Examination guidelines for "Certificate Course in Community Health for Nurses" Session April - August 2022

Mechanism of evaluation for CCHN Program:

- 1. Final examination will be conducted at the end of the course; the exam schedule will be communicated with the study centers through e-mail
- 2. Theory exam will be conducted in the allotted examination center by KGMU in Lucknow

3. Examination form:

- KGMU will issue examination forms for the students
- Timely submission is mandatory (by hand/registered post)
- Timeline for submission of examination form will be intimated with the program study center by respective institution mail IDs
- Admit card/Hall ticket will be issued by KGMU (by hand/registered post/online)
- Students will have to carry the admit card/Hall ticket to appear for the exam

4. Theory examination:

- Students have to complete 75% of attendance in theory to appear in the exam
- The eligibility for the students is to be determined by the respective Program Incharges/center coordinator
- The duration of theory paper will be for three hours and shall be on MCQ
- The paper will be for 100 marks and would comprise of 200 MCQ questions
- Each answer would be awarded ½ a mark each
- The questions will be in English only.
- There won't be any negative marks for the incorrect answers

Note:

- Theory exam will be conducted in Lucknow under KGMU certified centers; students are requested to carry photo id proof along with admit card attested by Program in charge (PIC)
- In case any undue changes regarding the theory examination process, the respective PSCs will be intimated accordingly

5. Practical examination:

- Keeping in view the COVID situation, the students have to complete at least 80% attendance in clinical to appear for practical exam.
- Practical examination will be conducted in respective clinical site hospitals of each program study center.

Internal practical examination

- Internal practical examination will be conducted at the end of each clinical posting i.e. Community posting (at CHC) and District Hospital postings by faculty (Academic Counselors)
- o Internal practical examination covers 40 marks under which students will be assigned two cases which comprises of a long case and short case; A long case for 10 marks and a short case for 5 marks would be evaluated at the district hospital and also at the CHC level. Maintenance of practical log book will carry 10 marks.
- Evaluation format for the internal examination is in Annexure 1 and scoring sheet is on Annexure 3

Final practical examination

- The final practical examination will be conducted in the clinical practice site of program study center (District Hospital/Medical College Hospital) by both external and internal practical examiners.
- Program in charge will decide the examination date with consent of KGMU and will carry out the necessary co-ordination with the external examiner and University.
- Program in Charge (PIC) will identify external examiner, which will be communicated with KGMU.
 - External examiner can be faculty (academic counselor) from another program study center within the same district;
 Or

If there are no program study centers within the district, PIC can also identify PG doctor from DH/DWH/DCH/MCH/CMO office who are not counselor but are aware of the CCHN program.

- Not more than 50 students should be assessed in one day during practical exams. (PSCs with a batch strength of more than 50 candidates can carry out the practical examination in two days)
- The practical exams will be conducted as per the GoI protocols.
- Students will be assigned two cases (a long case and a short case) each
- The viva would be jointly conducted by both External and Internal examiners on basis of an objectively structured pattern; the students

would be rotated around 4-5 stations would identify/interpret/rationalize the case scenario simultaneously

- Suggested list of stations will be:
 - o Interpreting Case Studies
 - Identifying the disease condition
 - Identification of equipment, articles and anatomical models
 - Basic procedures like hand washing technique, Bio Medical Waste management
- o Evaluation format for the external examination is in Annexure 2 and scoring sheet on Annexure 4
- o Under any circumstances if the respective PSCs have not completed the stipulated hours of clinical postings, they are to ensure that the remaining hours is completed within 15 days after practical examination

For external examiner Rs. 2500/- per day (TA for external examiners as per UP Govt. rules and it is mandatory to attach Travel Proof like Vehicle Number, copy of RC & Total covered distance etc.)

Note: Remuneration bills of examiners for practical examination should be sent to KGMU after the completion of the examinations

8. Process of Re-evaluation:

- a. There will be no re-evaluation of final theory or practical examination.
- b. Unsuccessful candidates will be given only one attempt in upcoming examination and the examination fee would be borne by the candidates as per KGMU norms

9. Process of Evaluation:

The candidates should obtain at least 50% marks separately in both theory and practical final examination to pass the certificate course.

10. Instructions for Failed/Unsuccessful candidates

- The PICs/Course coordinators of respective PSCs and RHFWTCs are to inform the failed candidates regarding the filling up of the examination forms
- The failed candidates have to submit Rs. 4000/- for the examination process
 - The PSCs/RHFWTCs to make a single demand draft towards the Controller of Examination, KGMU, Lucknow, regarding the candidates who either failed or had attendance shortage in the last examination

The failed candidates will have to appear for both theory and practical examination

 Candidates who were not eligible to attempt the last examination due to attendance shortage; the respective PICs to ensure that these candidates are to carry out make up duty along with the current batch of candidates and complete their needed hours
