Kanpur Nagar - FY 2016-17 (April-March)

Interpretation (District Kanpur Nagar)

Summary sheet

Maternal health :

ANC Registration Reported in HMIS in the month of April- March, against estimated is 77 %. According to AHS it is 72.9% which considerably shows better value. Contribution of SC in ANC registration is 29% which is indicated Poor outreach coverage, whereas ANC registration in DH is considerably (13 %) .were as CHC & PHC Contribute only 4% & 54 % only.

As we compared to HMIS, MCTS is reporting ANC registration of 51 % against estimated in the month of April- March, which shows an opportunity gap of one third registration. This is suggestive of poor MCTS entries at the blocks Level. All the blocks except Ghatampur, Kanpur nagar, Sarsol & Shivrajpur have poor ANC registration. Major difference is seen in Ghatampur(59 % difference), shivrajpur (Reported 31 %) & Kalyanpur Reported (38 % Difference) registration as per HMIS , Its suggestive that to collect the data from the field and increase the ANC registration under MCTS Portal through our MCTS Operator .Their is some over reporting or may be typical mistake in data reporting Under kanpur nagar. very important to verify the data before reporting.

District is reporting 77% early ANC registration as compared to AHS data of 59%, which is relatively Good , This is suggestive of over reporting or perception of FLWs (Field level worker's) about registering a pregnant women after TT injection. Percentage of 3 ANC checkups reported in HMIS (50 %) as compared to AHS data (52%) is indicated good coverage of reporting. Data needs to be verified. MCTS service updation of 3 ANC is also shows good (57 %), but when we drill down the Block level data , Block Billhaur & Ghatampur shows only 45 % & 44% , need to be increase on priority basis on this block.

Delivery :-

Delivery reported is 52 %, a huge part of delivery is missing (48 %)against estimated. Even when pregnant women are registered (77 % ANC registration) are not tracked till delivery (gap of 29 %), Bhitargaoun , Bidhuna , Patara Shivrajpur & Ghatampur, is reported less then 50%. Situation in MCTS reporting is much poorer that is only (37 %), Need to be instruction given to improve the data.

According to the HMIS data district reported only 2 %, home delivery . some block Bhitargaoun(4%), Kakwan(4.2 %), Chobeypur(1.5%) , Shivrajpur (2.3 %) reported . SC contributed less % of deliveries are being reported, this shows reporting gap. Or If this gap is covered around 20% missing deliveries can be covered. so that they covered some missing delivery. Delivery reported in kanpur nagar may be some over reported kindly check.

HRP and Complication Detection :-

Trend Analysis of HRP woman is decreasing from April to March . need to verify the reason why there was decrease in reporting. It is a mandate to treat severe anemic women at block facilities and DH , but from table in HRP sheet it is find that many blocks are not providing the services or not reporting except Ghatampur chobeypur, Kanpur nagar & Shivrajpur

At SC level HRP detection is very poor which raises the issue of equipment availability or skill of the FLW or there is operator problem need to be verify .Complication detection in district is 2 %. District Hospital is also not reporting the complication need to address. & Instruct the related staff nurse to report the data.

Child Care and Immunization:-

Out of estimated live births 56.7 % live births are reported in HMIS and 50 % in MCTS. Billhaur, Chobeypur, bheetargaun, patara Shivrajpur & Ghatampur difference in HMIS and MCTS is around more .Need to address this issue to the particular blocks.

Immunization of birth dose i.e. BCG 86 % since it can be administrated till one year, OPV0 is 39 % and HepB0 is 23%. Thus it reflects that birth doses are not given at higher facility level like CHC and DH where these antigens are available 24X7. Need to address the issue to the MOIC. Full Immunization status in MCTS is 82% where as district is reporting 98 % in HMIS. which shows over reporting Need to be check in Kalyanpur Block.

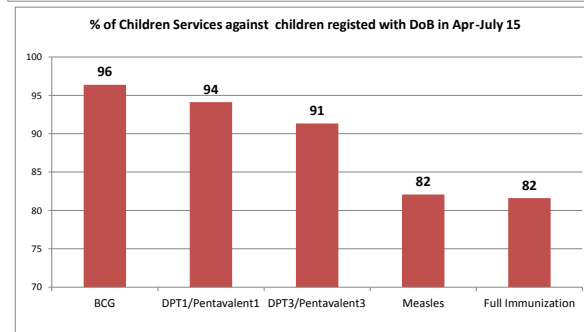
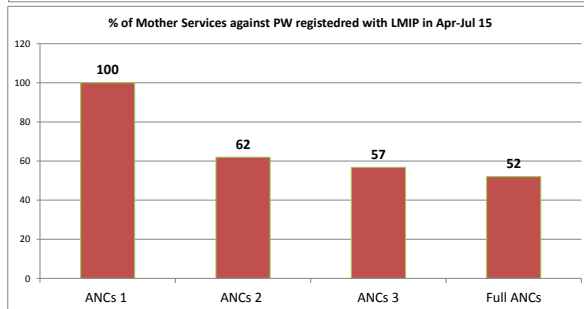
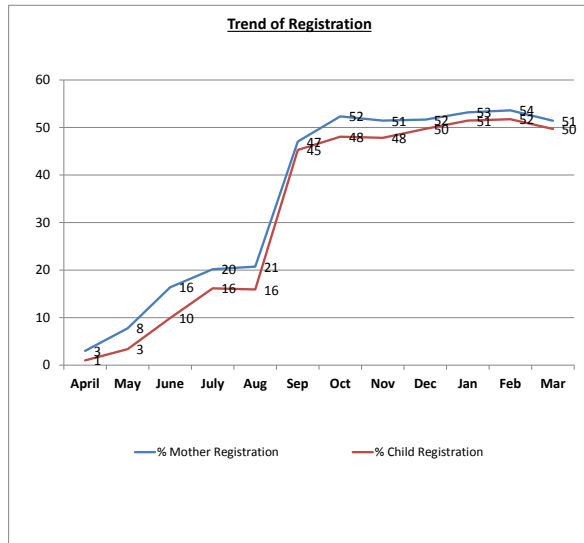
Family Planning :-

Except Kanpur Nagar , ghatampur, Bidhuna & Shivrajpur, All the block's, IUCD nsertion & spacing Method reported in HMIS is more then 100%. but need to focus to verify the Quality of data . 56 % IUCD conduted at S.C & 30% or 12 % conducted at PHC & CHC. increase the service & utilization of service at Sub center & CHC because mostly couple accept IUCD for family planning from SC & CHC.

- Asper HMIS Mother Registration is 77 % but in comparison to MCTS Mother registration is just 51 % and child registration is only 50 % in MCTS against 57 % in HMIS. It's a gap between HMIS & MCTS Registration need to special focus in MCTS Registration.
- 3ANC is 57 % and delivery shows in MCTS is 37 %.
- Full immunization shows 82 %
- High risk pregnancy shows only 8 % . need to be focus on HRP Registration.

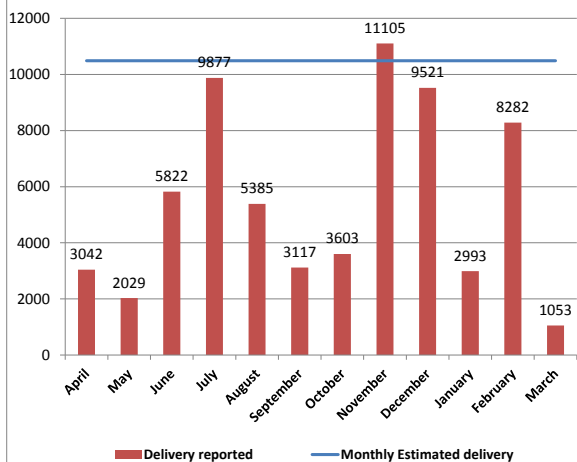
Gaps in ANC Registration :

1. ANC registration of dist. is 77 % and block Bidhna, Kakwan, Chobeypur & kalyanpur reported >80% although AHS 2012-13 showing ANC registration 72.9%
2. ANC Registration in 1st trim. is 75 % which is reported more than to AHS 12-13 i.e. 59.3%. there is some over reporting or may be typical mistake in data reporting Under kanpur nagar.
- 3- % of received 3 ANC checkup . is 50 % which is reported less than to AHS 12-13 i.e. 52.8%. may be block kakwan over reported.
- 4- SC Reported only 29 % ANC Registration of total. Its important to increase the ANC Registration at SC.



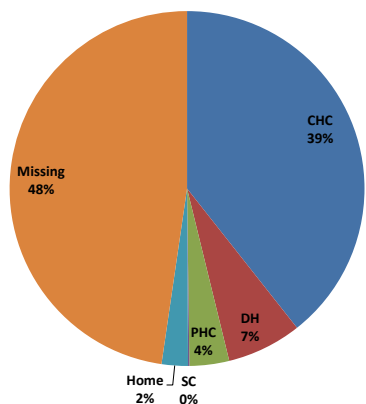

Trend of reported delivery to estimated deliveries (in number) - FY-16



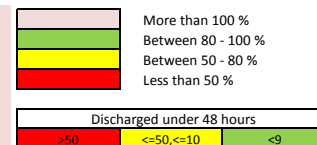

Percent Distribution of deliveries by type of Facility



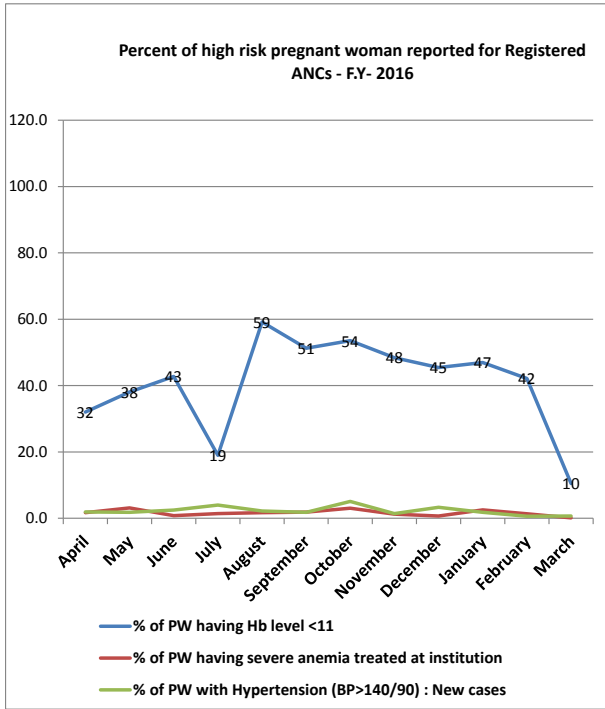
Gaps in Deliveries :-

- 52 % deliveries reported against the total estimated deliveries, needs to report rest missing deliveries.
- 95 % deliveries are reported as institutional out of total deliveries(it is 49 % against the total estimated deliveries) although AHS 2012-13 reported for kanpur nagar is 61.6%
- only 2 % deliveries conducted at Home and 48 % deliveries are not reported against the estimated deliveries. may be the home delivery is not reported properly.
- 78 % mothers discharge under 48 hrs of delivery in kanpur nagar . Billahaur reported 11 % need to verify the data.
- 5% of missing deliveries are highest in bhitargaoun , Ghatampur, Shivrajpur, & bidhuna, Patara . District reported 48 % missing delivery. its very important to verify the data whether all the home delivery are reported .
- Delivery reported in kanpur nagar may be some over reported kindly check.

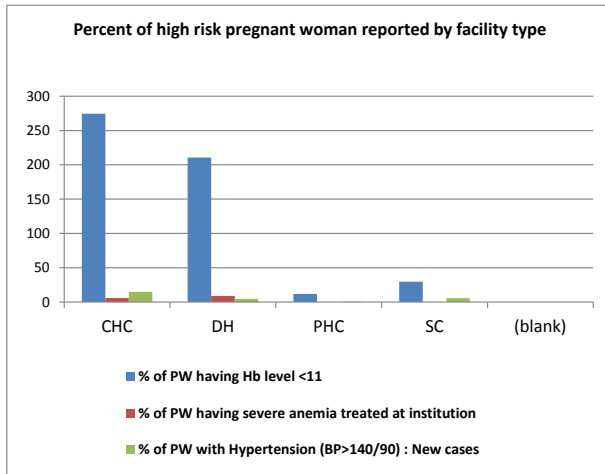

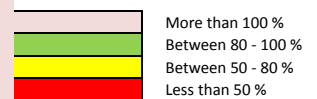

- Hypertensive cases identification is zero in Bidhuna & kakwan , . data need to verify the records. District Reported 2.2 % of Hypertensive cases.



Kanpur Nagar C-Section and Complication treated



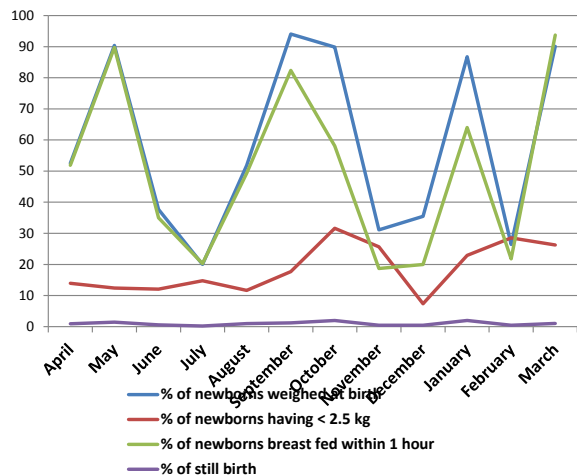

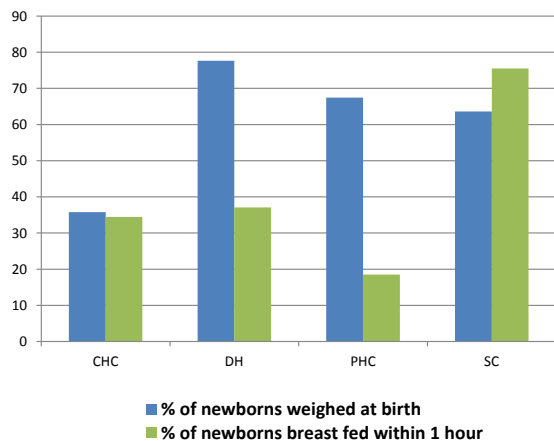

Trend in Child care services (in Percent) - April -March-2016



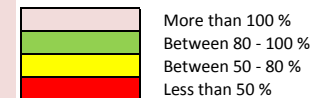

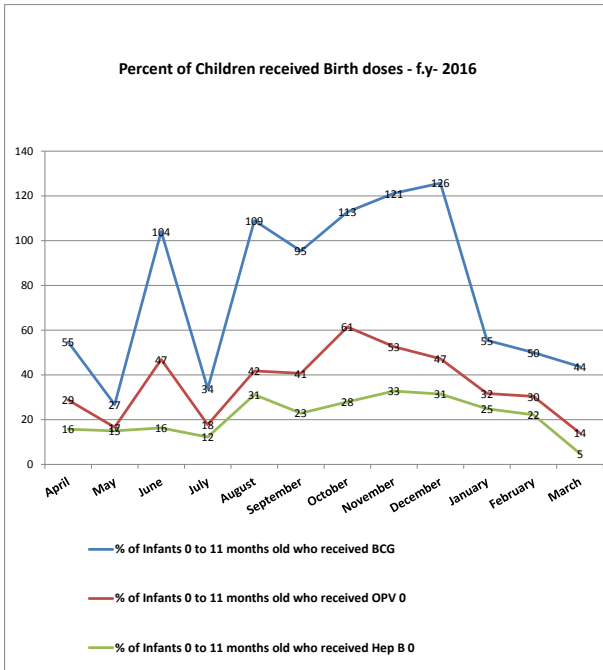

Gaps in Child care :

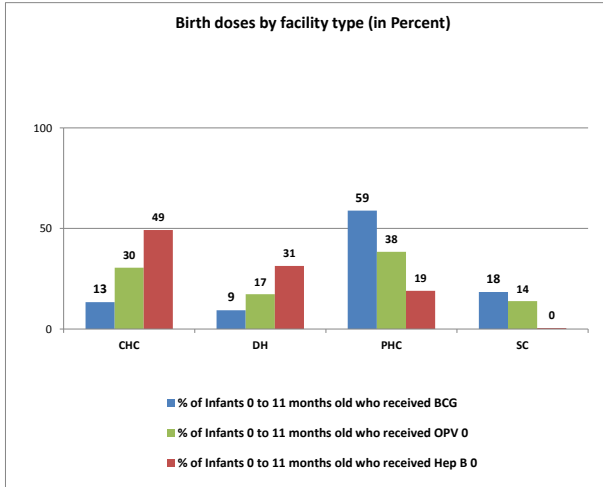
- 0.7 % still births are reported from the dist.on 1000 live births while billhaur reported 0.5 % still birth and Kakwan reported 3.3 % which is highest in district
- 35 % births are reported as breast fed within 1 hours of births, as AHS 2012-13 showing data is 54.7% only.
- In kanpur nagar 44 % children weight at birth and of which 20 % LBW while AHS 12-13 estimated this as 51 % & 23% respectively.

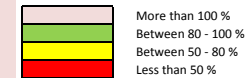

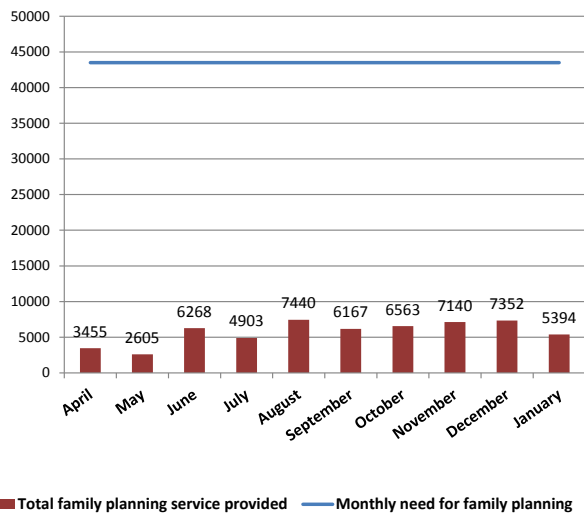
Gaps in Immunization :

- No. of Live births and BCG given not corresponding in most of the blocks as per the table and reporting approx. > 100% Of live births need to be check accurately. Ghatampur , Kalyanpur & Kanpur nagar reported BCG>100%.
- Only chobeypur, Kakwan,Billhaur, Kanpur nagar & Sarsaul given >45% Hep.B-0 dose to the total live births and rest blocks were not able to do so .District Reported 23 %.
- Usually BCG, OPV0 and Hepatitis B0 doses are given at birth time but reporting shows all three are not given at the time of birth even at DH and CHCs, it is showing service gap at facility and need focus monitoring.



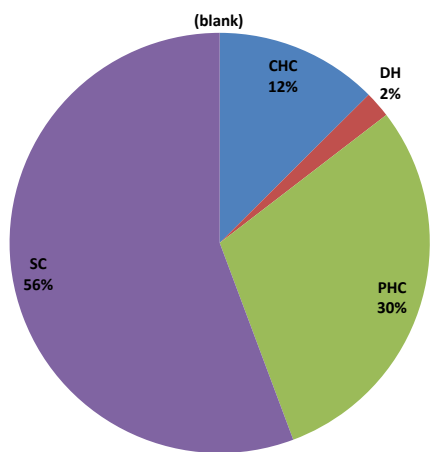

Number of Family planning users against need by month



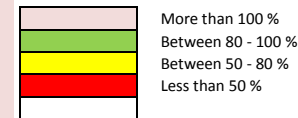
