## HMIS Bulletin - Summary Sheet    District Mathura Month - April-March    FY 2016-17



### **Mother Services :**

1. ANC registration reported in HMIS is 70% and quite fine as per AHS 12-13.
2. First trimester ANC registration reported in HMIS is low as compare than AHS 12-13 and poor blocks are Chaumuha, Mathura, Goverdhan. Block Nandganv 100% required data Audit.
3. Mathura and Goverdhan Blocks ANC reported is very low. Need to be focus.
4. Chaumuha Block 3 ANC and ANC Registration data almost equal. Need to be Check.

### **MCTS:**

- 1- Mother Registration is not satisfactory improving from last month and quite low as compare to state target of 80%.
- 2- Poor Performing Blocks in Mother registration are Goverhan, Chaumuha, Baldav, Chatta, Naujheel
- 3- Except Mathura, Nandgaon, Chatta rest blocks are poor Performing in Child registration and also quite low as compare to state target of 70% ANC registration any time.-
- 4- Need to focus on Urban entry as it's only 3% in child and 9% in mother registration.
- 5- HRP tracking is poor in the district which 7% of the total PWs.

### **Delivery Services:**

1. 50 % Deliveries are not reported in HMIS portal against estimated deliveries.
2. DHQ, Maant, Goverdhan block are reported on HMIS portal mother to paid JSY incentive is very less comparison to other block. Need to be check.
4. 64 % Delivered women discharged under 48 hours of delivery.
5. Mathura, Chatta, Chaumuha Block home deliveries reported more than institutional Delivery. Need to be check.

### **Gaps in HRP Services:**

1. Number of Cases identified of severely anemic PW is very low at Blocks Chatta, Chaumuha, Naujheel, Raya and Goverdhan it need to focus at Facility level.
5. % of hypertensive PWs is very high in Chaumuha and Mant while zero by Nandgaon

### **Maternal Complication attended and their treatment:**

1. Complicated pregnant women are attended at block Farh, DHQ and Mant only.
2. Treatment of attended cases are reported wrong by the blocks DHQ, Mant Data should be validated.
3. Currently C Sections are performed only in DHQ, Farha and Maant block only. Block Maant very high C-section Delivery rate.

### **Gaps in Child Care :**

1. 0.2 % still births are reported from the district in FY 2016-17. Data need to be check. 5 block still not reported any case of still birth from april to feb 17
2. Newborns weighed at birth and newborns breast fed within 1 hour data Reported in HMIS is almost double than the AHS data 2012-2013.
3. Except Farha, Mant, Chatta, DHQ and Raya no block reported Still Birth. Need to check.
4. Mathura, Goverdhan and Mant New born < 2.5 kg is very high and . Data need to be check

### **Gaps in Immunization :**

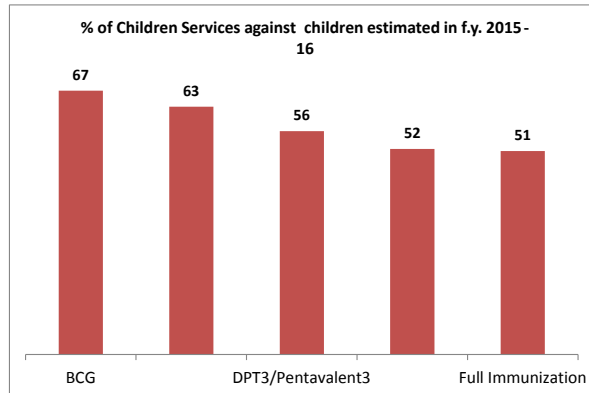
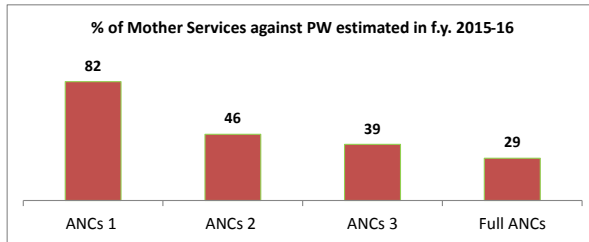
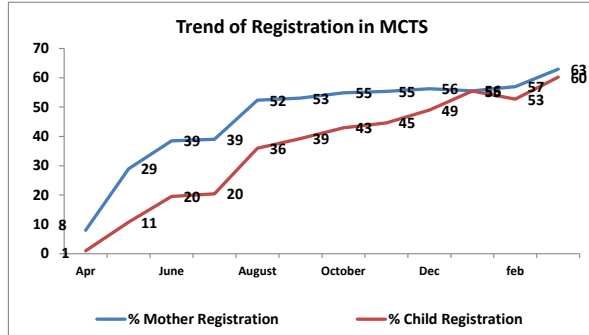
1. Number of live birth and BCG given not corresponding in most of the block as per the table.
2. BCG, OPV 0, Hep B 0 Doses are given at birth time but reporting shows all three are not given at the time at CHC, PHC and DH level, it is showing service gap at facility and need focus Monitoring.
3. "No. of infants (0-11 months old) immunized for measles >= No. of infants (9-11 months old) fully immunized " but 3 blocks namely Man, Nandgaon and Chaumuha 4. reporting fully immunization infants 0 to 11 month is more than Measles given to infants 0 to 11 months old. Data need to check.
5. In Baldev and Nandganv Block Number of Infants 0 to 11 months old who received Hepatitis-B0 vaccination not done at facility. Birth dose can prevent Neonatal death.

### **Gaps in Family Planning Services :**

1. Its good having 45 NSV cases but Female sterilization poor as per unmet need. Except Baldav, Faraha, Chatta, Naujheel no block are providing any limiting Family planning Method. Achievement for limiting method is very low i.e. 9 % only.
2. Spacing still 80% of couple not getting any method or using traditional method. block nandganv spacing coverage less than 10%. only 10 IUC inserted from april-feb .
3. Total coverage from all couple 15% still 75% couple required any method for family planning.

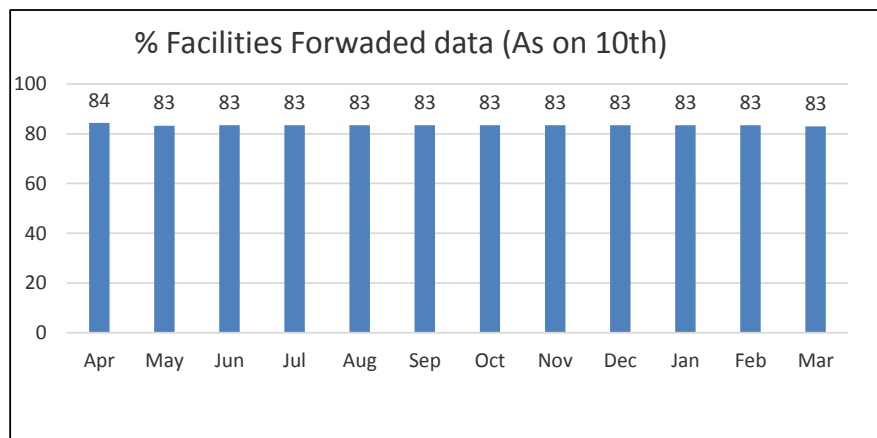
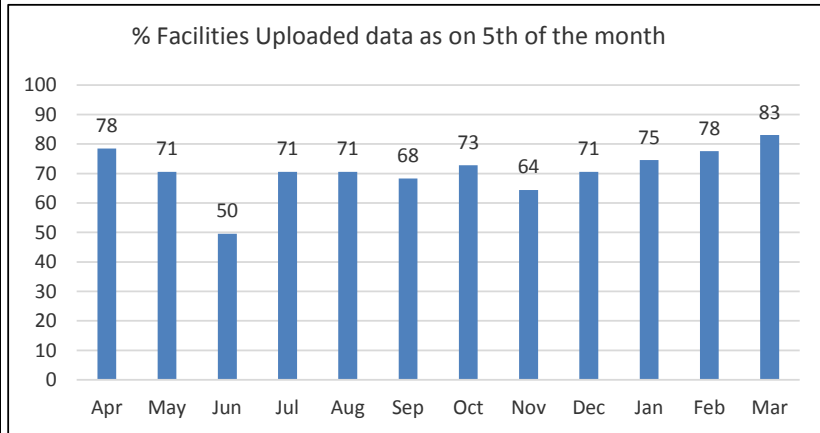
- 1- Mother Registration is 10 point percent improving from last month and quite low as compare to state target of 80% .

- 3- Except Mathura,Nandgaon,Chatta rest blocks are poor Performing in Child registration and also quite low as compare to state target of 70% ANC registration any time.-
- 4-Need to focus on Urban entry as it's only 4% in child and 9% in mother registration.
- 5-HRP tracking is poor in the district which is just 7% of the total PWs.

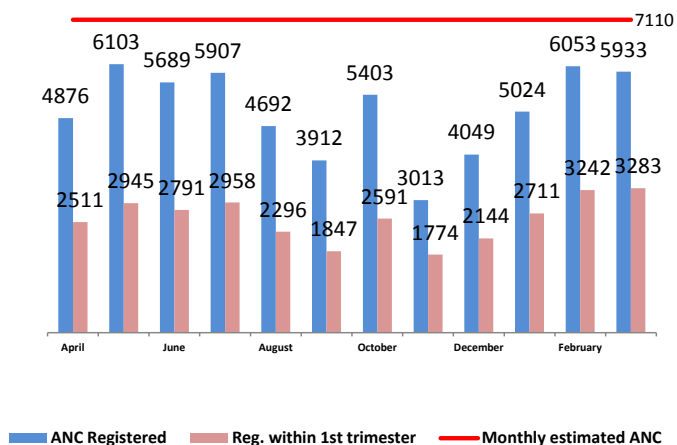

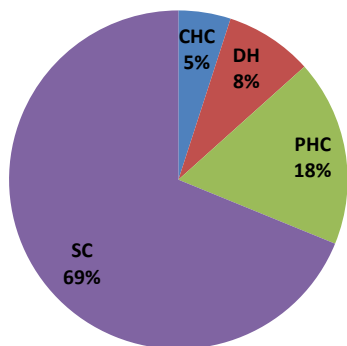
### ANC Services Trend, Distribution and progress



**Trend of ANC registration (in numbers) - FY 2016-17**



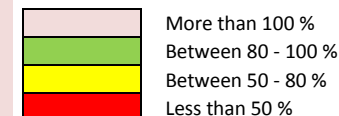

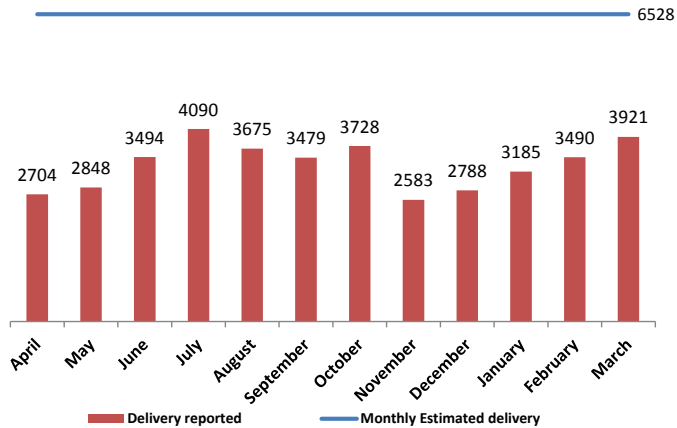

4. Chaumuha Block 3 ANC and ANC Registration data almost equal. Need to be Check.

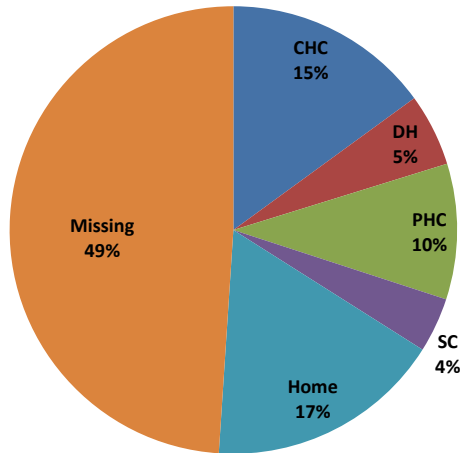

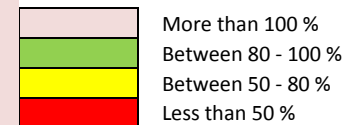

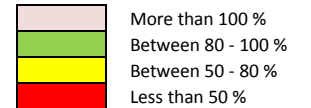

**Number of Family planning users against need by month**



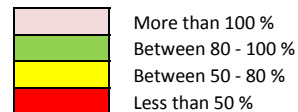
