Maternal health :

ANC registration of dist. is 82 % while Mahrajanj Block reporting more than 100% and in AHS 2012-13 showing ANC registration 74.4% . ANC Registration in 1st trim. is 36% which is reported Less than to AHS 12-13 i.e. 39.5%.need to check the data 1st trimester registration. .

Total delivery reported by Dist is almost 54% in over the period i.e. 46% Deliveries are still missing in reporting. Institutional Del against estimated delivery is 81% whereas AHS shows 50.9% , Home deliveries are not reported adequately in HMIS reported only 10% to estimated, data needs to be checked and verified.

Many blocks are not reporting complications. It indicates poor identification of complications or poor reporting. Block staff need to be oriented on complication identification. Data shows the Govt. facility conducted only 8 C sections its need to regular monitoring of district hospital . it seems number of cases are referred from the district hospital..

Child Health

Still Birth against total Delivery is reported only 1.3% by Dist. 2 Blocks are reported less than or equal 1% of Still Birth in over the period, it seems very low reporting. Weight at birth against total live Birth is reported 91% by Dist whereas AHS is only 22.1%. Newborn having <2.5Kg is almost 8% of Dist but AHS shows 19.6% . % NB breast fed within 1 Hr is 96% reported in HMIS by Dist but AHS shows 32.7% all the Blocks reported near about 100%.

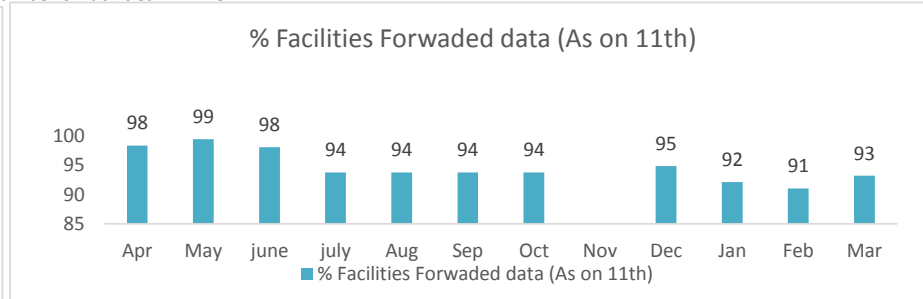

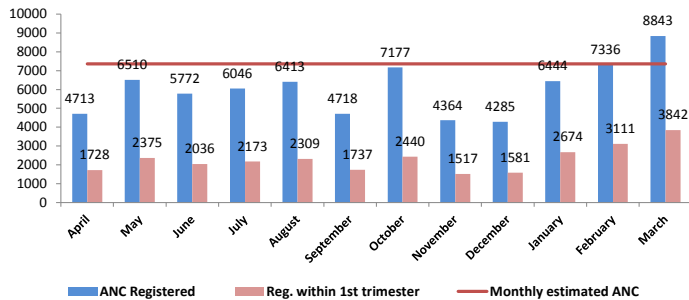

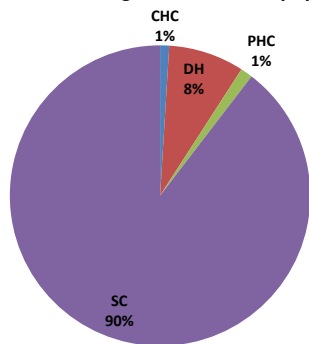

Trend of ANC registration (in numbers) - April - March (2016-17)



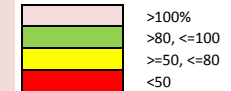
Percent Distribution of Registered for ANC by Type of Facility



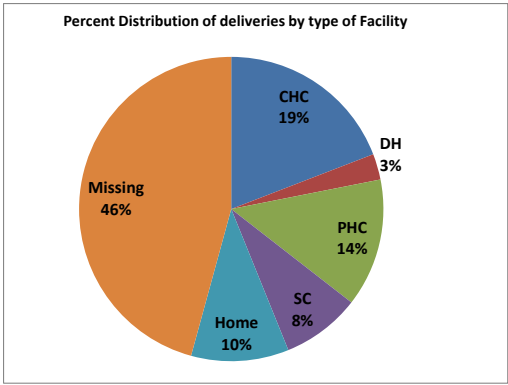
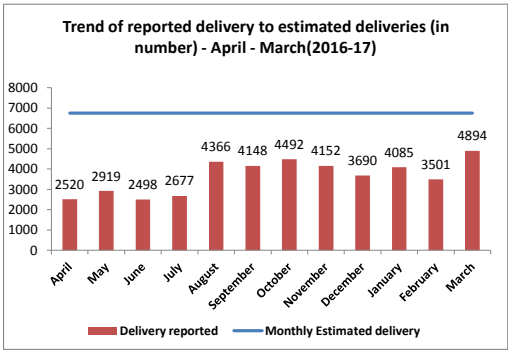

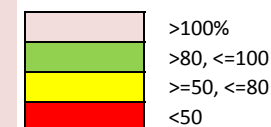

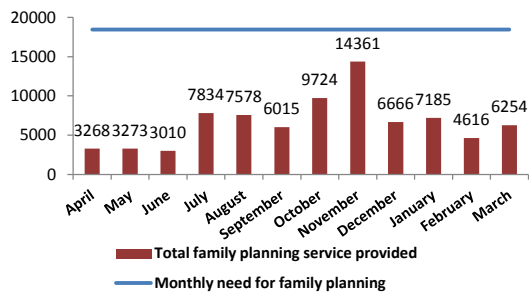

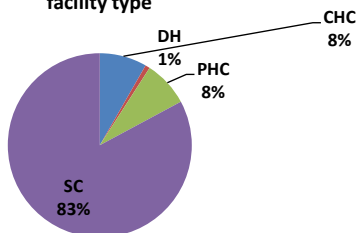
