- 61% of the mother is registered in HMIS since April-Mar 2016 but only 54% have got registered in MCTS which shows a big gap in the name based tracking of mother.  
 - Similarly child registration is only 52% in MCTS while 41% children have reported in HMIS.  
 - There is a need to improve the status of MCTS for proper tracking of mother and children

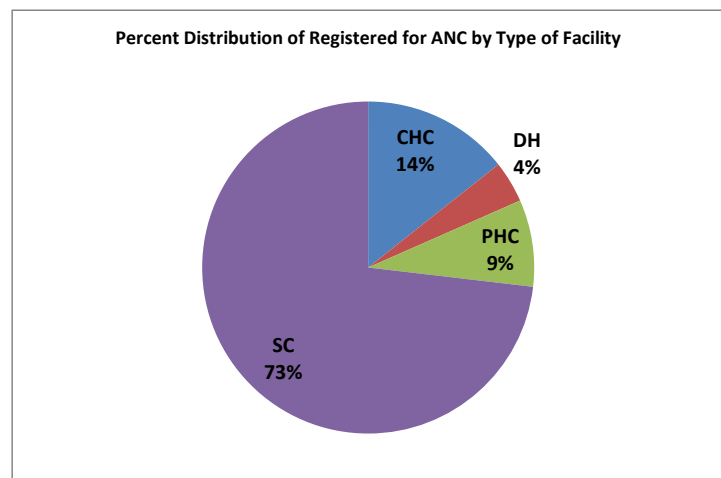
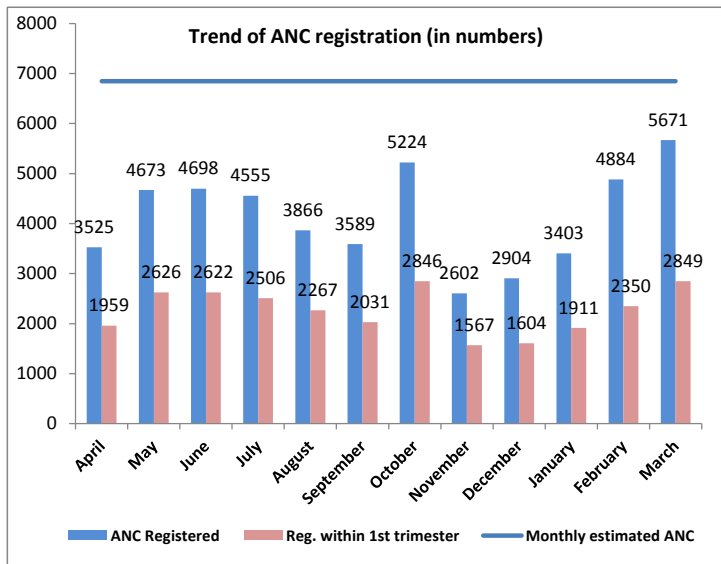

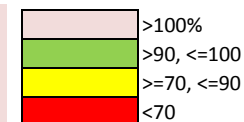

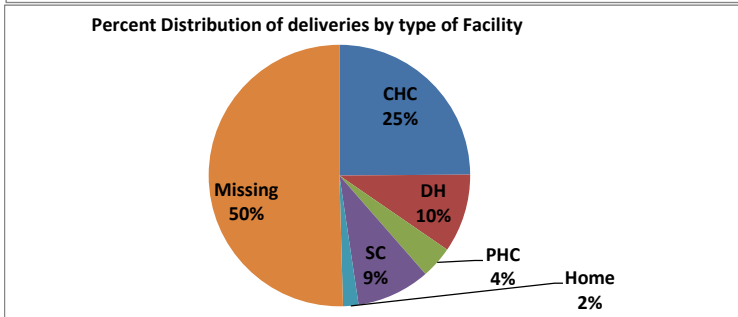
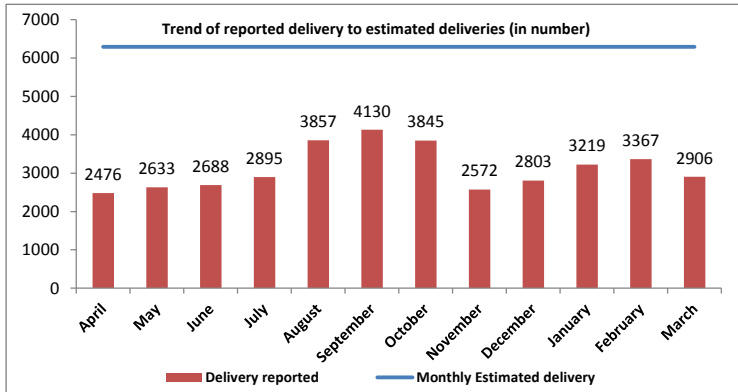
### Gaps in ANC Registration :

1. ANC registration of dist. is 60% although AHS 2012-13 showing ANC registration 78.8%.
- 2- ANC Registration in 1st trim. is 55% which is reported little more than AHS 12-13 i.e. 53%.
- 3- % of ANC received 3 ANC checkup is 48% which is higher than AHS 12-13 ( 35.9) .

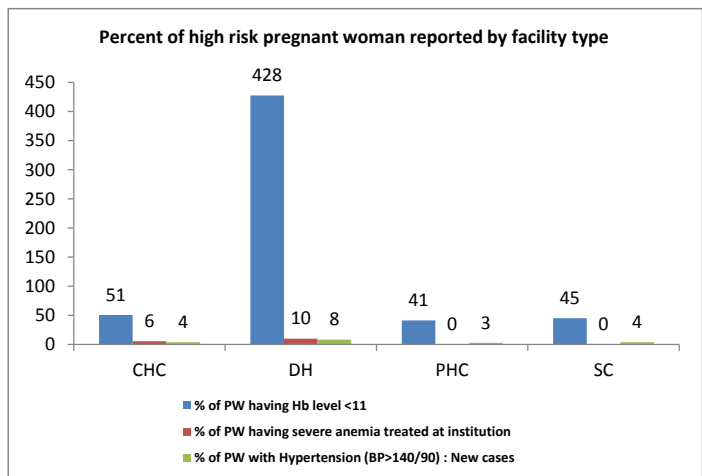
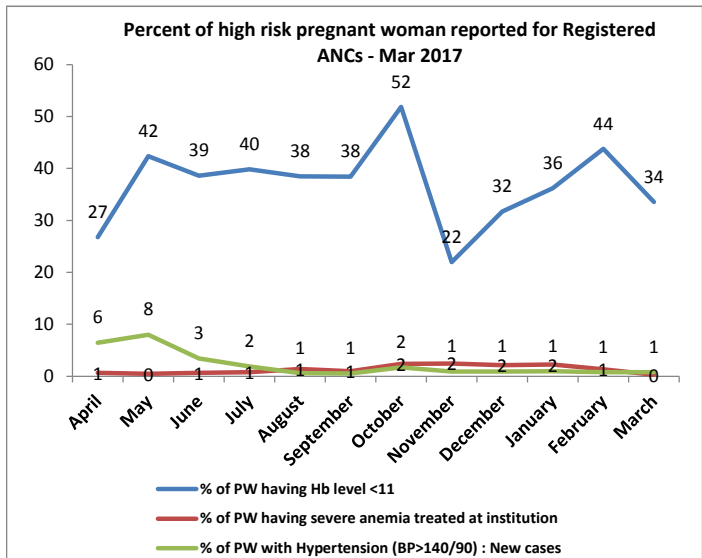
- 1-50% deliveries reported against the total estimated deliveries, needs to report rest missing deliveries.
- 2-96% deliveries are reported as institutional out of total deliveries(it is 47% against the total estimated deliveries) although AHS 2012-13 reported for Sultanpur is 64%.
- 3- 4% deliveries conducted at Home and 50% deliveries are not reported against the estimated deliveries.
- 4-84% mothers discharge under 48 hrs of delivery in Sultanpur district
- 5- JSY payment is 93%. Motigarpu block is reporting more than 100% JSY payment.

- District reported 2.2 % hypertensive women but block Motigarpur & kadipur did not reported any hypertensive women.

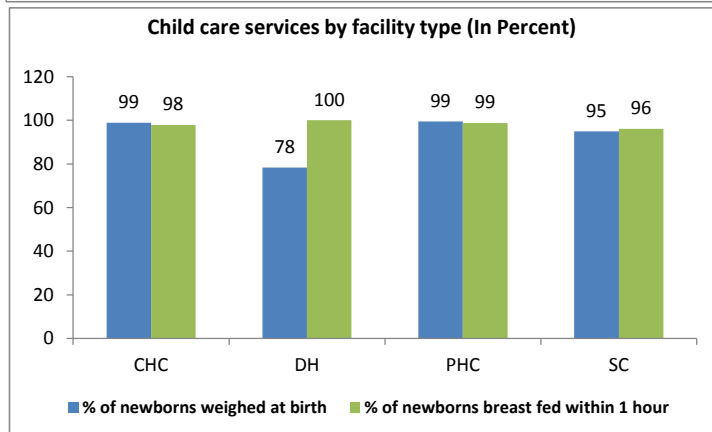
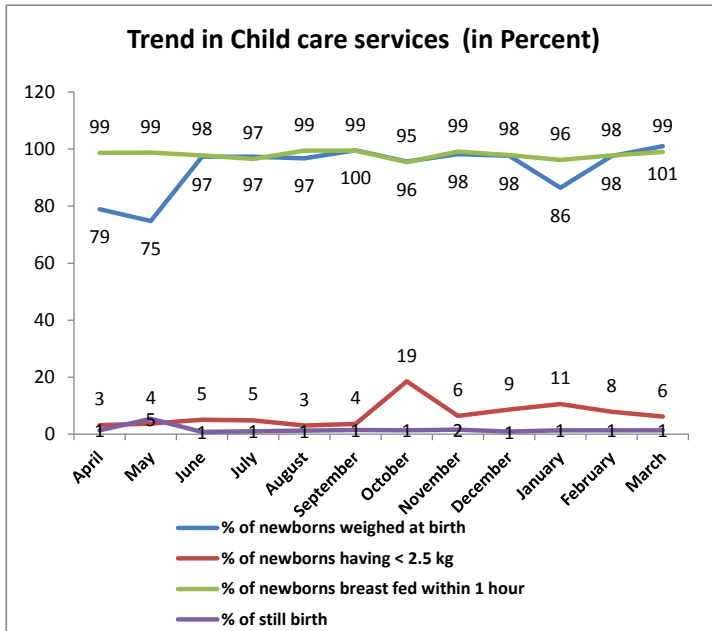

- In Sultanpur 94% children weight at birth and of which 7% LBW while AHS 12-13 estimated this as 44% & 15.9% respectively.

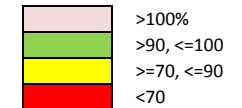

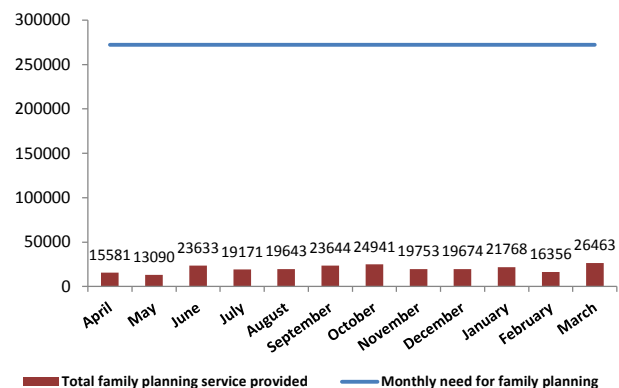

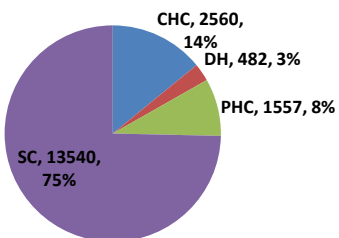

**Number of Family planning users against need by month**



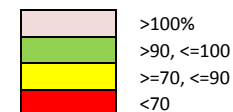
