Visit of District Bijnor:

The undersigned visited on 20th October at Bijnor and met CMO, ACMO & DIO, Bijnor and briefed the objective of visit. Two blocks of Bijnor namely Haldaur & Nahtaur were selected. Out of six sessions, five sessions have been monitored by the undersigned. ACMO/DIO and DCPM Bijnor also accompanied to the team.

The general observations are as follows.

1. Sessions were organized as per micro plan which was prepared in advance.
2. The officials of health department as well as DPMU were also engaged in supportive supervision.
3. IEC materials like banner were displayed everywhere few pamphlets regarding programme may be distributed in advance for its more effectiveness.
4. Coordination among ANM, AWW & ASHA were found satisfactory.
5. Thermometer was not available anywhere except village Kashmiri of Nahtour block.
6. On dated October 19, 2016 session were not organized due to Karwa Chauth.
7. Till date DCPM has supervised 16 sessions of "Matritwa Saptah"
8. Out of six only five sessions could be monitored due to shortage of time.

Visit of District Amroha:

On dated October 21, 2016 the undersigned moved for district Amroha and visited DPMU where DPM, DCPM and other officials of DPMU were present. Two blocks namely Joe & Gajraula were selected for supportive supervision. Total six sessions have been monitored by the team.

The general observations are as follows.

1. Sessions were organized as per schedule & ANM, AWW & ASHA were present everywhere. Good coordination was found among them.
2. Two team were constituted for the monitoring. DIO Amroha was also involved to provide support to sessions running in district.
3. At village Chaubara block Gajraula the place of session was anganwadi center which was surrounded with garbage the same has been brought in notice of concerned officials of ICDS & health department for its immediate cleanness.
