


User Manual for Supportive Supervision Dash Board


Begin with the Story of Supportive Supervision

It shows the objective, idea and methodology of Supportive Supervision with the formula used in the dashboard and the results that we get.



Intro Dashboard (Page)

It consists of the status of SS Planned, SS Done and SS tools received. It also consists of Drill down feature to analyse district wise tools status.




Now continue with Home button.

Home Dashboard (Page)

It consists of 2 sections:

1. Upper half: Map showing block covered during SS Visits.
2. Lower Half: % of Participation of Government Officials during SS visits in reference to the available govt. officials. It also consists of Drill down feature to analyse district and availability wise participation of Govt. officials.

It also consists of 6 buttons in the Map section of the dashboard (Page) to go to the different pages, which are: HR, Training, Drugs & Supply, HMIS Data element, JSSK and Summary.



HR dashboard (Page)


It consists of 2 sections:

1. Upper Half: Summary of HR data elements for 226 facilities. Green to red colour diverging as per the data varies. This table also consist of 4 columns: Blank, Matched, over reported and under reported which represent the count of facilities reporting blank, matched, over reported and under reported respectively.
2. Lower half: It consist of 3 filters
 - a) District wise data representation
 - b) Data element wise data representation
 - c) Data quality wise i.e. Blank, Matched, Over reported and under reported data representation.



Summary dashboard (Page)

It is a single section dashboard (Page) which shows the percentage of Blank, Matched, over reported and under reported with respect to 5 different parts i.e. HR, Training, Drugs & Supply, HMIS Data element and JSSK (throughout 226 Facilities).



Note:

1. Functionality of next 4 dashboard (Page) i.e. Training, Drugs & Supply, HMIS Data element and JSSK are same as HR dashboard (Page).
2. Each and every dashboard (Page) contains a button named home, which is link to Home dashboard (Page).

Formula used: -

1. If "Value as per Source Document- Value as per HMIS/UPHMIS" = "0" then Matched
 Else If "Value as per Source Document- Value as per HMIS/UPHMIS" = "" then Blank
 Else If "Value as per Source Document- Value as per HMIS/UPHMIS" > "0" then Over Reported
 Else If "Value as per Source Document- Value as per HMIS/UPHMIS" < "0" then Under Reported
