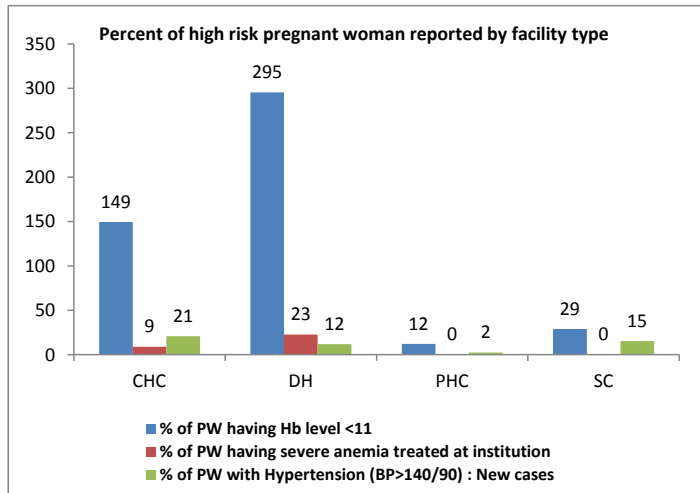
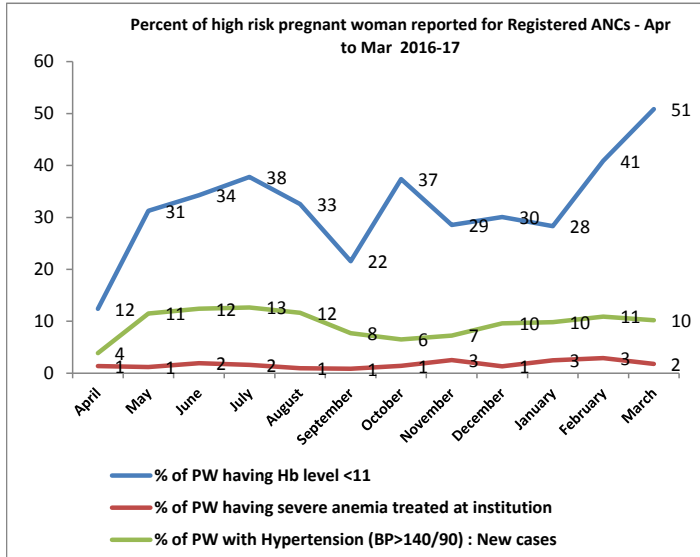
Gaps in Deliveries :

- Hypertensive cases identification is very poor in many blocks. All Moics need to verify & update properly in HMIS.

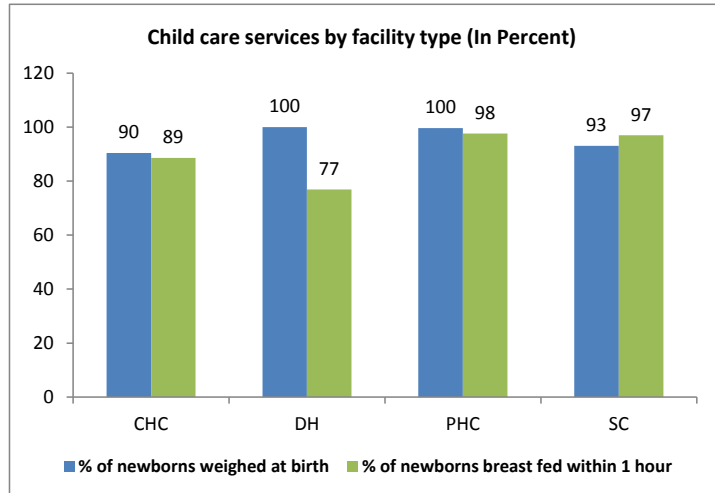
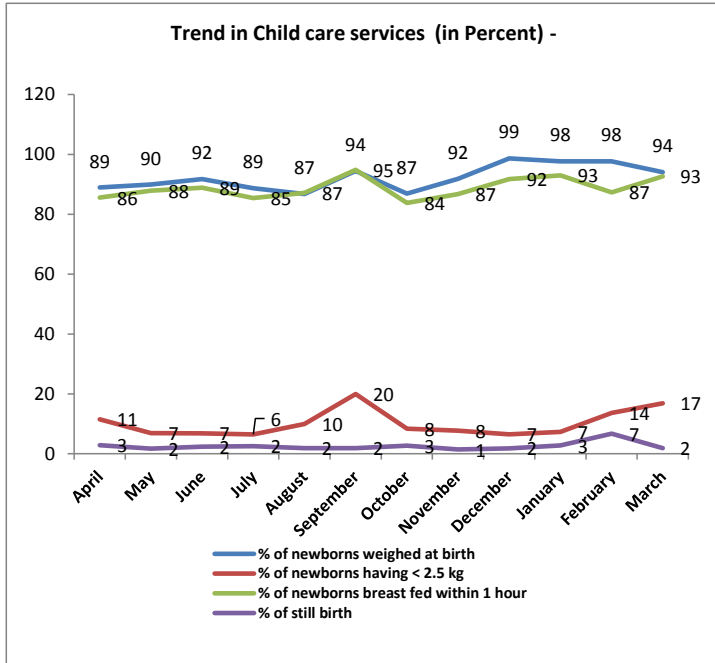

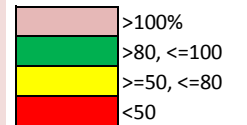

Child care services trends, distribution and progress



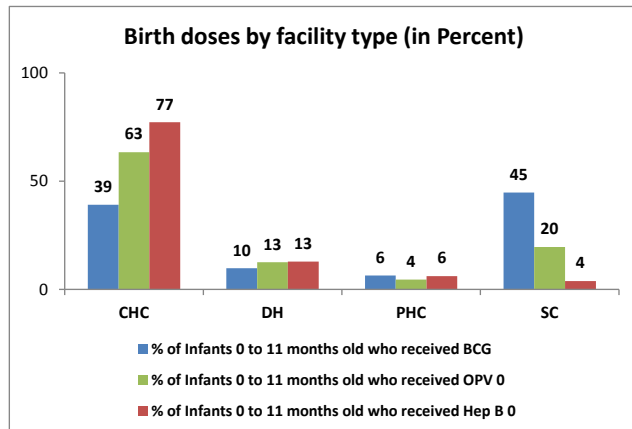
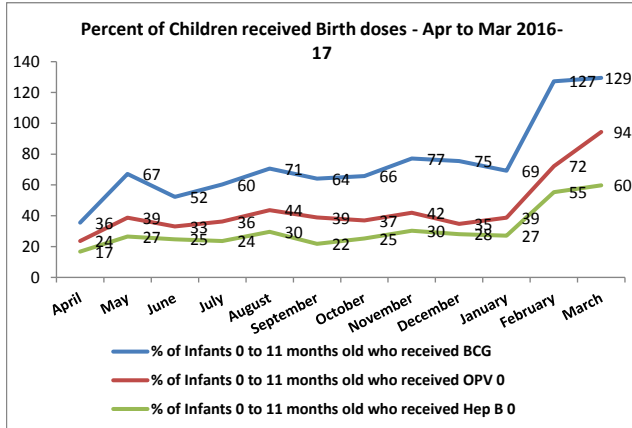

Same variation seem also here at newborn breast within 1 hour, district reported 89% & as per ASH report 63%.



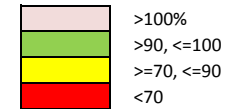

Child Immunization trends, Distribution and progress



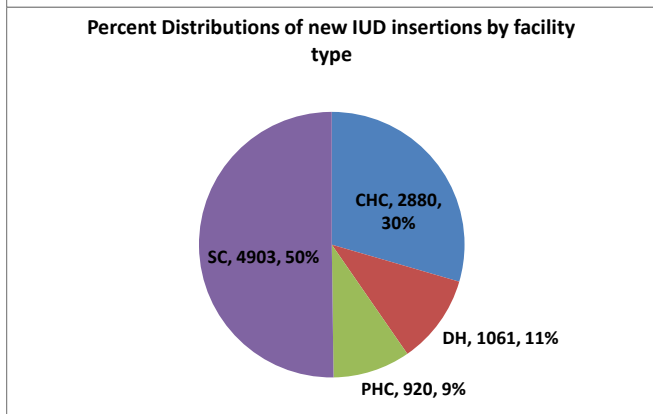
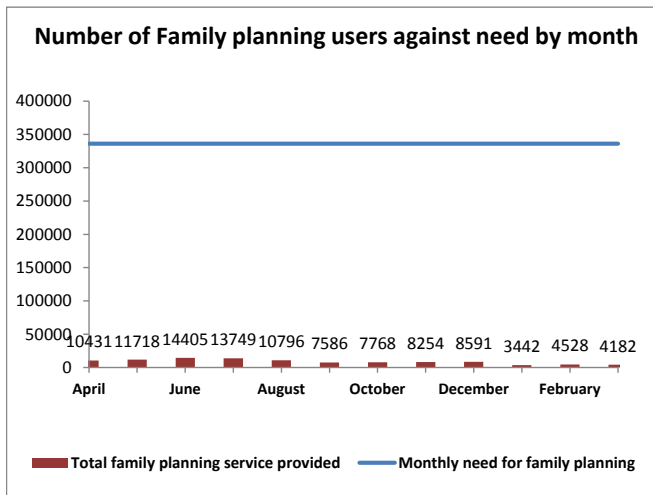

- Wide variation of Immunization to kind of doses.



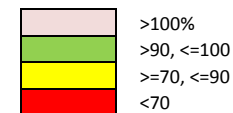
