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**Trip Report: मातृत्व सप्ताह** (HRP day) visit

Monitoring visit was made alongwith Dr. Manoj Shukla, DGM, NHM UP to Shahjahanpur and Bareilly District on 24-25 October 2016. The respective DPMs of Shahjahanpur and Bareilly coordinated the visit and accompanied the team during the field visit. In Bareilly Div PM reached the district hospital and coordinated with the officials their. The key observations are as follows:

**District Shahjahanpur (24/10/2016)**

**1. CHC Dadraul**

- General preparation and readiness of Maatritva Saptah and HRP clinic was not observed in the CHC and its staff. Specific preparation was not observed regarding positioning of tables, sitting arrangements of expected increased clients, Placement of Banner and hording and use of 102 Ambulance.
- LMO and LT were not available at the time of the visit, however LMO arrived at around 11 am and the LT & HEIO arrived at around 11:30 am. The LT was asked to start his work immediately as patients were waiting but the lab was not functional even until 11:45 am.
- Two ASHAs were there who came there with some ANC clients, but these clients were routine clients not HRP as declared in "मातृत्व सप्ताह".
- IFA and calcium tablet were available with staff nurse who was doing ANC check up.
- Monthly HRP register was available and maintained upto August 2016.
- The superintendent informed that most of the clients of the district are visiting to the District Hospital as the same is more accessible geographically, to the most of the block population.

**2. DWH Shahjahanpur**

- LMO was present and doing ANC checkups of the client. Total 100 ANC in OPD were there out of which 5 were HRP referred through मातृत्व सप्ताह.
- Staff nurse was handling the emergency and informed that all the clients are routine clients only and no specific campaign client load is there.
- 7-8 ASHAs were there who came there with some ANC and HRP clients.
- No HRP came till the time of visit using 102 ambulance service. Specific preparation was not observed regarding positioning of tables, sitting arrangements of expected increased clients, Placement of Banner and hording.

**3. CHC Sindhauli**

- No HRP came till the time of visit using 102 ambulance service. Specific preparation was not observed regarding positioning of tables, use of 102, sitting arrangements of expected increased clients, placement of Banner and hording.
- Medical officer and LMO (dentist) was available for HRP. Lab was functional and LT/LA were present.
- 10-12 ASHAs were available in the CHC, who were updating and submitting some formats. However, awareness about HRP was not there.

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#### 4. CHC Puwayan

- a. No HRP came till the time of visit using 102 ambulance service. Placement of a Banner was there but no hording was observed. However, specific preparation was not observed regarding positioning of tables, use of 102, sitting arrangements of expected increased clients.
- b. 5-6 ASHAs were there who came there with some ANC and HRP clients.
- c. LMO along with Superintendent herself was taking care of the ANC clients, Lab was found to be functional and LT/LA was doing blood tests.

#### District Bareilly (25/10/2016)

##### 1. DWH Bareilly

- a. The hospital has the capacity of 140 beds and almost all of them were full. The blood transfusion in wards were administered to some of the HRP women. The hospital is mainly managed by three Lady Medical Officers, including the Superintendent.
- b. There were 12-15 HRP clients registered on the day, however it was informed by the Doctor that these many HRP clients visits the district hospital on routine basis. The superintendent informed that the facility is not only serving to the referrals made by CHC/PHC in Bareilly and nearby areas but the cases are even referred from the district hospital Badaun.

##### 2. CHC Bhamoura

- a. 4-5 ASHAs were in the CHC along with the clients. ASHAs reported that the maatritva Saptah was celebrated in their respective village though VHND. However, awareness about the use of 102 Ambulances to bring HRP clients was not there.
- b. General preparation and readiness of Maatritva Saptah and HRP clinic was not observed in the CHC and its staff. Specific preparation was not observed regarding positioning of tables, sitting arrangements of expected increased clients, Placement of Banner and hording and use of 102 Ambulance.


##### 3. PHC Ramnagar

- a. HRP and delivery cases are there who came along with the respective ASHAs.
- b. IFA and calcium tablet were available with staff nurse who was doing ANC check up.
- c. The kitchen was functional and food was being provided to the inpatient clients.
- d. Placement of a Banner and hording was not observed.

##### 4. PHC Aonla

- a. Awareness about HRP day was not there among the staff including the MOIC. However, few HRP cases reached the facility along with the concerned ASHAs. Area of the PHC is mostly urban and as per the ACMO mobility support is not required for the clients.
- b. LMO is not posted and hence not available in the facility for services. ANC clients were there and were being attended to by the staff nurse/ANM of the facility. Pathology lab was functional and LT was available and working at the time of visit.
- c. One case was also referred to the district hospital, as informed the staff.
- d. Banners and hoardings were not displayed.

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
