Maternal Health -

ANC registration of dist. is 88% Jogiya and Bhanwapur reported 1025 and,103% ,Naugarh 128% thistype errors should be discuss in validation committee, and dat a should cross varify by the validation sheet or Sc wise hmis bulletin , although AHS 2012-13 showing ANC registartion 67.9%

2- ANC Registration in 1st trim. is 45% which is repotred more than to AHS 12-13 i.e. 28%.need to check the data 1st trimester registartion.

3- % of ANC recievd 3 ANC checkup is 72% which is more than traple of AHS 12-13(23.2%). 90% ANC conducted @ SC so record of 3 ANC need to check.

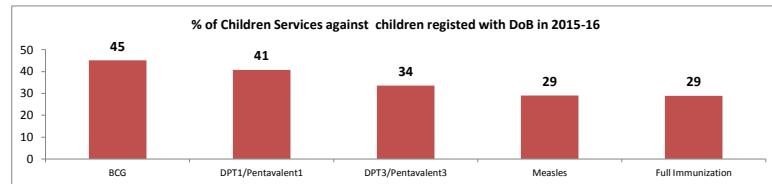
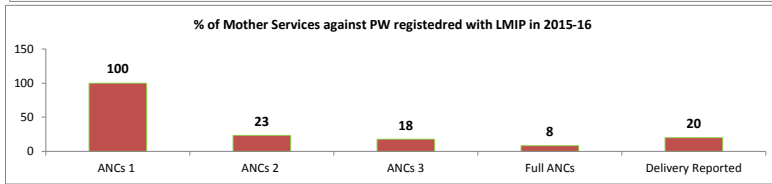
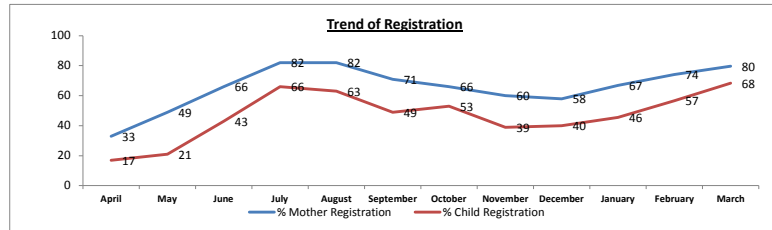

In Siddharthnagar 94% children weight at birth and of which 2.3% LBW while AHS 12-13 estimated this as 22%&20.% respectively.

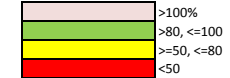

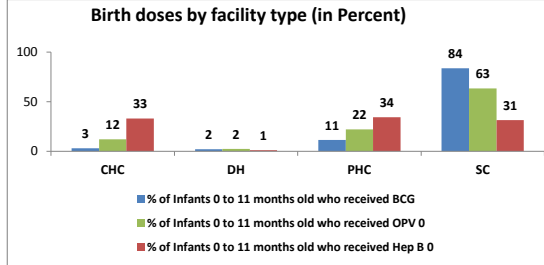

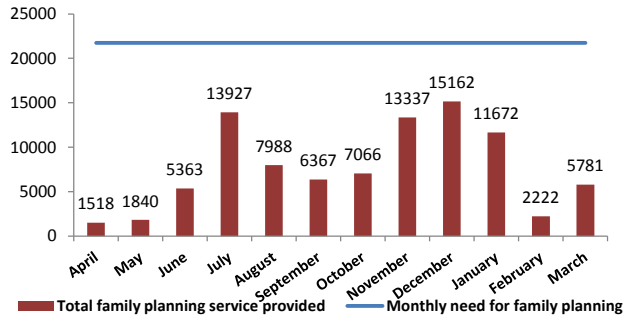

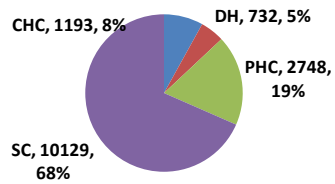


Siddharth Nagar - Family Planning Services Reported in HMIS during FY 2016-17 (April to March)

Number of Family planning users against need by month



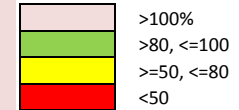
