Maternal Health

Total ANC Reg. of Dist is 107% reported over the period whereas as per AHS it was 50.3%, early registration is 45% and as per AHS it is 49.5%.
3 ANC is showing 71% of Dist whereas in AHS it is 29% .
HMIS data shows some drop out from 1 ANC to 3 ANC means all registered PW are not receiving services.

PW having HB level < 11 is 42% . Needs to be set on priority.

Hypertension cases are 6% and 0% of cases in Blocks like Pahla, Pisawan, Reusa, Sakran.

Total delivery reported to estimated by Dist is 71% in over the period ie 29% Deliveries are missing in reporting .
Institutional against reported delivery is 72% whereas AHS shows 56% its seems Home deliveries are not reported adequately in HMIS reported only 13%

JSY paid is showing 89%. Due to Pvt. facility reporting in Dhq is showing low.

Complications cases are reported by Dist is 5% to total Delivery , Dhq is not reported data over the period that's why the total complications are showing poor of Dist. DWH is needs to check data because most of the complications cases are identified and managed at DWH .
however, DH reported treatment of complications like blood transfusion.

% C-Section reported only 1% DH hospital and Puranpur CHC reported data, other CHCs of Block are not performing C-Section. need to check data wherever C-Section has Conducted.
C-section deliveries of PVT facility are not showing in HMIS that's why Dist showing low performing on this particular indicator.

Child Health

Still Birth against total Delivery is reported is 1.5% by Dist. Apparently good number as compared to the previous Month
Newborn having < 2.5Kg is only 8% of Dist but AHS shows 21.4 . Dhq has DWH and some Pvt. facility but reporting of LBW Newborn is only 1% that's why Dist showing less.

Immunization

Number of Live births and BCG given not corresponding in most of the blocks as per the table.
- Kasmanda reported more than 100% .
- Usually BCG, OPV0 and Hepatitis B0 doses are given at birth time but reporting shows all three are not given at the time.
- Wide variation of Immunization to kind of doses.

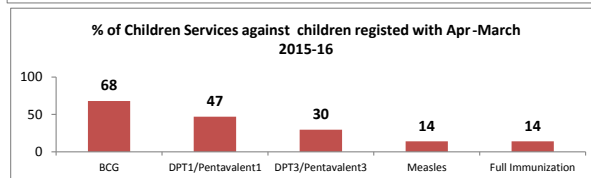
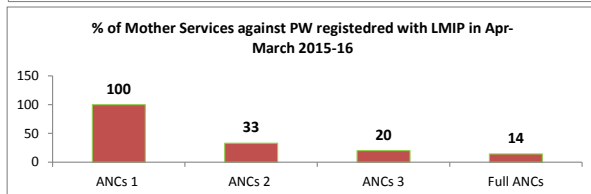
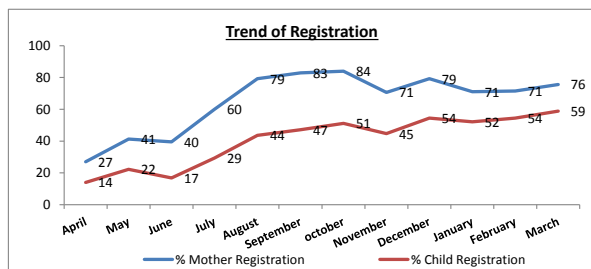
Family Planning

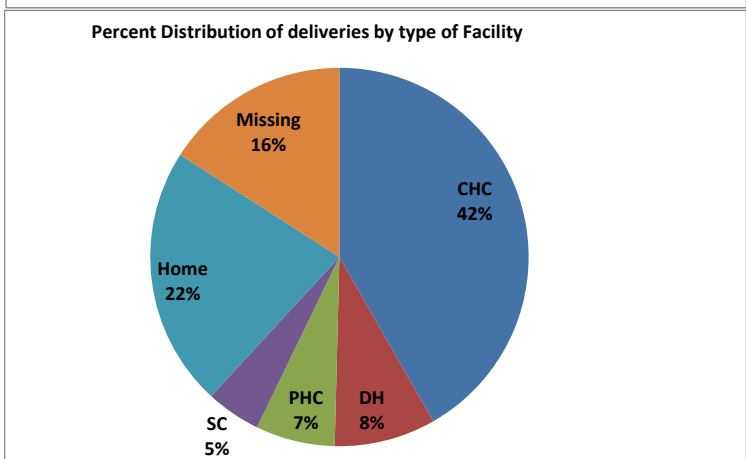
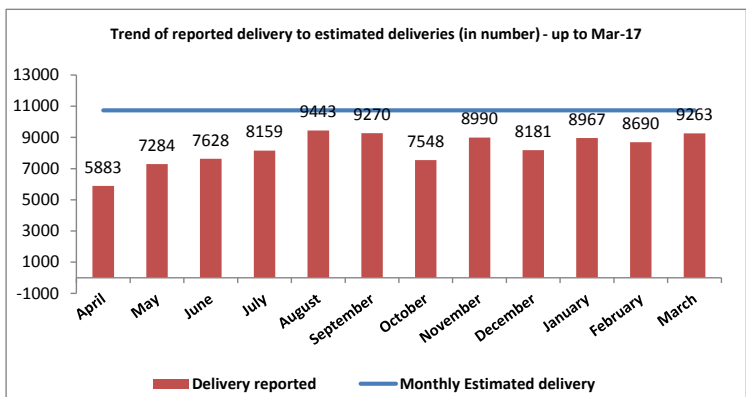
Gondlamau and DHQ and Reusa are reporting more than 100% ANC registration. It needs to be validated and checked.

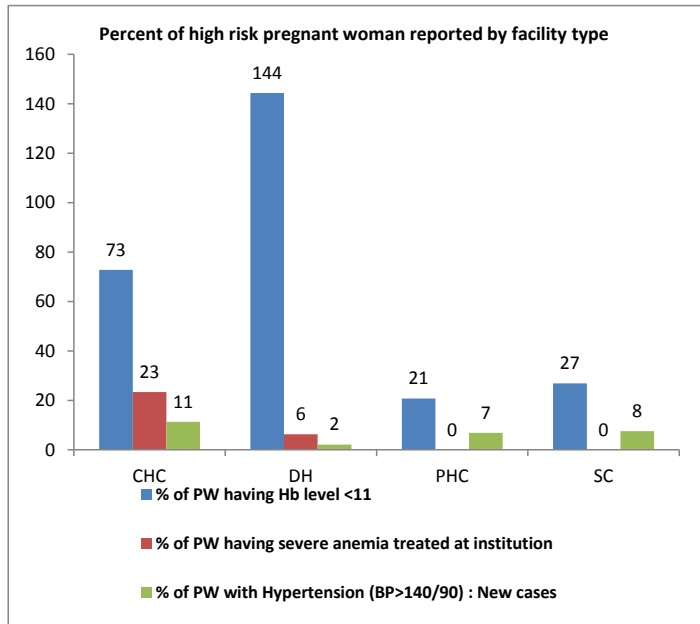
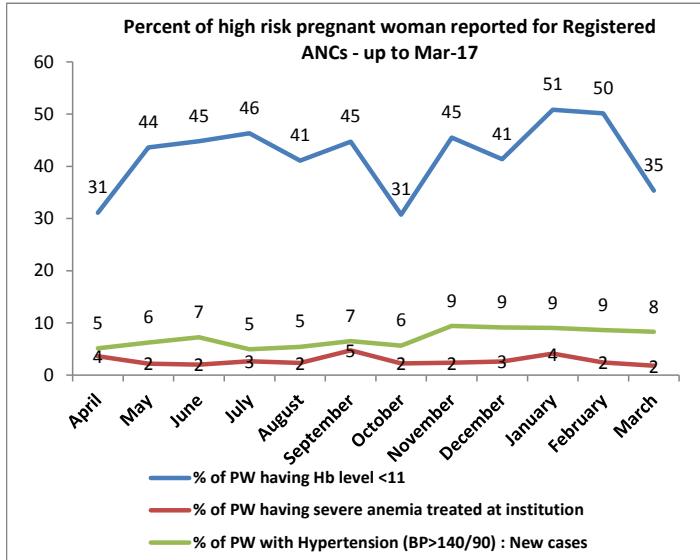

- Hypertensive cases identification is very poor in many blocks. All Moics need to verify & update properly in HMIS.

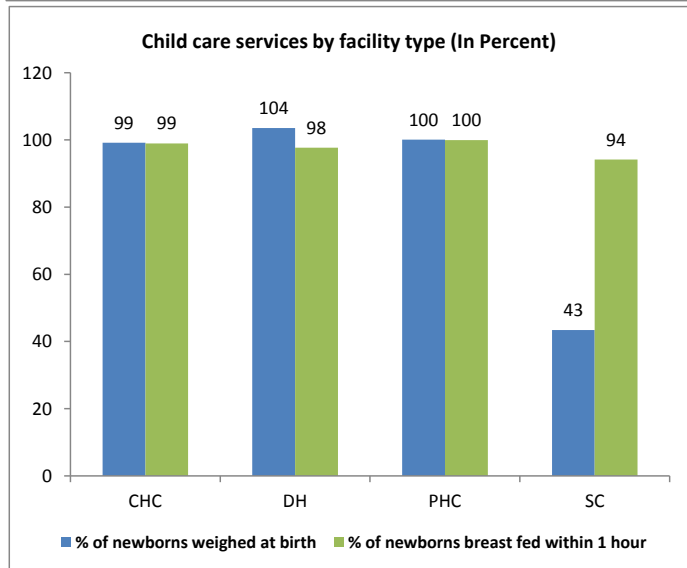
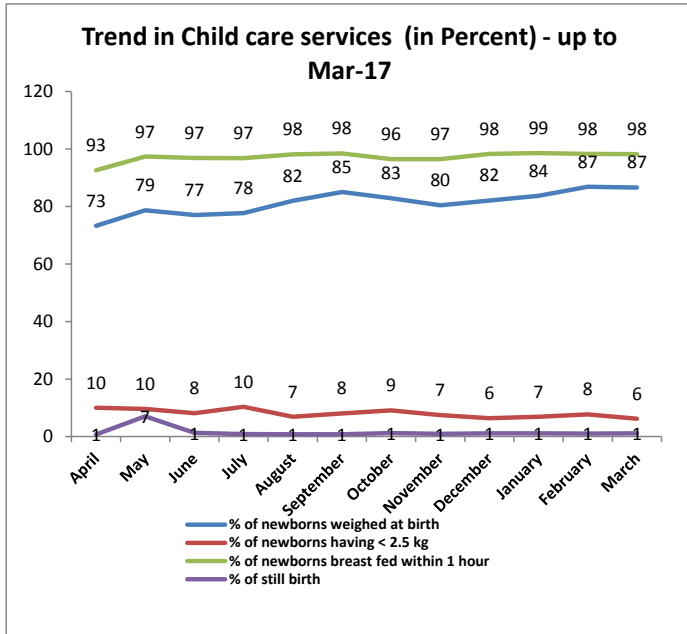

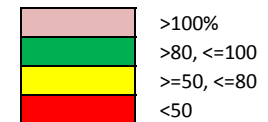
Sitapur - Child Services Reported in HMIS during FY 2016-17 (March) Child care services trends, distribution and progress



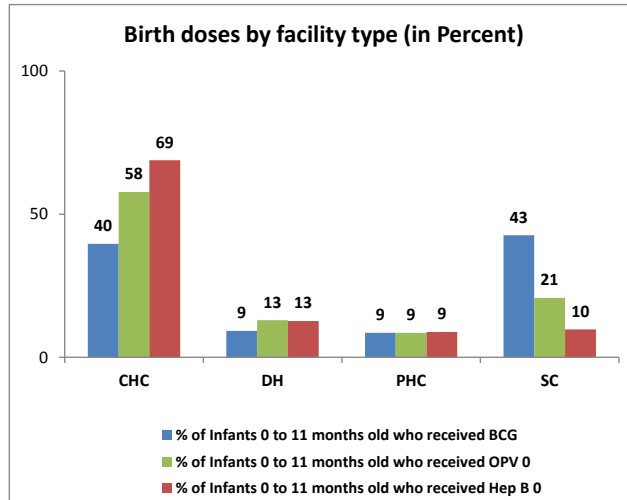
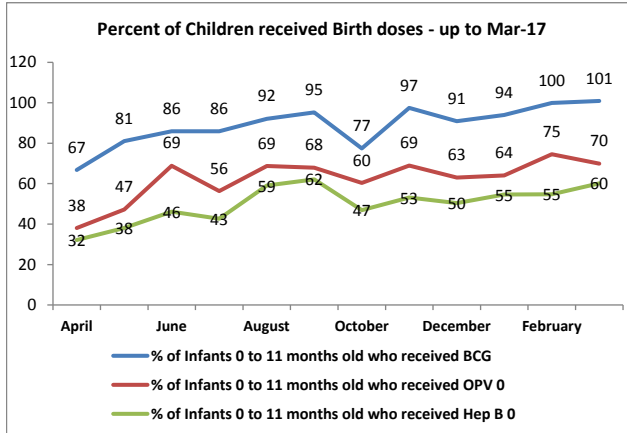

Same variation seem also here at newborn breast within 1 hour, district reported 97% & as per ASH report 54.9%.



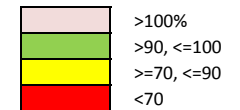

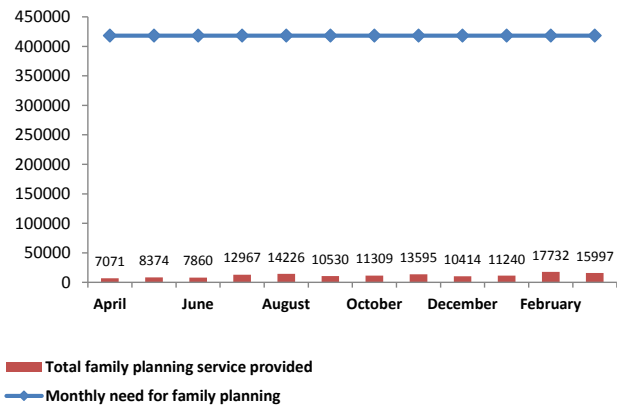

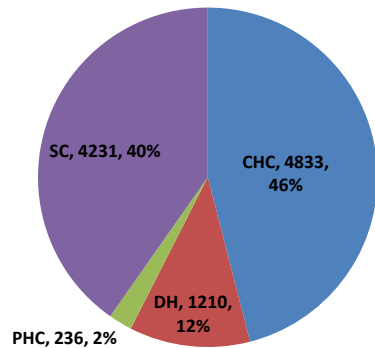


Sitapur - Family Planning Services Reported in HMIS during FY 2016-17(March)

Number of Family planning users against need by month



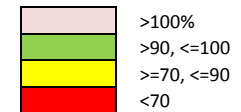
