- Mother registration and Child registration both have improved from June to March where as the child registration has been improved very high in the same period.
- Out of 9 blocks, 5 blocks have poor registration for Children in MCTS portal. 5 blocks such as Badraon, F.Mandaon, Ghosi and Ranipur.
- All blocks are poorly performing for Mother registration.
- All blocks are poorly performing for child registration except Ranipur.

**Gaps in ANC Registration :**

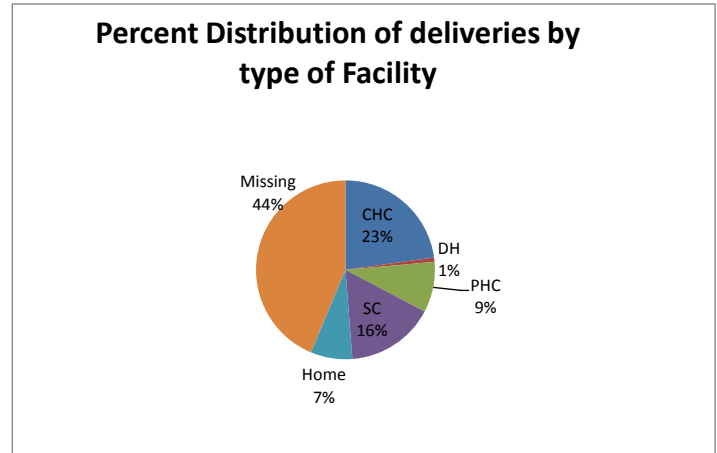
- ANC registration of dist. is 83% and Mohammada bad and Bardaon reporting status <70% although AHS 2012-13 showing ANC registration 74%. It means ANC registration has been improved relatively.
- ANC Registration in 1st trim. is 27% against registration. There is opportunity for mother registration in 1st trimester. Also, almost all blocks are below 50% . Strategies should be planned to improve it.
- 3 ANC checkup is 60% which is more of AHS 12-13(38.6%). It shows the 3 ANC check ups has been improved in the district.

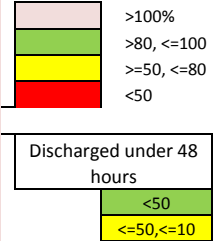

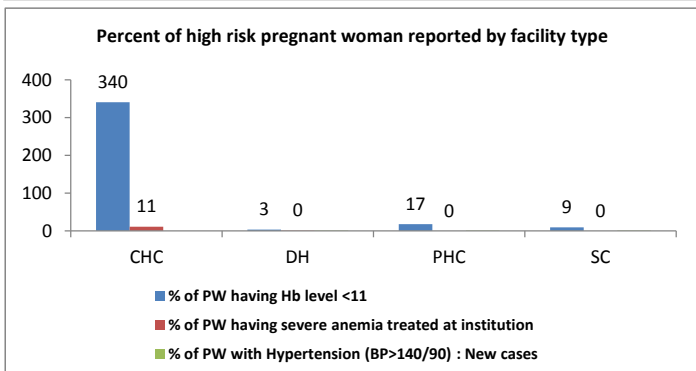
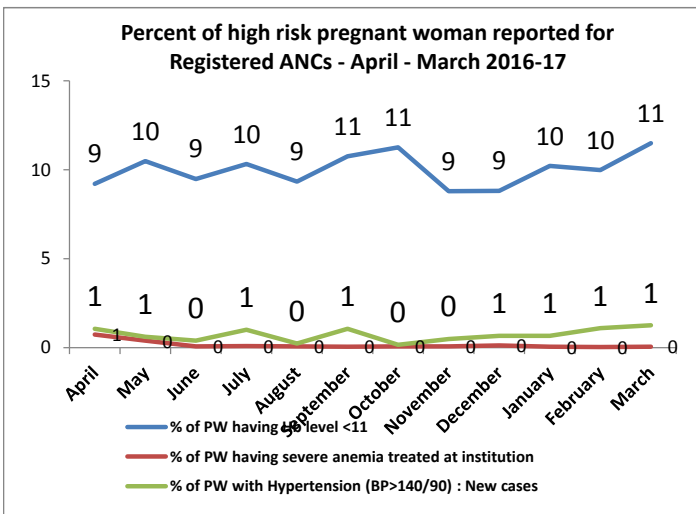
**Gaps in Deliveries :-**

- 1-Almost 56.3% deliveries reported against the total estimated deliveries, needs to report rest 44%missing deliveries.
- 2-86.6% deliveries are reported as institutional out of total deliveries although AHS 2012-13 reported for Mau is 63.6%.
- 3-7 % deliveries conducted at Home and 56% deliveries are reported against the estimated deliveries.
- 4-102.% mothers discharge under 48 hrs of delivery in the district. Over reporting of data is done in most of the blocks.
- 5- Missing deliveries are highest in Ranipur and Ratanpura and Badraon.

#### Gaps in Child care :

- 1.4% still births are reported from the district and on other hand Kopaganj and dhq reported 4.0% and 1.9 % respectively which is highest in district.
- 86% births are reported as breast fed within 1 hours of births, it is need to check as AHS 2012-13 showing data for Mau is 30.4% only.
- In Mau 98.7% children weight at birth and 6.7% LBW among them while AHS 12-13 - estimated this as 34.1% & 23.1% respectively.

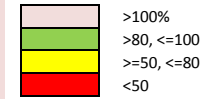

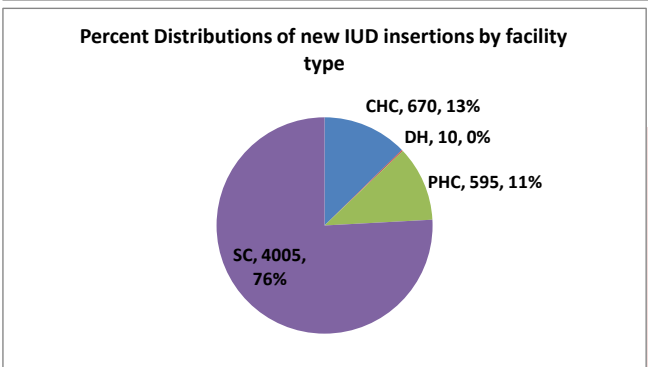
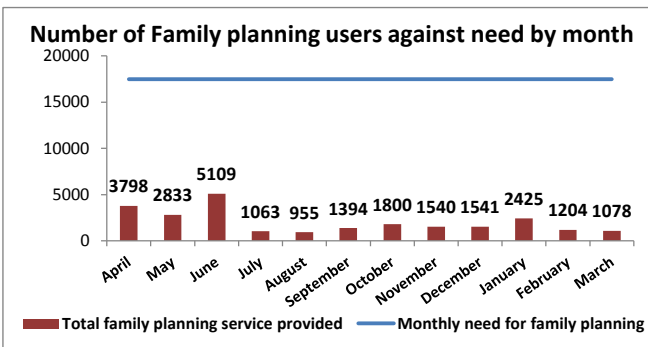
**Gaps in Immunization :**

- OPV 0 are less than 50 % in all blocks except F.Mandaon which shows that birth doses are not given within 24-48 Hours of delivery and Hepatitis 0 are less than 50 % in all blocks
- Full Immunization is Poor (less than 50%) in DHQ.

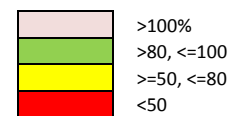

**Gaps in Family planning :**

- 76% of total IUCD was performed at Subcenter till month so quality and quantity should be a concern to all Family planning managers.
- Achievement of Spacing method is 32.5% while limiting method services is just 4.23%
- Only 3 Blocks provided Female Sterilization services out of 9 blocks and Male Sterilization provided only one block Ghosi.
