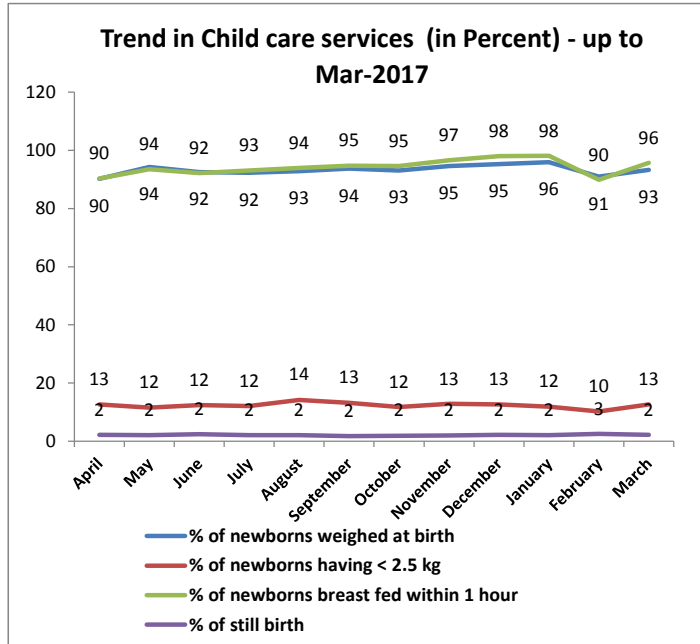
Gap in Complication and C-section

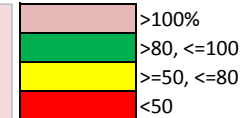

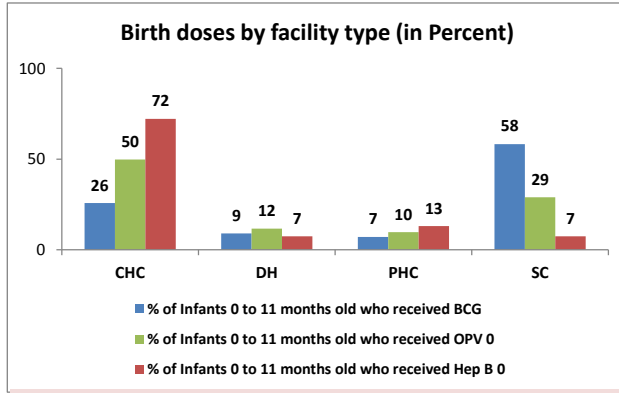
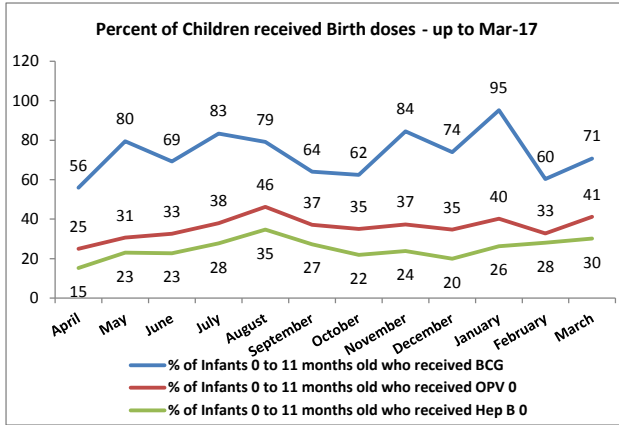
Gaps in Child care:

2 % still births are reported from the dist.on 1000 live births while lowest reporting is from Bijua need to check the reporting and Nighasan and Isanagar are high reporting facility needs to strengthen the services and complication management .
 94% births are reported as breast fed within 1 hours of births, it is need to check as AHS 2012-13 showing data for Kheri is 57.6% only.
 In Kheri 93% children weight at birth and of which 13% LBW while AHS 12-13 estimated this as 33.4% & 26.8% respectively

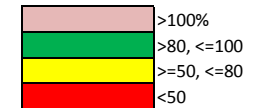

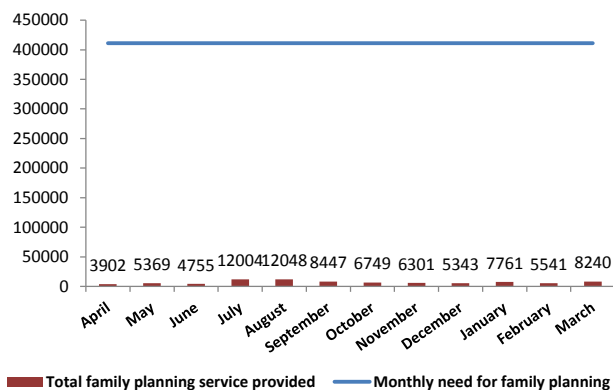
Gaps in Immunization :

- No of Live births and BCG given not corresponding in some of the blocks as per the table . Against estimated BCG is only 73%.
- Bijua, Kumbhi, Pasgawa, Phardhan have poor reporting of Hep.B-0 dose to the total live births and rest blocks were not able to do so.
- Usually BCG, OPV0 and Hepatitis B0 doses are given at birth time but reporting shows all three are not given at the time of birth even at DH and CHCs, it is showing service gap at facility and need focus monitoring.

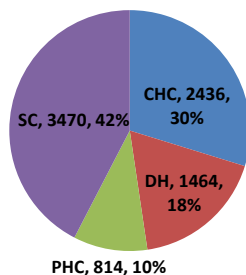
